



LINDEN RESIDENTS HOST ALEX'S LEMONADE STAND TO RAISE FUNDS FOR CHILDHOOD CANCER

Remember fair to be held on Saturday, September 28th on Wood Avenue in Linden.

Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation (ALSF) emerged from the front yard lemonade stand of cancer patient Alexandra "Alex" Scott (1996-2004). In 2000, 4-year-old Alex announced that she wanted to hold a lemonade stand to raise money to help find a cure for all children with cancer. Since Alex held that first stand, the Foundation bearing her name has evolved into a national fundraising movement, complete with thousands of supporters across the country carrying on her legacy of hope. To date, Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation, a registered 501(c)3 charity, has raised more than \$55 million toward fulfilling Alex's dream of finding a cure, funding over 250 research projects nationally.

Linden's Alex's Lemonade Stand is a family affair. The team consists of 8-year-old Gabriella Meloni, her mom Mary Ellen Cook and her aunt Kathie Martis. What started out as finding a lemon decorated table cloth at a clearance event has been transformed into a family life lesson. The family feels that it's the perfect opportunity

to show Gabriella that you are never too young to make a difference and that it can be easy to help others through simple actions.

This will be the families 5th stand, to date they have raised of \$3,000. This year the Stand got a makeover by the generosity of Home Depot.

The family decided that their little lemonade stand needed sprucing up for their next event and went to the local Home Depot in Linden to get some supplies. When Gabriella's aunt Kathie shared their story with Home Depot employees Dennis and Marcos they decided they wanted to help and offered to build a new lemonade stand. Both Dennis and Marco spent several hours showing Gabriella what they were doing and letting her help them build. "To say they went over and above is putting it mildly." stated Gabriella's mom Mary Ellen.

If you can't stop by the Alex's Lemonade Stand the September to Remember event, the Linwood Tap House, located on Wood and Linden Avenues in Linden, will be selling paper lemons all month to help the fundraising effort as well.

BOXING NIGHT SET IN LINDEN



INFLUENZA IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM


The Linden Board of Health is currently registering Linden residents for their Annual Seasonal Influenza Immunization program.

While no definite clinic dates have been set, you should register to receive a "flu shot" by calling the Linden Board of Health Office at (908) 474-8409. Once registered, you will be notified of the seasonal flu clinic time and date.

Influenza, also know as the flu, is a viral infection which is spread from person to person.

Symptoms of influenza include fever, headache, sore throat, body aches and a severe and often prolonged cough.


Health Officer Nancy Koblis encourages all Linden residents age 60 and older and all Linden residents with chronic illnesses to be vaccinated against Seasonal Influenza. EPICOR AND MERCER RECOGNIZED AS OSHA STAR SITE BY US DEPT. OF LABOR

This is recognition for employers and employees who demonstrate exemplary achievement in the prevention and control of occupational safety and health hazards as well as development, implementation the and continuous improvement of their safety and health management system.

Epicor was first advanced to the Voluntary Protection Program (VPP) Star level in 1996. Star is the highest level of VPP participation. There are currently 2,337 VPP Sites in the United States and 138 VPP Sites in OSHA Region 2 (New York and New Jersey). Of the 138 VPP Sites currently in Region 2, Epicor is the 18th longest participating VPP site (since 1996). Richard Brown, Manager of VPP, praised Epicor's commitment to safety and called this "a

Rose Bussiculo President of Epicor had this to day during the award presentation "You can lose a sale, that's only money, but if you lose a life or a limb, that's irreplaceable."

The VPP recognizes private and federal work sites with effective safety and health management systems that have maintained injury and illness rates below national Bureau of Labor Statistics averages. Management, labor and OSHA work cooperatively and proactively to prevent fatalities, injuries and illnesses through a system focused on hazard prevention and control, work site analysis and training. Union support is required for applicant work sites where employees are represented by a bargaining unit. Participating work sites are exempt from OSHA programmed inspections while they maintain their VPP status.


