

18 TEENS PARTAKE IN YOUTH FACILITATOR TRAINING FOR GRIEF SUPPORT

Imagine held its sixth youth facilitator training in September. 18 amazing young people, ages 14 to 18, attended the full day training which sensitizes teen participants to the issue of childhood grief and prepares the youth to assist with the facilitation of peer-support groups for children who are coping with the death of a parent or a sibling. SCARECROWS AT MOUNTAINSIDE'S HETFIELD HOUSE

On Tuesday, October 17, 75 fifth grade students, chaperones, and teachers walked from Deerfield School to the historic Deacon Andrew Hetfield House for a field trip. During their nearly mile-long walk, in beautiful fall weather, the group was escorted by the Mountainside Police Department.

Upon arrival at the circa 1760 Hetfield House, the students began assembly of their 13 scarecrows, each representing a different historic figure in world history. Teams of 5 or 6 students, with parent chaperones, constructed their scarecrows which were planned in advance by the students.


Materials were delivered by teachers to the Hetfield House in advance of the field trip. Mountainside Restoration Committee members were on-hand and provided the frames and straw to stuff the scarecrows. Each team took a break from their scarecrow assembly to take a tour of the Hetfield House where they learned about the history of the Hetfield House and some history about Mountainside. Tours were conducted by Mountainside Restoration Committee volunteers.

The thirteen scarecrows represent George Washington, Nathan Hale, Amelia Earhart, Walt Disney, Martin Luther King Jr., Albert Einstein, Anne Frank, Jackie Robinson, Steve Jobs, Marco Polo, Benjamin Franklin, Thomas Jefferson and Thomas Edison. The scarecrows were placed on stakes in front of the Hetfield House where they will be on display through early November.

The Deacon Andrew Hetfield House and Levi Cory House are located at Constitution Plaza adjacent to the Mountainside Library. Constitution Plaza is the first right off Birch Hill Road which is off New Providence Road near the Mountainside Volunteer Fire House. The Mountainside Restoration Committee is a committee of volunteers governed by the

Borough of Mountainside whose purpose is to restore and maintain the Deacon Andrew Hetfield House and the Levi Cory House and collect and save historic information and items from destruction.


