

Students at Hehnly and Valley Road Schools in Clark learned about the Olympics during recent activities at both schools. At Hehnly, Mrs. Pflug's fourth grade and Mrs. Mytrowitz's kindergarten buddy classes enjoyed an Olympic Day. Students learned about the history of the Olympics and the various events available to athletes in the Olympic games. Seven buddy teams worked together to create an event for the day. Students were given items such as hula hoops, lacrosse sticks, scooters, and Hot Wheel cars. They then decided what the game would consist of, what the rules were, and how points would be distributed. Each group then chose a country to represent them and created a flag for that country to display during the opening ceremony.

"This was a great opportunity for youngsters to learn about and emulate the hard work and

spirit of the athletes who participate in the Olympics every two years," explained Mrs. Bergin.

Mrs. Pflug and Mrs. Mytrowitz were proud of how their students demonstrated good sportsmanship throughout the events. A great time was had by all!

At Valley Road School, second graders participated in Winter Olympic-themed STEAM activities. The students learned about specific events such as bobsledding, snowboarding, curling, and speed skating. With the use of various household materials, the students were able to construct their own mini bobsleds to send their team of "counting bears" down the track to achieve the fastest time. The students also used these materials to send their bolt into the designated area for curling and create a snowboard to race down the mountain. Additionally, the second graders learned about speed skating and practiced the motion down the hallway to see who could slide through the course the fastest.

According to Ms. Pinto, "These activities were a fun and creative way to learn about a great winter tradition."





The clean-up will focus on areas upstream and downstream of the dam at Winfield Park, New Jersey. It is our hope to have enough folks participate that we can have teams work as far upstream as the Garden State Parkway and downstream through Rahway River Park in Clark, Linden and Rahway all the way to Elizabeth Avenue.

Plans are to meet at the parking area adjacent to the waterfall of the Rahway River by the dam at Winfield Park at 8:45 a.m. This is a great way to celebrate Earth Day and if you haven't participated in an event like this before, you will find it invigorating, and you will feel good about what you have accomplished...it is also a lot of fun...especially for scouts and young adults as they always find something interesting. This adds both education and adventure to the event.


The clean-up will generally be between 9 a.m. and noon, but any amount of time or effort that folks can volunteer is appreciated. There is always a large volume of floatable debris to pick up. This includes tires and of course floatables (cans, bottles, plastics, etc.). The County of Union generously supplies gloves and garbage bags, and we solicit material donations (donuts, bagels, coffee, bottled water, paper towels, handwipes, etc.) for all volunteers.

Last year, nearly 150 folks participated, including Girl Scouts, Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, fishermen, local activists and citizens, and we pulled some amazing things from the river. Sponsors came through with coffee, bagels, Danish, donuts, cookies, bottled water, and juice boxes, and we had grilled hot dogs for lunch. We also had other giveaways for the participants.

All participants should wear jeans, long-sleeved shirts, gloves and boots, and waders are welcome for folks who like to get a little wet. Each participant should bring a standard five-gallon carry bucket with a handle (put your name on the bottom). This makes for easy carrying of "stuff" for transfer to the large garbage bags. When we complete the event, we do a basic inventory of the "big stuff" that we removed and within approximately 24 hours Union County Parks removes and disposes of all the trash.






## GUEST SPEAKER VISITS ALJ'S AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE CLASSES




