# RACHEAL JOHNSON BREAKS 18-YEAR-OLD ARTHUR L. JOHNSON HIGH SCHOOL SHOT-PUT RECORD AT UNION COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP MEET

Racheal Johnson recently broke an 18-year-old Arthur L. Johnson High School record in the shot-put. The record was formerly held by Marjana Banic in 1997 with a throw of 39' 11 1/2". Ironically, Coach Banic, a former Crusader Throws coach and current Coach for the Westfield Blue Devils, was at the County meet when it was broken. "Records are meant to be broken," said Banic, who also owns the discus record at Johnson High School. "The torch has been handed over. The scary thing is, with all of Racheal's ability and a great coaching staff in Coach Anthony DelConte and Coach Christopher DiNucci, the sky is the limit for Racheal as she is only a Junior and has an entire

year left to improve."

The Junior thrower let the record setting throw fly on her third throw of the meet prior to finals.

Coach Anthony DelConte stated "Racheal really bought into the field events this winter season and is one of our hardest workers. She has all the characteristics of a great athlete and young adult, and she fits right into the great group of athletes that we have at ALJ. She had her mind set that she wanted to leave her mark on the program, which she did, yet she still strives to do more. I am extremely happy for her, and am excited to see what her future at ALJ holds."

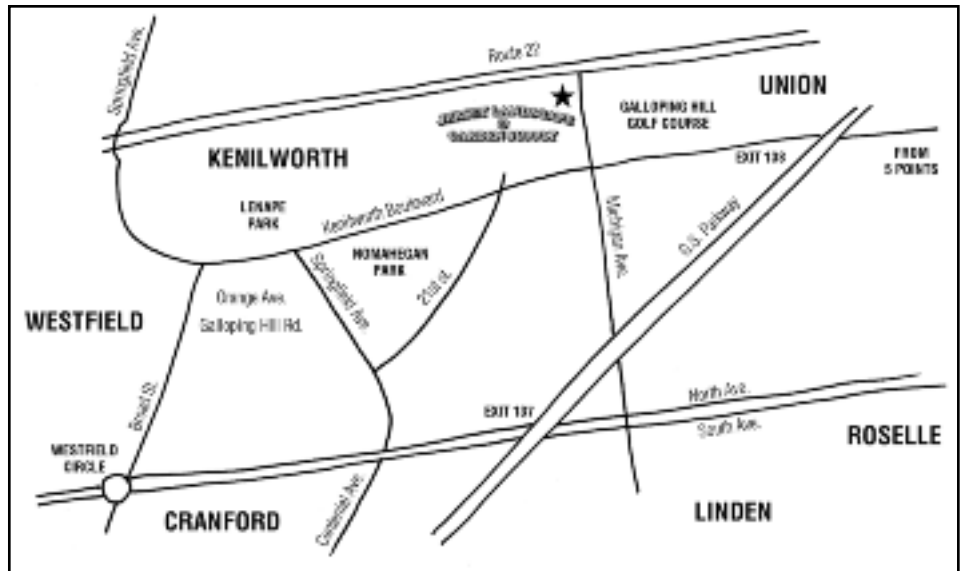

## RADIO FREQUENCY CHANGE TO 590 AM

Due to the construction of a high powered commercial radio station that is being put into service in the New York City area which will be transmitting on the 1700 AM frequency, the local radio station presently utilized by the Township of Clark will be overcome and we will no longer be able to be heard on that frequency. Based on that situation the Township has obtained a new radio license from the FCC and we will start to operate on the frequency of 590 AM in the next few months. We are presently in the process of obtaining the necessary equipment that will be needed to make this transition happen and will keep you informed as to the schedule of when the actual changeover will occur.

We are also in the process of upgrading the station capabilities for increasing the message recording time from 15 minutes to 3 hours which will greatly improve the ability to put additional information on the air concerning Township information and events on both the regular schedule and in emergency situations. We are also hoping to be able to put in an audio connection into the radio station which will allow us to feed the audio part of the TV 36 station into the radio system. In this way, when the township officials are doing a broadcast on TV 36 during an emergency event, people will be able to receive important information by utilizing a battery powered radio to listen to 590 AM even if they don't have electrical power to watch the program on TV 36.

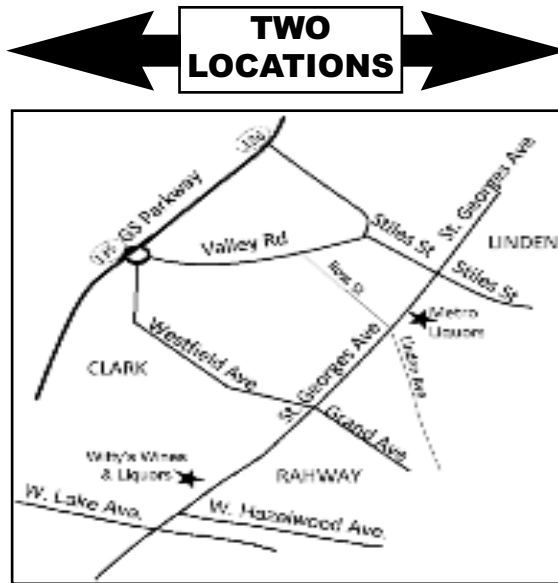

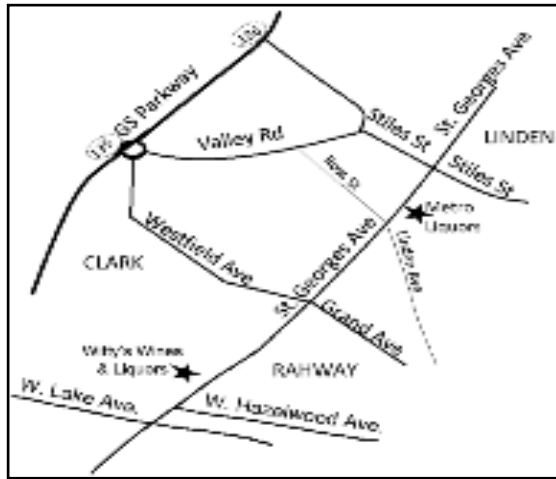
