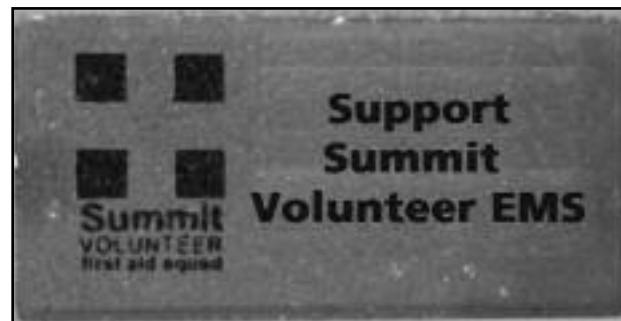

ANNUAL SCHOOL SUPPLIES DRIVE, MAY 16-20

For the eighth year, the Christ Child Society of Summit and Bridges Outreach are working together to collect next year's school supplies for the approximately 500 children in need in the Summit Public Schools. There will be collection bins during the week of May 16-20 by the main offices of all of the Summit public schools, at the entrances to St. Teresa's Church and Memorial Hall, and at 36 Woodland Avenue in Summit. "For many families in Summit, it is difficult to afford the high cost of the many school supplies needed each year. Donating supplies is an easy and thoughtful way for our community to help these families, and to give these children a fresh start to the new school year," commented Sally Golding and Jane Murphy, CCS Co-Chairs.

Residents can help by donating some of the following new items: 1", 2", and 3" Binders, 3-hole Pencil Cases, Subject Dividers, 2-Pocket Folders, Marble Composition Books, Loose Leaf Paper (wide and college ruled), Spiral Notebooks (wide and college ruled), 8-Pack Colored Pencils or Thin Markers, #2 Pencils and Erasers, Pens (Blue, Black & Red), Highlighters, 3 x 5 lined Notecards and Glue Sticks.

In August last year, the Christ Child Society and Bridges provided 353 elementary, middle and high school children in Summit, eligible for free or reduced lunch, with new backpacks and school supplies. Parents were able to take the financial resources that would have been used for school supplies to pay for food, rent, and other necessities. The Christ Child Society is a

non-profit association of volunteers dedicated to serving at-risk children in the area. Bridges is an outreach program for the homeless delivering food, clothing, toiletries, and other necessities to those who are homeless or in need in New York City, Newark, and Irvington every week and opens its doors to neighbors in need every Friday. 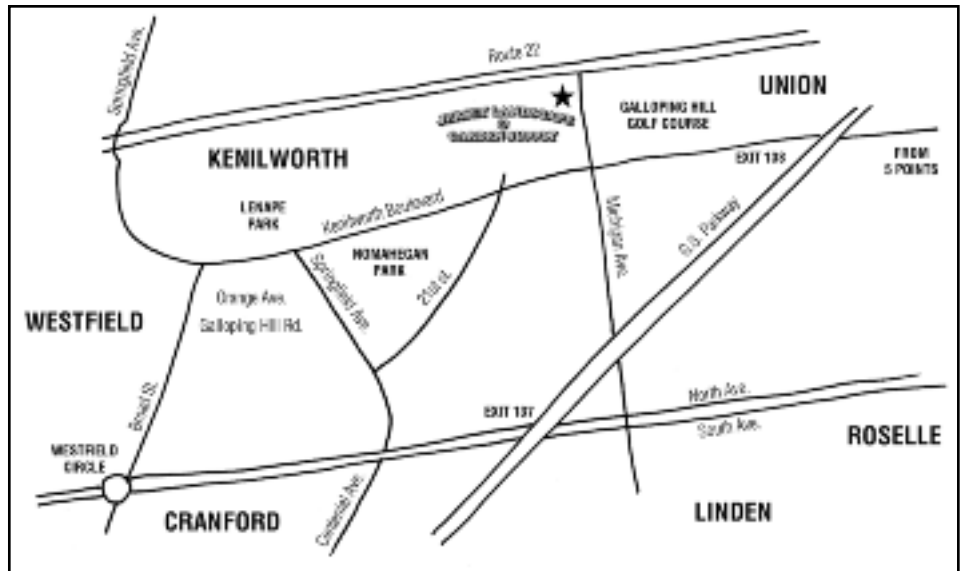

CITY PURCHASES AEDS FOR ALL MUNICIPAL SPORTS FIELDS

The City of Summit is announcing the inclusion of automatic external defibrillator (AED) equipment on all municipal sports fields as part of its emergency action plan to protect the safety of athletes, spectators, coaches and officials in the event of a medical emergency.

An AED is a lightweight, portable, battery-operated, computerized device that is used to restore a regular heartbeat after sudden cardiac arrest caused by undiagnosed heart problems. AEDs are designed to allow non-medical personnel to save lives.

During a cardiac emergency, two pads connected to the AED are placed on the patient's

chest. A computer inside the AED analyzes the patient's heart rhythm and determines if an electric shock to the heart is required to save the victim. If so, the AED uses voice instructions to guide the user through the defibrillation process.

As long as an AED is turned on, it is designed to be next to foolproof. It will not prompt the operator to go to the next step until the previous step has been completed and provides a logical, well-defined, and well-documented sequence of directions. Further, the AED will not allow a shock to be administered unless the person is actually in cardiac arrest.

While it is not mandated by state law for recreation departments to have outdoor AED equipment available on athletic fields, the City of Summit chose to follow recent schools legislation and require AEDs at all athletic games and practices.

In early 2016, the City of Summit Department of Community Programs received approval for the use of Field Restoration funds to purchase 13 AEDs that will be strategically placed in locations at Investors Bank Field, Glenside Field, Upper Tatlock Field, Memorial Field, Village

Green, Summit High School, Summit Middle School and all five elementary schools. The placement of each AED, designed with a red flag and highly visible markings, will allow for no greater than a 90-second response time to a potential victim on each field. All recreation and youth sports coaches will receive training on how to operate the equipment. Most CPR classes offer additional training in the use of an AED. If someone is already trained in CPR, training on the use of an AED takes even less time. In the state of New Jersey, Good Samaritan legislation protects all lay rescuers from lawsuits.

The City Department of Community Programs will be performing monthly visual inspections to help keep AEDs in proper working order. Citizens are asked to report any equipment that appears inoperable or damaged, or is sounding an alarm to www.cityofsummit.org/reportaconcern or call the Department of Community Programs at 908-277-2932.

3 SUMMIT RESIDENTS BECOME CASA VOLUNTEERS

Union County Superior Court Judge Daniel R. Lindemann last month administered oaths to 16 community members who stepped up to serve as extra eyes and ears for family court judges on cases involving abused, neglected or abandoned children currently in foster care. Among them were Summit's own Cheryl Barr, Rose Franco and Craig Grosswald.

CASA volunteers have court-ordered access to all parties in a child's life, including foster parents, doctors, caseworkers, therapists and teachers, and incorporate into court reports findings from these contacts, as well as, observations from time spent with the youth.

Volunteers advocate both in the community and in court to ensure that while the youth is awaiting a safe and permanent home, their needs are met, their best interests are priority and their time in care is as short as possible.

There are currently 600 Union County children in foster care; the nonprofit serves approximately one-quarter of those youth and its mission is to provide a volunteer advocate for every child in care. CASA of Union County trains three times a year. 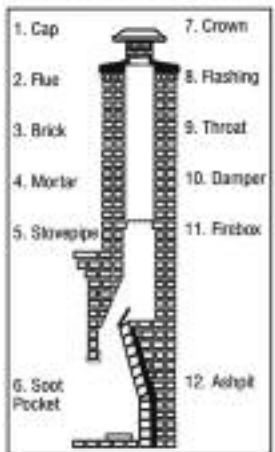

LET THE RHYTHMS TRANSPORT YOU AT NJIO'S SUNDAY CONCERT MAY 15

Musicians and audience members alike will be “Dancing to a New Beat” at New Jersey Intergenerational Orchestra’s concert on Sunday May 15, 2016 at 3:00 p.m. at Summit High School. The concert features noted guitarist, Joel Perry, performing the hauntingly beautiful guitar *Concierto de Aranjuez* by Spanish composer Rodrigo in a program that includes lively music from Russian to Romania and back to the Latino rhythms of Cuba. All three NJIO ensembles and orchestras will perform, each consisting of amateur and professional musicians of all ages. Admission is free.

Joel Perry, a highly esteemed guitarist, has performed in over fifteen countries and in Carnegie Hall, Alice Tully Hall, and The Rainbow Room. He is a member of the National Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences, the National Association of Jazz Educators, Music Educators National Conference, and American Choral Directors Association.

NJIO’s Symphony Orchestra, led by Maestro Warren Cohen, will begin the program with Sergei Prokofiev’s *Sinfonietta*, a rarely

performed work that is light in character while infusing Prokofiev’s typical harmonic twists. The program continues with the *Concierto de Aranjuez* by Spanish composer Joaquín Rodrigo, a work inspired by the gardens at Palacio Real de Aranjuez that evokes the sounds of nature, transporting listeners to another place and time. Be sure to arrive to the concert half an hour early to enjoy a short, but delightful serenade by NJIO’s *Prelude Ensemble*, led by conductor Robert Anderson.

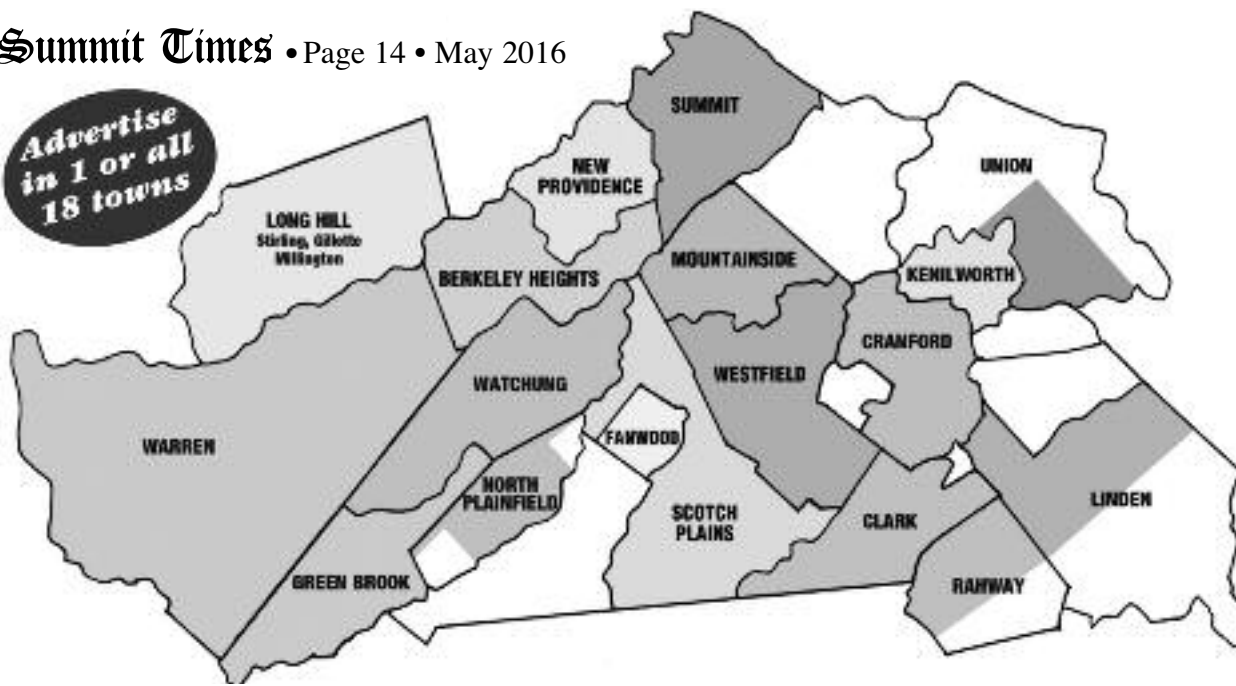
