#### **GRANT AWARDED FOR FULL DAY PRESCHOOL**

The North Plainfield School District received a \$1.6 in academic learning will be provided. million grant from the state of New Jersey, through a competitive Preschool Expansion Aid application process, that will allow the district to offer a full day preschool program to all families in the community.

Prior to receiving the grant, the district had a half-day preschool program in place through a partnership with two community providers, Growing Tree Preschool and Holy Cross Preschool.

The community expressed the need for a full day preschool program to enhance students' first educational experiences as well as assist parents by providing a single school location for their children. Superintendent of Schools, Dr. James McLaughlin, believes that the half-day program and partnership helped to strengthen the district's application.


"This partnership truly showed that our commitment is not just school-based but community-based - a very important part of preschool philosophy," said McLaughlin. "Our curriculum, our classroom model, our teachers understanding of preschool education, and the other many positive attributes of our program made our application extremely strong."

The funds have been used to hire teachers, provide breakfast and lunch to the students, to purchase furniture and class materials, to provide additional training, and to add a behavioral specialist to the preschool staff.

The program, which began on October 2, allows all fouryear-old North Plainfield students to experience a full day of school at no family expense. The curriculum emphasizes cooperation with others, balance, gross motor/ fine motor skills and coordination, pencil grip, language comprehension, expressing thoughts and needs, conversation skills, curiosity, problem-solving, engagement, making connections in learning, symbolic thought, and sorting. Additionally, the major skill and content areas necessary for a solid foundation

"It's so important to emphasize that all this learning occurs in a natural and developmentally appropriate way with lots of time for movement, play, and curiosity. It is also so important that our children see learning as a fun activity and school as a place they want to be," said McLaughlin.

"We are tremendously excited to have this program in our town and provide our youngest students with a real opportunity to start their school careers with a solid foundation for future learning," said McLaughlin. "Our motivation is always to meet the needs of our students and our whole school community embraces that responsibility. North Plainfield is a special place for students and we are extremely happy to be able to offer the gift of preschool education to the families we serve."

#### A NORTH PLAINFIELD LE FUE OTORGADA UNA BECA PARA LA JORNADA COMPLETA DE PREESCOLAR

El Distrito Escolar de North Plainfield recibió una beca de \$ 1.6 millones del estado de Nueva Jersey, a través de un proceso competitivo de solicitud de ayuda para la expansión preescolar, que permitirá al distrito ofrecer un programa preescolar de jornada completa a todas las familias de la comunidad.

Antes de recibir la beca, el distrito tenía un programa preescolar de medio día establecido a través de una asociación con dos proveedores de la comunidad, Escuela Preescolar Growing Tree, y Escuela Preescolar Holy Cross. La comunidad expresó la necesidad de un programa preescolar de jornada completa para mejorar las primeras experiencias educativas de los estudiantes, así como para ayudar a los padres proporcionando un lugar único para sus hijos. El superintendente de escuelas, el Dr. James McLaughlin, cree que el programa de medio día y la asociación ayudaron a fortalecer la aplicación del distrito.

"Esta asociación realmente demostró que nuestro compromiso no solo se basa en la escuela, sino en la comunidad, una parte muy importante de la filosofía de preescolar", dijo McLaughlin. "Nuestro plan de estudios, nuestro modelo de aula, la comprensión de nuestros maestros sobre la educación preescolar y los otros muchos atributos positivos de nuestro programa hicieron nuestra aplicación extremadamente sólida".

Los fondos se han utilizado para contratar maestros, proporcionar desayuno y almuerzo a los estudiantes, comprar muebles y materiales para los salones, proporcionar capacitación adicional y agregar un(a) especialista en comportamiento al personal de preescolar.

El programa, que comenzó el 2 de octubre, permite que todos los estudiantes de North Plainfield de cuatro años experimenten una jornada completa de clases sin gastos para sus familias. El currículo hace hincapié en la cooperación con los demás, equilibrio, habilidades motrices y motoras gruesas y coordinación, el agarre del lápiz, comprensión del lenguaje, expresión de pensamientos y necesidades, habilidades de conversación, problemas, curiosidad, resolución de participación, hacer conecciones de aprendizaje, pensamientos simbólicos, y clasificación. Además, se proporcionarán las áreas principales de habilidades y contenido necesarias para una base sólida para el aprendizaje académico.

"Es muy importante enfatizar que todo este aprendizaje ocurre de una manera natural y apropiada para el desarrollo, con mucho tiempo para movimiento, juego y curiosidad. También es muy importante que nuestros hijos vean el aprendizaje como una actividad divertida y la escuela como un lugar en el que quieren estar ", dijo McLaughlin.

"Estamos tremendamente emocionados de tener este programa en nuestra ciudad y brindarles a nuestros estudiantes más jóvenes la oportunidad real de comenzar su carrera escolar con una base sólida para el aprendizaje futuro", dijo McLaughlin. #### FOUR SCHOOLS ACHIEVE SUSTAINABILITY CERTIFICATION

Four Schools in the North Plainfield School District have met the rigorous requirements to achieve Sustainable Jersey for Schools certification. These schools join a group of 91 schools that achieved the Sustainable Jersey for Schools certification in 2017. A total of 679 schools and 273 school districts are participating in the program overall.

The four schools that have achieved bronze certification are: East End Elementary School, Stony Brook Elementary School, West End Elementary School and the North Plainfield Middle School. In response to this achievement, James V. McLaughlin, Ed.D., superintendent of the North Plainfield School District, stated, "Achieving sustainability certification is consistent with the value that North Plainfield places on being environmentally conscience, good stewards of the world we inherit, and ensuring that we are energy efficient with our expenses in order to place the maximum resources toward our students' learning."

"As students and teachers head back to school this year, they will learn the good news that their hard work has paid off," said Randall Solomon, executive director of Sustainable Jersey. "Becoming certified with Sustainable Jersey for Schools is a significant achievement for schools and their school district. The number of schools participating in the program is truly remarkable."

Sustainable Jersey for Schools, a program for kindergarten through twelfth-grade public schools in New Jersey, is voluntary, but achieving certification is not easy. Each school that is certified at the bronze level must submit documentation to show it has completed a balanced portfolio of the program's sustainability actions, attaining a minimum of 150 points. Actions completed by the North Plainfield schools include Education for Sustainability Programs, Access to Healthy Water in Schools, Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety, School Gardens, and District Wide initiatives such as the 'Breakfast After the Bell' Program, Buying Renewable Energy and Green Cleaning and Purchasing Policies.

"We are proud of the leadership provided by the boards of education and their superintendents, as well as the contributions of principals, teachers, education support professionals and parents, that made this important milestone a reality," said Dr. Lawrence S. Feinsod, New Jersey School Boards Association executive director. "We congratulate the schools on achieving Sustainable Jersey for Schools certification." On October 24, 2017, the certified schools and their districts will be celebrated at a reception held during NJSBA Workshop 2017 in Atlantic City. Workshop 2017 will feature Sustainable Jersey for Schools sessions along with NJSBA sustainability support programs for schools.

North Plainfield School District is a progressive, culturally diverse public school district located in eastern Somerset County. It serves 3,400 students, prekindergarten through grade 12, in a network of six schools. In addition to pursuing a first class education for every individual student enrolled in the district, the North Plainfield School District strives to maintain a holistic environment which focuses on sustainability and renewability.

#### **SUSTAINABLE JERSEY FOR SCHOOLS:**

Sustainable Jersey for Schools is a certification program for public schools in New Jersey. It was launched by Sustainable Jersey, a nonprofit, nonpartisan organization that provides tools, training and financial incentives to support and reward municipalities and schools as they pursue sustainability programs. To date, 274 school districts and 679 schools are participating in the program. The district participation has grown to include 46 percent of all New Jersey school districts.

Sustainable Jersey for Schools is underwritten by the New Jersey School Boards Association (NJSBA), the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities Clean Energy Program, The Geraldine R. Dodge Foundation and the New Jersey Education Association (NJEA). The 2017 Sustainable Jersey for Schools small grants program is funded by the PSEG Foundation, NJEA, the Gardinier Environmental Fund and the New Jersey Department of Health. #### NPFD VISITS SCHOOLS DURING NATIONAL FIRE PREVENTION MONTH

During October, for National Fire Prevention at where we work and how the station operates. month, the North Plainfield Fire Department conducted many fire prevention and education visits to our local schools. This year's theme is, "Every Second Counts: Plan 2 Ways Out!" We explained the meaning of this theme to these young students and provided them with a wide array of educational lessons about fire safety awareness. In addition to conducting those school visits, we also hosted a number of visits at the fire station, so the children could get a first-hand look

Both the school and firehouse visits allow us to have a unique one-on-one interaction with the children that they always seem to appreciate. Some topics covered were "stop, drop and roll", identifying a smoke detector, how it works, what the alarm sound means, what to do when you hear the alarm and how to safely exit your home.

October also kicked-off our annual smoke batterv replacement detector program. Traditionally this program has been for our senior

citizens, but it is open to all residents who live within our great community. During this month and through November, we schedule visits to these homes to assist in replacing the smoke detector batteries. If necessary, we will also install or replace the smoke detector itself.






