SCOTT KLINDER ELECTED MAYOR BY BOROUGH COUNCIL

Scott Klinder was elected Mayor by the Kenilworth Borough Council at their April 9th, 2014 public meeting. As Council President Klinder automatically became acting Mayor when Kathi Fiamingo resigned in April. Klinder was then voted on by the full council at their next public meeting. Former councilman Kevin Leary was also sworn in at the April 9th meeting to fulfill the remainder of Klinder's term.

The mayor's seat will be placed on the ballot of the 2014 General Election. The winner of the election will serve the remainder of Kathi Fiamingo's term, which expires on December 31, 2015. Klinder has stated that he will not be seeking election. It is not known who will be seeking the mayor's seat. Candidates have until the first week of September to file with the county clerk.

Scott Klinder was born and raised in Kenilworth. He attended Harding Elementary School and David Brearley High School, and graduated from both. Later he attended Rutgers University and received a BA Degree.

Scott has been a homeowner in Kenilworth for almost twenty years. He has been a member of the NJ State Park Police for more than twenty years. He currently holds the rank of Lieutenant. Scott also volunteered with the Kenilworth Rescue Squad from 1999 through 2004.

He was elected to council in 2009 and has chaired the Health, Education and Welfare Committees. He also manages the town's Senior Citizen Handyman Program. Scott is also a member of the DPW and Police Committees.

Mayor Klinder and his wife Urszula have three children, Annabell age 10, Dylan age 3, and Allyson age 4 months.

MIDDLE-HIGH SCHOOL BUILDS ITS SERVICE LEARNING PROGRAM

Lost in the national school reform discussion has been the dedication of some middle-high schools to engaging adolescents in service-learning projects. Service learning is a method of teaching that combines classroom instruction with meaningful community service. This form of learning emphasizes critical thinking and personal reflection while encouraging a heightened sense of community, civic engagement, and personal responsibility. While standardized tests have become the eminent measure of school success, educational policymakers have overlooked the importance of compelling young adults to give back to their community.

Brearley Middle-High School has renewed its effort to teach kids how to help their local and regional communities and to point out to them why it is important to be contributory members of society. For instance, students in

the Kenilworth Scholars Academy are required to complete hours of service learning before graduating from the program. Three "branches" of philanthropy these students must pursue are "Stewardship" (fund raising, volunteering, getting involved in civic government, etc.), "Ingenuity" (conducting workshops, research, etc.), and "Enterprise" (tutoring, babysitting, etc.). The Academy's sophomores, led by teacher Joseph Pickton, recently picked up tremendous recognition at Kean University for its efforts, being awarded the Bronze Award for its service-learning project.

Kenilworth's schools will continue to address the needs of the "whole child" and not just his/her academic needs. I invite the local community to contact Brearley Middle-High School (908-931-9696) to find out how businesses, non-profits and government agencies can become a part of the school's service learning efforts.

RELAY FOR LIFE OF KENILWORTH WILL TAKE PLACE ON SATURDAY MAY 31, 2014

The American Cancer Society's Relay For Life of Kenilworth will take place on Saturday May 31, 2014 at David Brearley High School. This is a 12-hour long, overnight event which begins at 6:00 pm and concludes at 6:00 am. Teams have been busy raising funds at different events around town in the lead up to the event, and there are still opportunities to join in and donate.

Relay For Life is an overnight fundraising event to increase awareness and funding for cancer research. An evening of progress and hope, Relay For Life celebrates

survivors, remembers loved ones lost and helps in the fight against cancer. Relay For Life is open to teams and volunteers from all towns; teams camp out and take turns

walking around a track all night long making the statement that cancer never sleeps so neither will its volunteers.

During the last century, the Cancer Society has led the way in saving lives and creating

more birthdays. Today, 2 out of 3 people diagnosed with cancer are surviving (for at least five years). In fact, more than 400 people a day in the US are celebrating birthdays that would have otherwise been lost to the disease. We've contributed to a 20 percent decline in cancer death rates in the US since the early 1990s. That means we've helped save nearly 1.2 million lives during that time. We've played a role in nearly every cancer research breakthrough in recent history. Our work has helped lead to a 50 percent drop in smoking since the 1960s, which has contributed to a drop in overall lung cancer death rates.

This May, Gallery-on-the Boulevard at the Kenilworth Public Library will feature the work of photographer Rosemary Hampp in, “Superstorm Sandy – An Artist’s Perspective.” In designing this exhibit, Hampp was inspired by a quote from Winston Churchill: “We shall draw from the heart of suffering itself the means of inspiration and survival.”



“Even though Superstorm Sandy had such a strong and devastating impact on many lives, there is still beauty if we look for it,” Ms. Hampp wrote in a statement describing her show. “The photographs attempt to evoke the feeling that we are forever changed but will continue to move forward.”

Ms. Hampp’s photographs document the widespread destruction caused by the now-infamous 2012 storm, which left ruined homes and fractured landscapes in its wake. Yet the images, enhanced, enlarged and reproduced on metallic paper, show signs of growth and rebirth. The results are stunning, as Ms. Hampp’s trained use of color and composition evokes both beauty and resilience.

Growing up in Union, NJ, Ms. Hampp developed a passion for photography in the ninth grade and progressed to working a basement darkroom, where she spent hours developing film and making black and white prints. Photography took a back seat to college and career, but occasionally resurfaced over the

years. In recent years, Ms. Hampp’s newfound interest in technology has renewed her interest in the medium.

“Several years ago I went kicking and screaming into the world of digital photography, and soon realized its potential,” Ms. Hampp wrote. “Expanding my skills in the digital darkroom helped me take my images to the next level.”

“Superstorm Sandy – An Artist’s Perspective” will be on display from May 1 through June 30. Works displayed will be available for purchase. The Kenilworth Public Library is located at 548 Boulevard. J. Sterling Morton organized the first Arbor Day in 1872 in Nebraska where over one million trees were planted across the state. In 1884, New Jersey held its first official Arbor Day celebration. Arbor Day is officially celebrated on the last Friday in April.

Children and their families had an opportunity to learn about the importance of trees in our environment through interactive activities which included viewing various items made of wood, cork, and rubber. Children made leaf rubbings of

various types of leaves, and viewed tree cookies which are cross sections of tree trunks used to illustrate how trees grow.



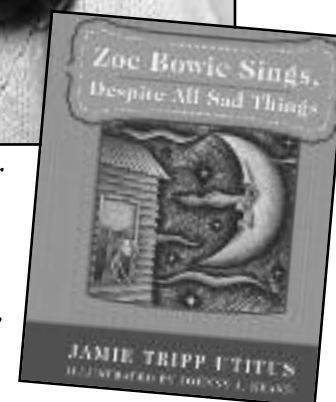

“OGDEN DAY” CELEBRATES 350TH ANNIVERSARY OF ELIZABETHTOWN

On Saturday, March 29th, the 350th Anniversary of Elizabethtown, today's Union County, was celebrated with "Ogden Day". The Ogden family was the major founding family of this first permanent British settlement in New Jersey, called Elizabethtown. Kenilworth was part of this first beginning of New Jersey in 1664, which encompassed today's Union County. "Elizabethtown became New Jersey's first capital from 1668 to 1686", states Dorothea Krihak.

The 350th anniversary committee held the event at the First Presbyterian Church in today's Elizabeth with American Revolutionary War reenactors from the 1st New Jersey Regiment of Colonial Matthias Ogden. American Revolutionary War talks of Elizabethtown first took place at this church, which acted as a meeting house for the patriot citizenry of Elizabethtown, which also, along with the Ogden family, included General William Livingston who became our first governor of New Jersey when we declared our independence from England on July 4, 1776.

This 1st Presbyterian Church was the "old first church as it was also known as prior to the war itself. It was burned down in early 1780, just prior to the Battle of Connecticut Farms by the British. A new church was set up at Connecticut Farms, which became the new "Meeting House". Kenilworth was part of this first settlement in 1664, where New Jersey began.

Kenilworth was, in 1667, named Connecticut Farms, a village suburb of Elizabethtown, along with the township of Union. Wm. Livingston lived in the Union Section of Connecticut Farms. The Halsey name is also mentioned as participating in the war. Adj. Luther Halsey was

another member of the first old church whose families had ties to Connecticut Farms in Kenilworth. The colonial Halsey Farm, became the old Kenilworth Inn. There is a Halsey Street in Kenilworth. Along with Halsey, another church member was Pvt. Ephraim Sayre, a Kenilworth Sayre family member who were also related to the Ogden family. Daniel Sayre built and lived in today's Sayre/Locorriere/Shallcross house in Kenilworth on Springfield Road. Some land from this historic homestead, which had a carriage house, barns and sheds became today's Black Brook Park. The pond at Black Brook Park is named the Shallcross Pond after this house. The Sayre family were the largest landowners in Elizabethtown. The County of Union has placed a Union County Seal at the 19th street entrance o e here where the great efforts of our farmers held off a large British army of 5,000 troops marching through Connecticut Farms via Galloping Hill Road and Springfield Road, next to today's Black Brook Park, to keep the British, who were headed to

Morristown, from capturing General Washington who was in Morristown, NJ on June 7, 1780, and ending the war with a British victory. There were other routes through Connecticut Farm taken by the five regiments during this battle, but none of these British soldiers made it passed the Connecticut Farms borders.

There are 350th Anniversary events scheduled for June 6, 7 and 8th to commemorate this great battle at Liberty Hall and historic walking trails from Elizabethtown. For more information about upcoming events please visit www.goelizabethnj.com.

"Don't forget, our first fire chief was Andrew Ogden." States Krihak, who is a past vice present of the Kenilworth Historical Society. She went on to establish the Friends of Black Brook Park in 2001. 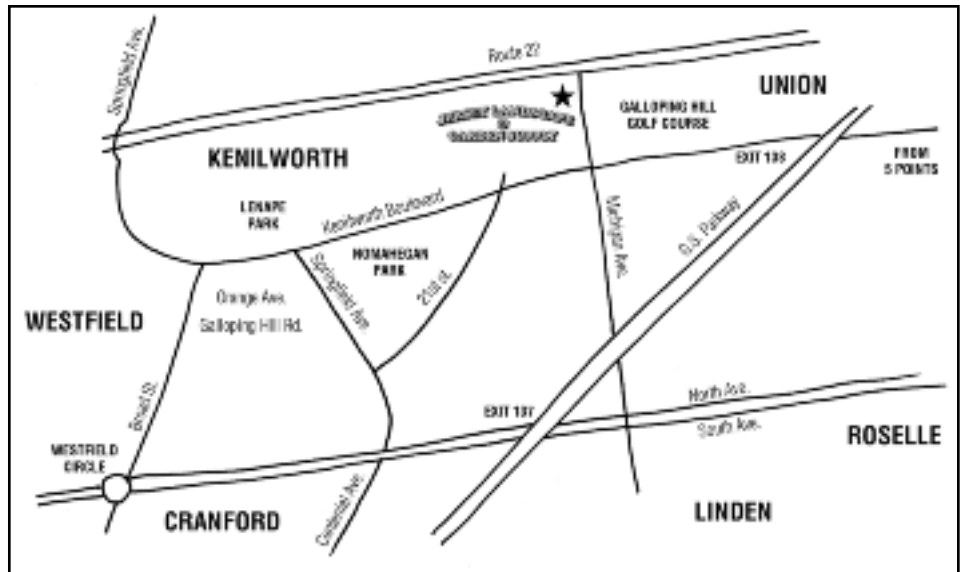

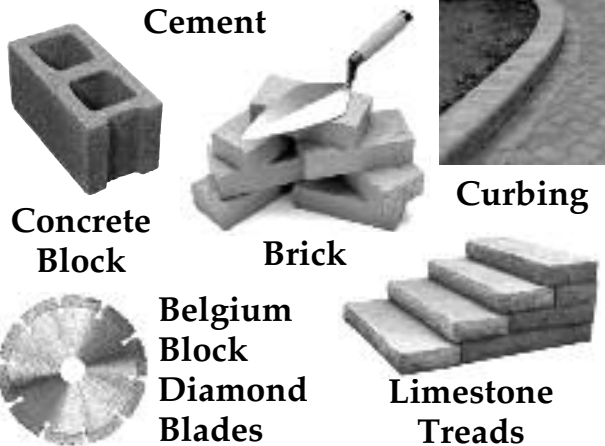
