Beer and wine were also available. There were game trailers for everyone to take a chance to win prizes, plus a money wheel, 50/50, and an LCD Flat Screen TV was raffled off.

Children enjoyed rides, eating cotton candy, popcorn, and ice cream. Brother John Brown band performed live on Friday night and Sounds of the Street doo-wop band performed live on Saturday night. ST. JOHN THE APOSTLE FOOD PANTRY IS GEARING UP FOR THE HOLIDAY'S

St. John the Apostle Food Pantry located on Valley Road in Clark/Linden, has reached a milestone recently. They have gone over the 100,000 pound mark of documented food products distributed to their clients during the last few years. Some of this was given to them by state and federal programs, much of it was provided by food collections, and some was purchased with the generous donations many of the parishioners, school children, neighboring businesses, and friends have given to them.

Their client list has more than tripled itself over these last few years, and they still anticipate an ever-growing need for their ministry. Expenses have increased tremendously because

volunteers are now forced to transport, almost weekly, their food allotments from the Community Food Bank in Hillside to the pantry, in a rental truck.

"St. John the Apostle Food Pantry is so grateful for all the donations we recently received in outfitting our youngest clients with new book bags and school supplies. We accommodated over 100 students," stated Mary Ann Fiorillo, director of the pantry.

Mrs. Fiorillo explained that as the major holidays approach, they will once again have a great need for turkeys, trimmings, children's gifts, and infant supplies. She stated "While the Community Food Bank of Hillside has been a most generous source for us, we would still fall short of our task to defeat hunger and poverty

for our surrounding parishioners and neighbors. These ARE tough times, and we need YOUR support. Please help our dedicated volunteer staff provide for those that are less fortunate. We anticipate feeding over 700 mouths each month from now through the end of the year."

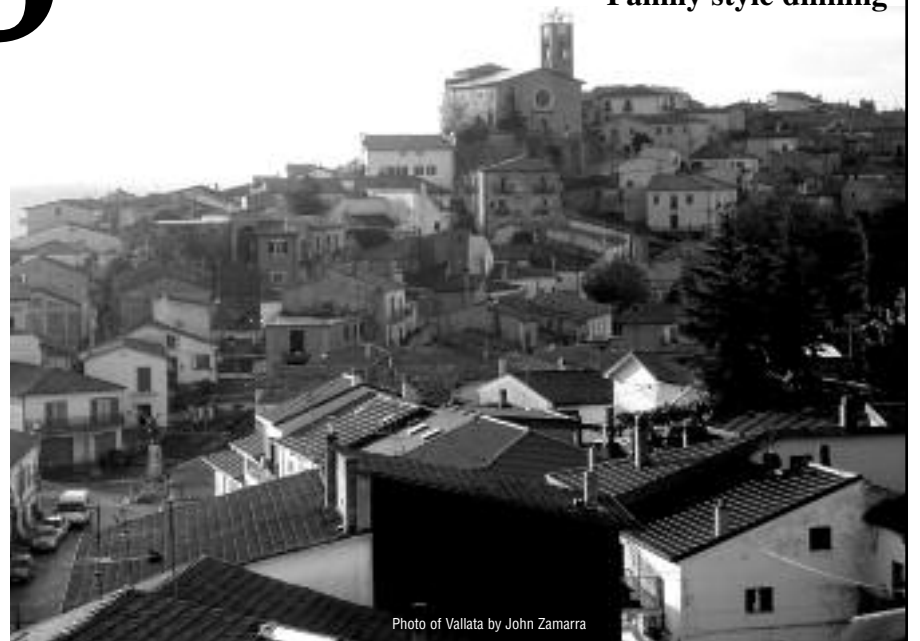
