## CHAMBER MEETINGS KEEP BUSINESSES IN THE LOOP

# ORTEGA WRESTLING COACH OF THE YEAR



On Saturday, January 19, 2013, at the U.C.I.A.C. Wrestling Tournament Arthur L. Johnson High School's Head Wrestling Coach, Rick Ortega, was named Union County Wrestling Coach of the Year. It is an annual award that honors one County Coach each year for their achievements both on and off the mat. The award is voted upon by Union County's Wrestling Coaches, making it an even greater accomplishment as he was designated by his colleagues.

Ortega, a Governor Livingston alumnus, won the State Championship at 130 pounds as a

senior in 1993. He has been involved with the Arthur L. Johnson High School Wrestling Program for the past seven years, the last two as a head coach.

In addition Arthur L. Johnson High School had a wonderful showing at the U.C.I.A.C. Tournament, as they won two individual County Championship bouts behind the efforts of Charlie Hudak (126 pounds) and John Coler (138 pounds). This was the first time in years that Arthur L. Johnson High School has had multiple County Championships in the same year.

Supervisor of Athletics, Health, and Physical Education Gus Kalikas had this to say about Coach Rick Ortega: "Rick is a model of what we want and expect from our coaches. In only two short years, Coach Ortega has turned our wrestling program around not only with results, but with numbers as well. He is heavily vested in both the recreation wrestling program in the community of Clark. We are thrilled that he was honored by his peers as the Union County Wrestling Coach of the Year and are extremely proud of his wonderful achievements in the sport of wrestling."

On Sunday January 27, 2013 ALJ HS Senior Cheerleader, Alison Dugan, was one of seventy All-Americans to cheer in the NFL Pro-Bowl. This All-American Cheer and Dance (AACD) group of talented athletes performed during the pre-game and half time show.

Ali was nominated in April 2012 for the Pro Bowl tour by her competitive all-star cheerleading team, NJ Heat, and was selected by AACD at a competition in Hershey, PA. While in Hawaii, Ali and 29 other athletes qualified to compete for a national scholarship. Ali competed in the Cheer and Tumble division and was judged on an individually performed routine. She was awarded first place and a one thousand dollar scholarship.

Reflecting on her accomplishments Dugan says, "I have been cheering since I was 6 years old and I never imagined cheerleading would take me to Hawaii to cheer at the Pro Bowl. It was an awesome experience and I got to meet athletes from all over the country. Taking 1st place in the scholarship competition was the icing on the cake for this amazing adventure."

Alison will be attending Penn State University in the fall where she hopes to continue her cheerleading career as a Nittany Lion.

All attend Kumpf Middle School in Clark, NJ and participate in Pop Warner. These students were chosen as First Team for Pop Warner Eastern Region Scholar Athletes.

Out of 1927 applicants who submitted from 5 states, they were among the top 35 cheer and top 35 football who were chosen. These athletes qualify only if they have a 96% or higher grade

point average. In addition, they take into consideration the students participation in clubs, groups, volunteer work, community service, etc. They will receive a certificate and medal at the awards banquet on March 24, 2013 at the Woodcliff Hilton in Woodcliff Lakes, NJ.
