# ANDY WOLMAN RECOGNIZED AT KENILWORTH CHESS CLUB

The Kenilworth Chess Club has kicked off their 2018 season celebrating its 45th year anniversary. On hand for the festivities was Linden native Andy Wolman, one of the founding members. Wolman has been a fixture in Clark, New Jersey, where he owned and operated his barber shop Checkmates Hairstyling, from 1976 to 2012. He still cuts hair in Clark at Mane Expressions, just one block down from his old shop on Westfield Avenue. Wolman is one of the sole founding members still active in the club, other founders have passed away or relocated.

The club was formed in 1972 amid the chess craze in America spearheaded by Bobby Fischer's march to the World Championship. For 45 years the club was a force to be reckoned with as its member roster included many Master level players, including State Champions.

The club has a reputation for being friendly and accommodating. It welcomes non-members with no obligation or cost. It's a place where beginners can learn in a casual setting without being intimidated. Strong players are generous with their time in analyzing and giving instruction.

The club's website, kenilworthchessclub.org, is well read and features an award-winning blog by Michael Goeller and has other instructional features. Players are welcome to just pop into the Kenilworth Chess Club with no formalities every Thursday evening at 8 p.m. at the Kenilworth Community Center located next to Borough Hall on the Boulevard and the corner of 24th Street.

# ARTHUR L. JOHNSON STUDENTS FEATURED IN CIVICS UNPLUGGED


Arthur L. Johnson (ALJ) seniors Maryann Makosiej and Brenner Gull were recently featured in a student orientation video for Civics Unplugged, a program designed to bring together students from diverse backgrounds to discuss a variety of civic-related topics. Seventy-two students from New York and New Jersey convene once a month to engage in a dialogue about issues such as immigration, trade, and voting rights.

According to Civics Unplugged, its goal is to "deepen and broaden civic capacity in students, schools, and society." Students are encouraged to think deeply about complex issues impacting our society and engage in powerful conversations providing multiple perspectives.


Makosiej stated, "I love Civics Unplugged. I find that I leave with more questions than answers but perhaps that is the point." Gull agreed saying that it teaches students, "how to respect and value other people's opinions."
