The festivities opened at 11:30 am with a ribbon cutting ceremony by Mayor Sal Bonaccorso and Town Council members Pat O'Connor, Al Barr, and newly appointed Marie Soyka. Bonaccorso thanked Recreation Director Ralph Bernardo, Manager of the Pool Mike Kozlowski and the members of the Clark Pool Advisory Board. He said, "I think today it (Clark Pool) is the best it's ever been under the wonderful leadership of this volunteer board. The thing they always come back to me and the Council for is about making the pool better for all of you. Have a wonderful summer, and maybe we'll see each other in another 40 years."

More than 1,200 people were in attendance on a beautiful summer day to enjoy the many special activities taking place to celebrate the occasion. Float races, a penny find in the baby pool, a giant floating obstacle course, balloon animals, a DJ, and at the end of the day the LEGO movie was shown on an outdoor screen.

Free hot dogs and hamburgers, watermelon, cotton candy and sno-cones were available all day. Later in the day two sheet birthday cakes were enjoyed by all. All members enjoyed free giveaways as they entered the pool and every pool member had the opportunity to win over 25 door prizes including gift certificates from various businesses in the area.



Members were able to see a large assortment of original newspapers and photographs from 1974 covering the grand opening of the pool. Also on display were the original blue prints and the estimated invoice to build the pool - \$374,000.

Recreation Director Ralph Bernardo said that memberships to the pool are still available for the season. Membership is not limited to Clark residents and he encouraged anyone who wanted to visit the pool to stop by for a tour. FOURTH GRADERS HOLD INTERGENERATIONAL PUBLISHING PARTY FOR "CLARK CHRONICLES"

The scene in the auditorium of Arthur L. Johnson High School was one of excitement, reminiscing, renewing old friendships, and sharing an appreciation for growing up in Clark over the generations.

Miss Nicole Parlavecchio, fourth grade teacher at the Frank K. Hehly School in Clark, facilitated the culminating activity of an exciting

year-long initiative that involved interviewing, writing, publishing, and presenting an oral history of life in the Township of Clark. This culminating activity involved the fourth graders reading the biographies aloud of the Clark resident, past or present, they had written, and presenting the interviewee with a published copy of "Clark Chronicles" a bound copy containing the students' biographies of their interviewees.

Starting this past October, Miss Parlavecchio and her class began soliciting volunteers for their project. Those interested in participating were contacted, and invited into the classroom for a class interview. Various long time, former, and current Clark residents were interviewed in-depth about their recollections about growing up in Clark. The interviews provided the impressionable nine and ten year-olds with a primary source account of life in Clark over the past half century. Each student was assigned to a particular resident and presided over that person's interview. Using information gleaned from the interviews, each student then set out to write a biography of their assigned person. When all biographies were written, those interviewed provided both a vintage picture of their childhood in Clark, as well as a current photo. These pictures were then published with the biographies. All the biographies were then

professionally bound into a collection titled "Clark Chronicles."

At the publishing party, many anecdotes, remembrances, and memories were shared of those interviewed. Matt Casey was the first person to step inside the new Burger King, Mary Arrowood inadvertently walked out the wrong door of her school and ended up walking home alone the distance of one-half mile on her first day of Kindergarten, and Valerie Boyle and her brother would race pigeons!

After the publishing party had concluded and each interviewed person had received their bound copy of "Clark Chronicles," students, parents, and interviewees adjointed to the library for refreshments. There, in an intergenerational setting, friendships were renewed and current fourth graders developed a special appreciation of the uniqueness of their town.

Commenting on the success of the "Clark Chronicles" project, Superintendent of Schools Kenneth Knops remarked, "I wish to express my gratitude to teacher Nicole Parlavecchio; our fourth grade students; and the residents, current and former, who came together to make this a magical experience. The cherished memories of those who grew up in Clark will be forever memorialized in "Clark Chronicles" and make a new generation of Clark residents aware of what a very special place they are growing up in."

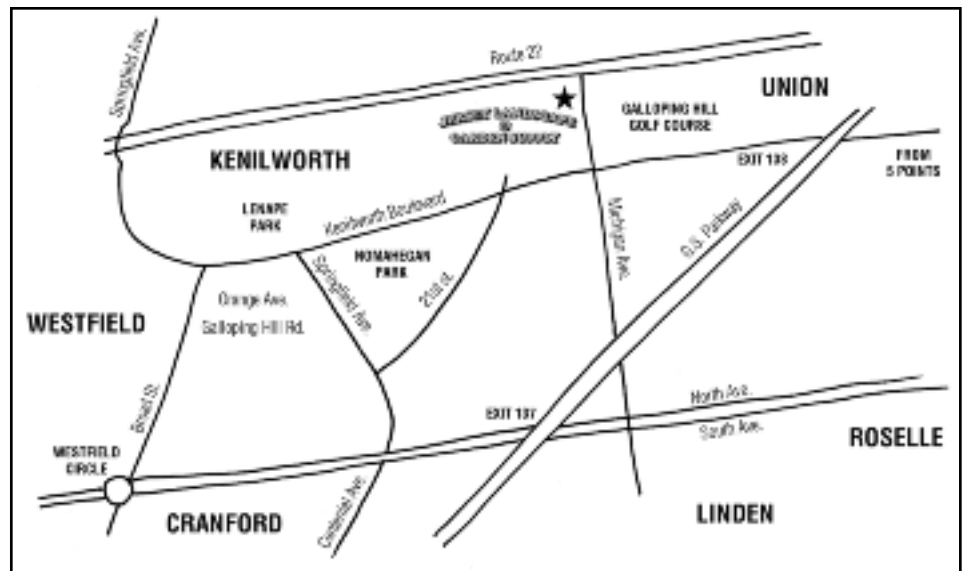

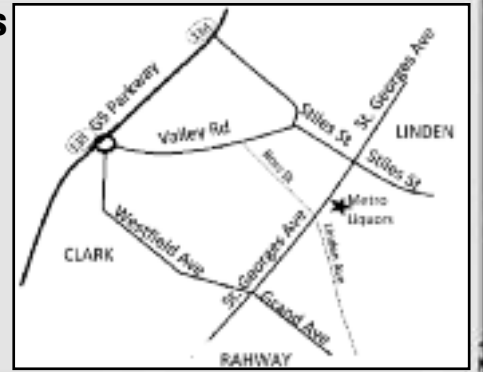
