BERKELEY HEIGHTS KIDS GET RADIO ACTIVE

Talk about a good time! When 20 kids gathered on January 7, 2018, they had a lot to say – to other kids all over the United States. The Berkeley Heights Community Center, 29 Park Avenue, Berkeley Heights, hosted a Ham Radio event.

Ham radio, also known as "amateur radio" lets kids, licensed or not, to get on the air and speak to other kids. Its use is for non-commercial exchange of messages. This experience may lead a young person to developing an interest in electronic technology. Or even pursue a ham radio license in the future.

NPARC, the Amateur Radio Club, based in New Providence, and serving the Watchung Hills area, set up two operating ham radio stations. Children were able to make direct radio contacts with other kids at Ham Stations all over the United States.

Carinne Zhou, 9, of Berkeley Heights, was excited to speak on Ham Radio for the very first time. She said, "I'll get to talk to people in other states!"

Past president Barry Cohen K2JV, was a fan of Ham Radio since he found a book about it as a little kid growing up in the 1930s. As a kid he "got hooked on the concept of talking to people around the world." The origins of amateur radio can be traced back to the late 19th century.

Kids Day occurs twice a year – in January and in June. It is done in cooperation with the

STEP BACK INTO HISTORY AT THE LITTLE-LORD FARMSTEAD MUSEUM

The Historical Society of Berkeley Heights (HSBH) will open the door of the Little-Lord Farmstead Museum, at the corner of Horseshoe Road and Mountain Avenue, to the public beginning in April. The 257-year-old farmstead is the oldest continuously occupied farmstead in Union County. For 110 years it was occupied by descendants of Charles Wait Lord, who purchased the land in 1867. His great-granddaughter, Elizabeth Ann Wemett, sold the property to the Township of Berkeley Heights in 1975, and in 1977 the Historical Society established the museum.

Progress has been made in maintaining the house and the grounds. The photograph shows part of the new roof that was installed in May over the north wing of the house. Long term damage to the previous roof permitted water entry into the building. Three trees close to the

house, including a pine that was split by a lightning strike, were removed by the men of the Berkeley Heights Public Works department. The HSBH received a Union Country grant which will be used to repair damage to the east side of the house, with the town providing assistance in gathering bids. Plans are also being made to replant Osage orange trees which were common on the property for decades. Two such trees were lost to storms over the past year.

The Historical Society of Berkeley Heights is registered as a 501-C(3) organization. All donations are tax deductible to the extent permitted by law. The Society is looking for part time volunteers of all ages to assist with research and restoration projects.







area residents can obtain free assistance in preparing and filing their individual 2017 tax returns. There are no age or income limitations for participation in the program, but taxpayers with complex returns may be advised to seek paid assistance. Free assistance will be provided at the New Providence Senior Citizens Center (NPSCC), 15 East Fourth Street, New Providence, by volunteer tax counselors under a

Internal Revenue Service, and the New Jersey State Division of Taxation.

Assistance will cover individual federal and NJ state income taxes, the NJ Homestead Property Tax Rebate, and the Property Tax Reimbursement Program (PTR − 1 & 2), as applicable. All returns will be filed electronically, resulting in refunds being received typically in about four weeks after filing. Any taxes due would not be payable until April 18, 2017. Taxpayers will be provided with vouchers to be submitted by that date with any payments due.

Tax counselors will be available on Mondays and Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., from Monday, February 5, 2018, through Monday, April 16, 2018. Taxpayers seeking assistance in preparing and filing their returns may call the NPSCC at 908-665-0046, between the hours of 10:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., Mondays through
