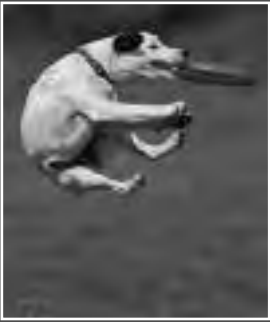

2017 WHRHS GRADUATION

Under brilliant mid-morning late-June skies, and in front of family, relatives, friends, administrators, teachers and each other, more than 540 students received their diplomas on Thursday, June 22, on the field in Tozier Stadium at the 60th Commencement of Watchung Hills Regional High School (WHRHS).

Principal George Alexis said humans are drawn to stories. "They delight us. They teach us. They touch our souls. They help us make sense of the world, and remind us we are part of a larger world."

A graduate of WHRHS himself, Alexis said the Class of 2017 had left its mark on the school, which first opened its doors to students in 1957. He urged the Class of 2017 to continue to reason critically, ask questions freely, solve problems, be curious, explore new ideas, forge their own narrative journeys boldly, and write their own stories. "Do your best," Alexis said.

He ended, quoting the late beloved Juan Carlos Cruz, the Spanish Teacher, soccer and track coach, cultural ambassador, mentor and friend who died unexpectedly and quite young in October. The quote is something many members of the Class of 2017 had heard Cruz say often, urging students to put everything into what they were doing. Alexis said, "As Señor Cruz would say, "Empty The Tank!"

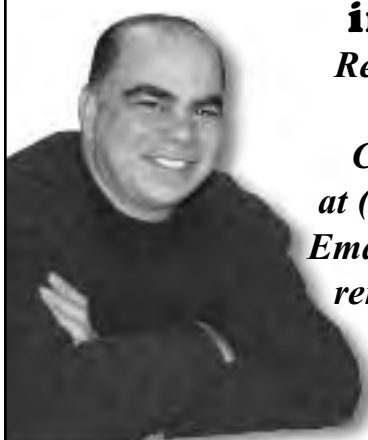

Student empowerment was not just on the agenda, it was the agenda Monday night, June 19, at “TEDx Youth@WHRHS, an independently organized TED event,” at Watchung Hills Regional High School.

The TEDx event, which was the brainchild of 2017 WHRHS graduate Vineet Parikh, championed student empowerment, innovation and inspiration. Youth@WHRHS was an example of immediate discussions about how student inspiration, innovation, and empowerment can be turned into real, everyday improvements for WHRHS.

According to the TED organization, TED is a nonprofit devoted to spreading ideas, usually in the form of short, powerful talks, 18 minutes or less. TED began in 1984 as a conference where Technology, Entertainment and Design (TED) converged, and today covers almost all topics — from science to business to global issues — in more than 100 languages. Meanwhile, independently run TEDx events help share ideas in communities around the world.

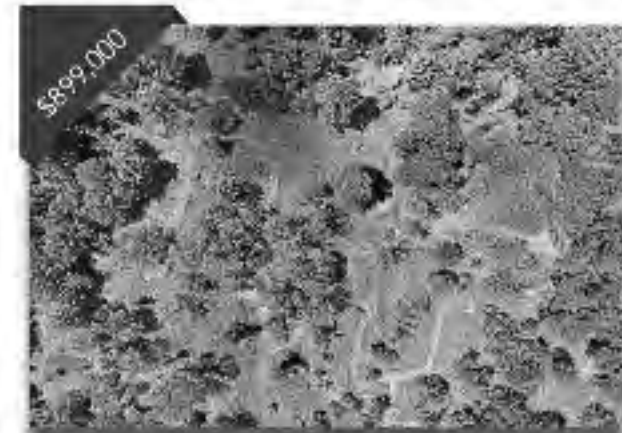

PROTECTING YOUR CREDIT; BEFORE DURING AND AFTER A DIVORCE

Unfortunately, at the time a divorce is finalized an individual can encounter new and unanticipated financial obligations. Any debt that was incurred during the marriage and will not be paid off at the time of divorce needs to be addressed in the parties' settlement agreement. It is important that any written settlement reached between the divorcing parties be thorough and clear as to which of the parties is responsible for a particular debt and how and when that person will satisfy that debt.

The entry of a divorce judgment does not alleviate the joint responsibility for a joint debt. As an example, should one party agree to pay the balance due on a joint credit card debt in its entirety, and then fail to subsequently do so, the credit card company can pursue its claim against both of the individuals named on the account. The creditor is not bound by any agreement made between the divorced parties.

Additionally if payments are late or not made, the Lender or the bank that provided the credit can report negative information to the credit reporting companies. This can affect not only the credit rating of the party who was responsible to make the payments but possibly the other party as well.

There are several steps that can be taken to help protect yourself and your credit before, during and after a divorce:

- In any divorce settlement, attempt to close or separate any type of joint account that exists or may have existed during the

marriage. Establish your own individual checking and savings account.

- Eliminate any joint debt between the two of you or minimize the debt as much as possible.
- If the other party is assuming ownership of jointly owned real estate, make certain that you are not responsible for any mortgages or other liens against the real estate in which you will no longer have an ownership interest.
- During the period of time when you are negotiating your divorce settlement with your spouse, be certain that payments are being made on all accounts even if they are the monthly minimum amounts due.
- If you have not established credit in your individual name during the marriage, it is a good idea to do so by obtaining even a small line of credit or credit card (even if a co-signer is necessary) and be certain to pay any and all charges on such an account on time. Once a repayment history is established you can seek an increase from the credit card company.
- Check your credit score and consider enrolling in credit monitoring to be certain there are no incorrect entries or changes in your score.

For some individuals, removing their shoes can be embarrassing because they suffer with foot odor. With over 250,000 sweat glands generating a pint of sweat daily, unless there is an evaporation option, bacteria that live on the skin in that area will ingest the sweat and produce the "isovaleric acid" that causes foot odor. Another possible culprit is a fungus that causes a skin infection, commonly referred to as athlete's foot. Poor hygiene and over-wearing shoes and socks may also result in foot odor. Washing with antifungal foot soap; applying antibacterial foot powder; and wearing clean socks and dry, breathable foot wear daily can all help alleviate a foot odor issue. IMAGINE WELCOMES NEW VOLUNTEERS

On July 7-10th for 32-hours 16 new volunteers were trained to take on a year-long commitment at Imagine, A Center for Coping with Loss as volunteer facilitators. The training is delivered by Imagine clinical staff who model how to provide support using mirroring and reflection and by immersing the volunteers in the experience of a support group. "The training was so rich and gave me a true sense of how to facilitate as well as the value in the work we do," said one newly trained facilitator, Maria Mujica.

"Volunteers are the heart and soul of Imagine and we could not be more grateful to all of the people who take on this commitment," said Mary Robinson, Imagine Executive Director.

"Since moving into our new space (244 Sheffield St., Mountainside, NJ) we have grown quickly as anticipated," said Mandi Zucker, Imagine's Program Director. "These new

volunteers mean we can start a fifth Night of Support in September serving 60 additional children and adults without having to place anyone on a waiting list. We now provide support groups on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays, offering more choices and flexibility to the participants that need it."

Imagine offers free year-round grief support groups for people ages 3-30 as well as parents/guardians of the children who have had a parent or sibling die, and for people coping with a family member with a terminal or chronic illness. Support groups meet on weekday nights for an hour and a half. Dinner is provided prior to the group meeting.



PAYMENT OF SEWER SERVICE FEES

On May 17, 2017, the Warren Township Sewer Authority and on May 18, 2017 the Township Committee approved and entered into a Shared Service Agreement.

Effective July 24, 2017, payments for sewer service that have been previously paid to the Sewer Authority offices will be collected by the Tax Collector's office. The Sewer Authority will continue to be responsible for calculating and establishing the user fees for each property. The amount of your bill for sewer services will not change for 2017, only the location where the payment will be received will change.

Sewer customers paying Stub #2 with a due date of August 1, 2017, should utilize the stub provided.

• Payments made before Monday, July 24, 2017 should be delivered in person or by mail to the Warren Township Sewer Authority offices on the second floor of the Town Hall.

• Payments made on or after Monday, July 24, 2017, can be made in person to the Tax Collector's office on the first floor of Town Hall or mailed to:

Effective August 1, 2017, sewer customers will be able to make their sewer payments online by utilizing the Warren Gateway, which is accessed through the Township website: WarrenNJ.org. On the home page of the website, click on "Warren Gateway," then click on "Pay Your Sewer Bill Online" and enter your property information in the boxes provided. Tax payments can also be made online.

The Tax Collector's office is working diligently with our software vendors and the Sewer Authority in order to implement this new program.

The Township Committee is implementing this change in order to streamline the collection process and to provide Warren residents with a single point of contact for both tax and sewer payments.

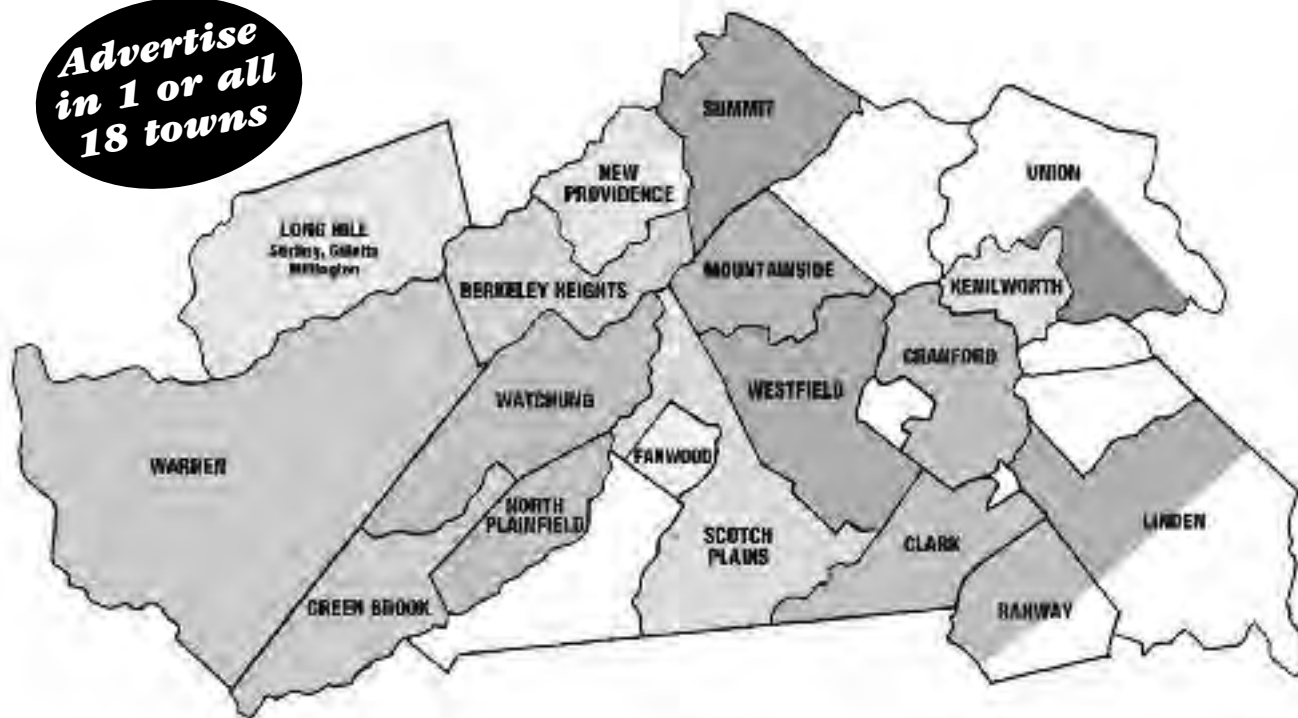
