DOGGY DIP AT SUMMIT FAMILY AQUATIC CENTER

The Summit Department of Community Programs is announcing the third annual Doggy Dip will take place on Saturday, September 9 at the Summit Family Aquatic Center, located at 100 Ashwood Avenue. The event is open to Summit residents and non-residents. The rain date is Sunday, September 10.

The fee to attend is \$10 per dog for Summit residents and \$15 per dog for non-residents. Small dogs (under 20 lbs.) can swim from 9 to 9:45AM, followed by medium dogs (20 to 50lbs) from 10 to 10:45AM. There will be two swimming sessions for large dogs (over 50lbs), from 11 to 11:45AM and 12 to 12:45PM. A maximum of 40 dogs per size group is allowed, with two groups for large dogs.

Interested participants should register online with a credit card prior to the event using Community Pass. Walk-ins are welcome as space allows, and can pay with cash or check only. All participants will be required to sign a waiver at check-in.

All dogs must be accompanied by at least one owner who is 18 years of age or older. Dogs must be six months of age or older, current on all vaccinations, and have a valid license tag. Please note that there is no human swimming during the Doggy Dip.



THE DEBARY INN; FOUNDED ON RICH HISTORY WITH A PASSION FOR LUXURIOUS HOSPITALITY

The DeBary Inn was acquired in 2009 by Joseph Riela and a group of Summit-based business partners and is now managed by Joseph Riela, Louis Helfer and one of the city's most recognizable citizens, Jim Cramer. The group of investors began their journey to revive the interior infrastructure and furnishings, thereby establishing sixteen unique guest rooms and maintaining the 1880s architectural charm, all while offering luxurious modern conveniences. Primary focus was set on complimenting "Downtown Summit" by reviving and re-opening the Inn.

DeBary History: Baron Fredrick DeBary was born in Rheims, France in 1815. At the age of 25 he sailed to America at the behest of the Mumm 'Champagne' family to be their American agent. The timing was right and DeBary went on to become the largest wine importer in America. After years of continued success, Fredrick's son Adolphe took over the American business at the age of 27.

The mansion's history begins in 1871 when Adolphe DeBary, married Augusta Cecil, a young woman from Summit. The couple went on to have 3 children and constructed the vast estate in 1880. The mansion was described by a local paper as "one of the largest showplaces in Summit", known specifically for "its size, beauty, and elaborateness". The original estate was over

3.5 acres including several separate buildings, extensive gardens, and stables for six horses.

In 1906 the DeBary family moved out of Summit and the estate was later sold in 1916 to a development company. A road was established through the property, presently called 'Debary Place', and remaining grounds were subdivided into residential lots. The three-story Victorian was then moved over 200 feet to its present location with frontage along the present 'Springfield Avenue', now home to the majority of the City's finest restaurants, small-business, and specialty shops.

In 1923 the DeBary's former home began offering lodging and was called "The Hobart Hotel" but renamed in 1941 to "The DeBary", honoring the original family. Paul and Peggy Brown acquired the property in 1977 and opened "The DeBary Guest House", specializing in lodging for 14 senior citizens, and later evolving to provide for various Summit residents facing hardship. The Brown Family of Summit put the property up for sale in 2006, and was then purchased by Anita and Hill Rose, also Summit residents, until the present ownership change in 2009.





2017 SUMMIT POLICE YOUTH ACADEMY GRADUATES 58 CADETS

The Summit Police Department is announcing the conclusion of the thirteenth season of its Youth Academy, an increasingly popular program designed to provide area youth with the opportunity to gain an understanding of the role of the police officer. A total of 58 cadets graduated during two separate ceremonies which were attended by family members, Mayor Nora Radest, Police Chief Robert Weck, and various council members.

Ranging in age from 11 to 14, the cadets experience the same types of drills and physical training that men and women receive in today's police academies. In addition to receiving overviews of criminal investigations, evidence recovery and patrol tactics, the cadets are provided with hands-on scenario training in which they process crime scenes, conduct highrisk motor vehicle stops and even have an opportunity to experience some of the difficulties of emergency vehicle operation by driving golf carts alongside their instructor.

During their visit to the John H. Stamler Police Academy in Scotch Plains, the cadets utilized the same obstacle course used by police recruits, received unarmed self-defense instruction, and underwent firearms simulator training which demonstrates the split-second decisions that police officers must frequently make. The cadets also attended demonstrations from various specialized units that are available to law enforcement such as the Union County K-9 Unit, SWAT Team, Bomb Squad, and the Summit Fire Department.

"The mission of the Summit Police Youth Academy is to familiarize our area youth with the role of the police officer and provide them the opportunity to learn respect for the law, personal responsibility and the importance of teamwork, all through positive interaction with local police officers and exposure to the challenges of responsibility of police work," explains Summit Police Chief Robert Weck. "We are extremely proud of our graduates as well as the officers involved with the program. This year, 18 of our graduates participated in Summit's National Night Out Against Crime on August 1,

where they proudly wore their uniforms and demonstrated the drills they had learned."






