Al Volpe, a 1959 East Orange High School graduate, was a member and captain of the 1958 New Jersey State Championship Football Team. Earning All-State honors Al was appointed to the Scholastic Coach All-American Team. Al received an athletic scholarship and obtained a Bachelor of Science Degree from Purdue University followed by a Master's Degree from Kean University. Al also served in the United States Navy.

Al was employed by The City of Linden for 41 years and retired as the Director of Recreation, Public Property and Community Services. He served on the Planning Board and was also a CETA Coordinator and Community Development Representative. Al was inducted into the Union County Baseball Hall of Fame, Linden Athletic Hall of Fame, and is currently Chairman for the Linden Boxing Association. He also serves on the Board of Directors of the Morris County Chapter of the National Football Foundation. Though the years his involvement has resulted with raising over \$700,000 for public and youth athletics and activities.

Even in retirement, he still serves his community. His love of cooking always contributed to our The Kiwanis Club of Linden's Pancake Breakfast, but especially our Pasta Dinners. His special sauce is a secret shared with a select few and is so delicious! Al joined Kiwanis in 1976 and has served in many roles. He is a key reason of why our club still survives. Al received the deserved honor of being a 'Distinguished Past

President of the Kiwanis Club.'

Our Club was chartered in 1947 and needs youthful-minded individuals to re-spark us. From sponsoring the K-Kids programs in the elementary schools, raising money for scholarships and gift cards, supporting Children Specialized Hospital along with International causes, our Club has passion and dedication. 





PHILLIPS 66 DONATES SAFETY EQUIPMENT TO LINDEN FIRE DEPARTMENT

Recently the Linden Fire Department received an emergency bail out equipment kit for each of our 111 members. This equipment was purchased from a generous donation from Phillips 66 Bayway Refinery. Each kit consisted of a harness to be worn on their turnout gear, specially designed hook, a descending device and a 50-foot length of rope. These kits are to be carried by all firefighters when entering a structure fire, they are to be used as a last resort if they find themselves trapped by fire. If a

firefighter must use the kit, they hook into the window frame and bail out the window using the descender to slowly lower to the ground. In addition to the equipment each member also is receiving proper training in the use of the equipment, in this training they are all required to bail out of a window nine times to be qualified to use the kits.

Linden Fire Chief Joseph Dooley said, "Not having this equipment and training has been a significant gap in our preparedness. We have

been trying for years to get grants for the equipment. Phillips 66 has closed this gap, now every member of the Linden Fire Department has a way out if they get trapped by fire."

The Linden Fire Department would like to thank Phillips 66 Bayway Refinery for their donation, Phillips 66 has always taken a great interest in training and safety of the Linden Fire Department so that we can continue to deliver the highest level of safety to the citizens and businesses of Linden.



LINDEN HS STUDENTS TAKE A SPIN OUTSIDE GYM CLASS ROUTINE

A stationary bike doesn't move, but it sure can take you places.

Linden High School students are learning that lesson in a state-of-the-art spin studio that debuted in September just outside the main gym. So far, the reviews are positive all around.

"We kind of hit a home run here," said Steven Viana, the district's director of health and physical education.

The room is the latest "breakout" room offered to physical education students, meaning it gives them alternatives for workouts aside from typical gym-class activities. The students also have access to an expansive weight room and a multifaceted fitness room, which offers yoga, Pilates, kickboxing, and other activities. Because exercise bikes are among the most popular equipment in the weight room, it seemed natural to expand the offering.

It's a unique program that helps solve a common problem for large school districts: trying to put on the best possible physical education program in a limited amount of space.

"But I don't know another school in the area that's doing something similar," said Viana, who credited Superintendent Danny A. Robertozzi, Business Administrator Kathleen Gaylord, Principal Yelena Horre, and the support of the Board of Education for making the project happen.

"When we first heard this idea from Mr. Viana, we knew it was worth our time and effort to get it done," Robertozzi said. "It's a great way to maximize our resources while giving the students something unique and valuable. It's a win-win."

The spin studio consists of 26 bikes, two of which are Peloton bikes that are equipped with on-demand instruction programs with a real instructor that the user can view on a screen. The instructor gives users instructions and encouragement and keeps the workout interesting and challenging.

But Linden High School takes it a step further by taking Peloton's instructor video and broadcasting it from a big-screen television at the front of the room so that everyone can get the full experience.

"We wirelessly push the signal from the Peloton bike up to the seventy-five-inch tv set so every student is getting that Peloton experience," Viana said. "We're using the Cadillac of spin bikes in the Peloton and using it for everyone else in the room. We're using our technology to the fullest extent."

The Peloton experience includes 200,000 different videos to choose from, with different kinds of background music, different instructors, and different levels of difficulty and intensity.

"We have a whole myriad of options available," Viana said.

Coupled with the two Pelotons are 24 Life Fitness spin cycles, all of which are fully customizable for each student. All the bikes allow students to track their progress with real data, including calories, cadence, and other measures, which allow students to track their progress and compare it with others. For example, physical

education teacher Michael Firestone had his class in the spin studio for a rotation in December. Freshman Edgar Saint-Val burned 178 calories during a 20-minute workout to lead the class.

"The spin studio at Linden High School is an innovative and exciting new experience for the students as well as the physical education staff," said Barbara Brady, the Health & Physical Education Department chair, who was speaking on behalf of the physical education staff. "It is a great alternative to a traditional physical education class. The students can focus on individual exercise goals and they can monitor their own progress. The spin classes also offer the students the opportunity to experience a lifelong fitness activity."

Besides diversifying the students' options, the spin studio and other breakout rooms serve another purpose. Each gym class has 100 to 150 students, which can complicate lesson planning. The breakout rooms give teachers the option to place 85 students in activities outside the main gym.

"That leaves fifty to seventy behind, which is a very good number to do a formal activity in the gym, whether we're playing badminton, or floor hockey, or volleyball," Viana said. "Whatever we're doing, we have so much more space and the students are getting a much better class experience because we're basically reducing the class sizes and providing more individualized instruction."

"Teachers love it because it's so much more manageable. It's so hard to do an organized physical activity for 150 students in one small area."

Students rotate through different rooms every two weeks or so, so that everyone gets the chance to try different activities.

"We're doing new things, creative things, to expand the physical education opportunities with a limited space," Viana said. "We're always trying to give students new opportunities and the spin studio is just one venue in which students can get physically active."

"It's new, it's creative and the kids love it."

LINDEN MIDDLE SCHOOL PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS WORK OF HUMANITARIANS

Hanging in a second-floor hallway near the main entrance to Soehl Middle School in Linden is a monument to those who have used their lives for the betterment of humanity – and who stand as an inspiration to students.

“Piece by Peace” is a patchwork quilt of 120 cards, each of which highlights the achievements of a notable humanitarian of the past or present – from Susan B. Anthony, to Rosa Parks, to Bill Gates. The cards were created and strung together by students in the seventh-grade language arts classes of Jennifer MacDonald and Jamie Pierson as part of a larger project.

“The ‘Piece by Peace’ quilt has generated a lot of meaningful discussion as it hangs proudly in our hallway,” said Principal Richard Molinaro.

The project got started around Martin Luther King Day, when students were discussing the civil rights leader’s humanitarian works.

“The kids were totally unfamiliar with what that meant and with what contributes to being a humanitarian,” MacDonald said. “So, we thought it would be fun for them to become a humanitarian.”

The teachers came up with names of 30 humanitarians and students were randomly assigned one name to learn about.

“So, the students did research on what they did, what their impact on society was, or still is to this day,” said MacDonald, who was named Soehl’s Teacher of the Year in January. “And students thought about what we can do to be a good humanitarian, without the fame, without the money. So, the kids familiarized themselves with how they can be a productive humanitarian.”

Some of the ideas the students came up with were holding fundraisers at the school, collecting plastic to recycle, reducing use of paper, reducing food waste, and organizing clothing drives for the poor.

“It opened their eyes to how great an outcome it can turn into from something so simple,” MacDonald said.

Superintendent Danny A. Robertozzi was impressed by the work of everyone involved.

“It’s such a creative project and teaches the students about these prominent figures in a way that will truly stick with them,” he said. “Their ‘Piece by Peace’ display serves as an inspiration to other students and everyone who visits Soehl. Hats off to Miss MacDonald and Miss Pierson.”

Student Natalia Silva-Miceli said she learned a lot through the research and class presentations.

“It really helped to show us that as we grow older we can make a change no matter who we are,” she said.

Natalia’s humanitarian was Mother Teresa. At first, she considered trying to trade to get a different name, but she’s glad she stuck with her original pick.

“She was interesting to learn about and she did a lot in the world,” she said. “She helped those in poverty and she always fed people who needed food and tried to arrange clothing for them and visiting them to bless them.”

Some of the names were more contemporary. Ezinne Amadi got Brad Pitt.

“Actually, I had never heard of him,” she said. “But he’s done a little bit of everything. He has like thirty-six different causes. He tries to use his fame and his money for the benefit of others.”

In some cases, the project helped change the students’ perceptions of some famous people. Jean-Charles Precois was assigned to research Bill Gates.

“I always thought he was just some rich

After students researched their humanitarian and did a classroom presentation, the “Piece by Peace” quilt was put together in mid-February as the final step. Each student created a card for their humanitarian, then everyone worked together to attach and hang the project.

The final piece is an impressive example that shows what can be accomplished when a class – or humankind – works together.


