WHAT, WHERE AND WHEN IN OLD KENILWORTH: SAINT THERESA'S CHAPEL

The old Saint Theresa's Chapel still stands at 511 Washington Avenue near N. 21st Street in Kenilworth, New Jersey. But many are unaware that the building in its present state was once a Catholic chapel.

Built in the late 1920s or early 1930s it was a clothing factory. Sal Cirillo (1929-2010) recalled in 2004 that his mother, Mary Cirillo Nastasi (1894-1983), was a seamstress there during the Great Depression.

Without a church structure in Kenilworth back then, local Catholics worshipped at St. Michael's, Cranford, or at the Church of the Assumption, Roselle Park. Children's religious classes were held in homes, the old borough hall, the old Centre Del, and in Harding School.

In the 1940s, the former clothing factory was acquired by the Archdiocese of Newark. The formal dedication of Saint Theresa's Chapel and first mass were held there on November 1, 1942. Formal parish status came in 1949 at which time the late Rev. Sylvester P. McVeigh became the first resident pastor, serving until his death in

As membership grew construction of a school, church-auditorium, and convent began in 1953. They were dedicated in 1954. In 1959 a fire in the chapel resulted in burn injuries to Father McVeigh as he rescued religious items from the altar. Due to the size of the growing parish, some masses continued to be held in the chapel until the 1960s. A new church and rectory were dedicated March 18, 1967 on Washington Avenue between North 22nd and North 23rd

About that time the chapel was sold and converted into the Kenilworth Funeral Home. In 1991 the business was acquired by Albert Opacity and is now the Opacity Funeral Home.



IRS WARNS OF SCAMS TARGETING TAXPAYERS

suspicious individuals claiming to be from the IRS.

Thousands of people have lost millions of dollars and their personal information to tax scams. Scammers use the regular mail, telephone, or email to set up individuals, businesses, payroll, and tax professionals.

The IRS doesn't initiate contact with taxpayers by email, text messages, or social media channels to request personal or financial information. Recognize the telltale signs of a

Scams Targeting Taxpayers

IRS-Impersonation Telephone Scams

A sophisticated phone scam targeting taxpayers, including recent immigrants, has been making the rounds throughout the country. Callers claim to be IRS employees, using fake names and bogus IRS identification badge numbers. They may know a lot about their targets, and they usually alter the caller ID to make it look like the IRS is calling.

Victims are told they owe money to the IRS and it must be paid promptly through a gift card or wire transfer. Victims may be threatened with arrest, deportation or suspension of a business or driver's license. In many cases, the caller becomes hostile and insulting. Victims may be told they have a refund due to try to trick them into sharing private information. If the phone isn't answered, the scammers often leave an "urgent" callback request.

Some thieves have used video relay services (VRS) to try to scam deaf and hard of hearing

The IRS is urging the public to be aware of individuals. Taxpayers are urged not trust calls used to steal the victims' identity. just because they are made through VRS, as interpreters don't screen calls for validity.

> Limited English Proficiency victims are often approached in their native language, threatened with deportation, police arrest and license revocation, among other things. IRS urges all taxpayers caution before paying unexpected tax bills. Note that the IRS doesn't:

- Call to demand immediate payment using a specific payment method such as a prepaid debit card, gift card or wire transfer. Generally, the IRS will first mail you a bill if you owe any taxes.
- Threaten to bring in local police or other law-enforcement groups to have you arrested for not paying.
- Demand payment without giving you the opportunity to question or appeal the amount they say you owe.

Scams Targeting Tax Professionals

Increasingly, tax professionals are being targeted by identity thieves. These criminals many of them sophisticated, organized syndicates - are redoubling their efforts to gather personal data to file fraudulent federal and state income tax returns.

Surge in Email, Phishing and Malware

Phishing (as in "fishing for information") is a scam where fraudsters send e-mail messages to trick unsuspecting victims into revealing personal and financial information that can be

The IRS has issued several alerts about the fraudulent use of the IRS name or logo by scammers trying to gain access to consumers' financial information to steal their identity and

Scam emails are designed to trick taxpayers into thinking these are official communications from the IRS or others in the tax industry, including tax software companies. These phishing schemes may seek information related to refunds, filing status, confirming personal information, ordering transcripts, and verifying PIN information.

Be alert to bogus emails that appear to come from your tax professional, requesting information for an IRS form. IRS doesn't require Life Insurance and Annuity updates from taxpayers or a tax professional.

Variations can be seen via text messages. The • Ask for credit or debit card numbers over IRS is aware of email phishing scams that include links to bogus web sites intended to mirror the official IRS web site. These emails contain the direction "you are to update your IRS e-file immediately." These emails are not from the IRS.

> The sites may ask for information used to file false tax returns or they may carry malware, which can infect computers and allow criminals to access your files or track your keystrokes to gain information.





WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH CELEBRATION AT NITSCHE HOUSE

Nationally acclaimed author and historian Joanne Hamilton Rajoppi will highlight stories from her most recent book, "Northern Women in the Aftermath of the Civil War – The Wives and Daughters of the Brunswick Boys," during the Kenilworth Historical Society's Women's History Month Celebration on Tuesday, March 6, 2018, at 7 p.m.

All are invited to attend the event, which will be held at the Oswald J. Nitschke House "living history" museum and cultural arts center, 49 South 21 Street, Kenilworth. Admission is free, but advance registration is requested due to limited seating. Light refreshments will be served. Copies of Northern Women in the Aftermath of the Civil War will be available for purchase and signing by the author.

Rajoppi's presentation, based on her book, will show the challenges and struggles that defined the roles of women in the aftermath of America's Civil War, as exemplified by the experiences of the author's ancestors, the Hamilton family. It will underscore the perseverance, stamina, and quiet heroism of such women as they confronted widowhood and/or the strain of caring for returning soldiers with alcoholism, drug addiction and post-traumatic stress. The story of the Hamilton family further portrays the legacy as well as the dreams and hopes that late 19th to early 20th century women left their children in the context of a rapidly evolving America marked by a new Federal pension system, the westward migration, industrialization and the start of modern business culture.

Rajoppi is the author of two other books: "The Civil War in New Brunswick: The Brunswick Boys and the Great Rebellion," and the nationally acclaimed "Women in Office: Getting There and Staying There." Rajoppi's publications have received National Women's Press Association, New Jersey Women's Press Association and North Jersey Civil War Roundtable Book honors.


In addition to her literary achievements, Rajoppi has many notable accomplishments in business and government. She is the first woman in Union County's history to be elected Union County Clerk, a role that she has fulfilled since 1995. She also was the first woman to serve as

For information/reservations, please call 908- Union County Register of Deeds and Mortgages, a position that she held for 12 years prior to her election as Union County Clerk. A native of Springfield, Rajoppi was the first female mayor of the municipality, a post to which she was elected in 1977. She also served on the Springfield board of education and township committee. Rajoppi was elected to the Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders in 1978 and in 1980 became the first woman to chair the board. In 1981, she was appointed New Jersey's Assistant Secretary of State by the late former Gov. Brendan Byrne.

> Rajoppi earned her B.A. degree, cum laude, from Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio, and her master's degree in public administration from the Center for Public Service at Seton Hall University. She has received multiple National Association of Counties Achievement Awards for innovative and creative management.

> Rajoppi is a member of the Union Township Historical Society and a trustee of the Union County Historical Society. She chaired the 150th County Union Courthouse Anniversary Committee.




