The Parade is sponsored by the American Legion Martin Wallberg Post #3 and the Town of Westfield. Duty, honor and country are not just words to a West Point graduate. They are a way of life!

Born in Philadelphia, Peter moved to Westfield with his family in 1948. He attended school here and graduated Westfield High School in 1961. His sport of choice during high school was football. Peter attended prep school at the Manlius School in upstate New York. He was accepted into the U.S. Military Academy at West Point where he graduated in 1966. At West Point he lettered in football. As a key member of the West Point football team he is most proud of Army's win against Navy in the 1964 Army Navy game. The Navy Team was led by its Heisman Trophy winning quarterback Roger Staubach. This stunning victory by Army made headlines across the country. Five of the Army starters played both offense and defense. A book published in 2014 written by Nicolaus Mills, "Every Army Man is with You" tells the story of this memorable victory, the men who made it happen and their path from the gridiron to the Vietnam War then home again.

Peter served at Fort Carson in Colorado, and then went to Quang Tri Province in Vietnam where he was an advisor to the South Vietnam Military. His final year in the service he became an assistant football coach at West Point.

After serving his country, he left the service in 1970 at the rank of Captain to start his civilian

areer.

Peter currently resides in Mountainside with his wife of twelve years, Lucille. Peter's brother, Michael, is an attorney in Chicago and his sister, Shelley, is a retired school teacher in Bridgewater, New Jersey. Peter has three children, Christina, Lindsey and Heather.

Peter began his career in institutional equities with Bear Stern where he focused on national money managers. He retired from there in 2010 as a managing director. Peter is currently associated with Financial Capital Management in business development.

To use Peter's words "I am deeply humbled to be selected as this year's Grand Marshal honoring the men and women veterans who made the supreme sacrifice for the freedoms we, Americans, hold so dearly."







KEAN TO HOST SEMINAR ON THE INTERNET OF THINGS

The rapid expansion of digital technology has led businesses and consumers alike to question their security. On Thursday, June 8, the Cybersecurity Center at Kean University and the Union County Small Business Development Center will co-host The Internet of Things (IoT), a free seminar exploring the vast array of networked devices that surround us and the associated risks, from 7:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. David Weinstein, New Jersey's first Chief Technology Officer, will deliver the keynote address at the event.

"Small businesses use technology to increase productivity and capabilities. Just imagine how loosing control over these necessities can set them back?" said David Margulies, Director, Union County SBDC at Kean University. "We all need to be well versed on how to best mitigate this risk to ensure business continuity."

The Internet of Things refers to the diverse array of networked devices, ranging from cars and kitchen appliances to heart monitors, able to collect and exchange data through embedded sensors. The seminar will explore potential risks the IoT poses to small businesses and best practices for securing networked devices.

"While smart devices and systems are making life easier for users, the steady adoption of the Internet of Things and the integration of more smart systems into critical infrastructures are making industries and consumers more vulnerable to attacks—possibly with life-threatening repercussions," said Walter Rant, Managing Assistant Director, Cybersecurity Center at Kean University.

David Weinstein was appointed New Jersey's first ever Chief Technology Officer by Governor Chris Christie in June of 2016. Weinstein serves in Governor Christie's cabinet, oversees the New Jersey Office of Information Technology (OIT), and is responsible for developing and implementing strategic policies, information security standards, and requirements for all state departments and agencies.
