AUTISM NJ CHECKS PRESENTED IN FANWOOD

A Fanwood family's hard work and dedication in supporting people with autism came to a crescendo on June 6, 2017 when they presented a check for \$13,500 to Autism New Jersey at an event held at Sheelen's Crossing on South Avenue.

The proceeds from April's Rockin For Autism fair in Fanwood, along with additional online donations, totaled \$13,500 and were presented by the Banks family, led by 15-year old Mallory Banks who's been raising money for autism causes in the name of her brother, Ethan, who has autism, for a number of years. With the support of their parents, Gina and Jeff Banks, they staged the outdoor fair at LaGrande Park for a second year in a row, drawing crowds second only to the Fanny Wood Day street fair.

The Fanwood Police Benevolent Association Local 123 also donated \$200 to Autism NJ and a check was presented by PBA Treasurer, Officer Dan Kranz, and Lt. Frank Marrerro, Fanwood PD.





CODE CLUB GRADUATES 13 PARK SCHOL GIRLS

The Park Middle School Girls Who Code Club graduated 13 coders from their 2016-2017 class. Throughout the academic year, girls from grades 5 through 8 met once a week after school and were introduced to computer science concepts. The club year concludes with a "CS (Computer Science) Impact Project," where they design, build, and test code they developed applying computer science concepts to solve a problem relevant to the classroom and community. This year's club community-focused problem was bullying.

At their club graduation held on June 6th, coders from Park Middle School, initially having minimal to no exposure to computer science, showcased 8 CS Impact Projects that were created using Scratch and Python. Each project

adopted a unique approach bringing attention to anti-bullying in their community, raising situational awareness through interactive animations, quizzes, and games coded by club members

To complete the project, Club members learned the Core4 computer science concepts throughout the academic year that form the basis for all computer programming languages, loops, variables, conditionals, and functions.

Girls Who Code is a national non-profit organization working to close the gender gap in technology. Girls Who Code is leading the movement to inspire, educate, and equip young women with the computing skills to pursue 21st century careers.

A few facts about underage use of alcohol and the law:

It is a criminal offense in New Jersey to serve

alcohol to anyone who is under the legal age of 21 and to make your home or property available for the purpose of allowing minors a place to consume alcohol.

New Jersey's Social Host Liability Law imposes civil penalties on social hosts who serve alcohol to anyone who is under the legal age of 21. The same law imposes civil penalties on social hosts who serve alcohol to minors who subsequently are involved in incidents causing death or injury.


