
























LOCAL STUDENTS SHINE AT ANNUAL SPELLING BEE SPECTACULAR



ST. BALDWICK'S FUNDRAISER AT FIRE DEPARTMENT

The North Plainfield Fire Department, 8 Lincoln Place, North Plainfield, New Jersey, recently hosted a St. Baldwick's Foundation head-shaving event to raise funds and awareness for lifesaving childhood cancer research.

Over 70 local participants, including local firefighters, children, and even a pastor, went bald to support the Foundation's mission to take childhood back from cancer. With the participants, the barbers, and people who came for support, there was over 200 in attendance. The event was set up by off-duty firemen. The barbers and the DJ all volunteered their services.

This year's event raised over \$40,000, and some years over \$100,000 has been raised. Since 2004, the North Plainfield Fire Department has raised about \$1,050,000, according to event organizer, Captain Robert Beattie.

"It's an open community event," said Beattie. "Not just firemen. Teachers, police officers, cancer survivors, people of all walks of life. This is my twentieth year on the fire department and it's the highlight of my year. It became a friendly challenge; who can raise the most money?" Beattie shaved his head at the very end of the event.

Jeff Holtz, a retired fireman and big supporter of the event said, "I am proud of Captain Rob for continuing 15 years."

Chuck and Cheyenne Mangione were in charge of donations and running a Tricky Tray to help raise funds.

The top five shavees of 2018, who raised the most money to shave their heads were:

- 1. Frank Wagner, who raised \$4,575.
- 2. Vincent Williams, who raised \$3,000.
- 3. Jack Heyer, who raised \$2,745.
- 4. Alex Moshier, who raised \$2,225.
- 5. Mike Daley, who raised \$1,505.

Wagner said he shaves his head once every three years and has been doing so since the beginning. His teenage daughter Samantha shaved her head a few years ago. Now that she's licensed, she was on board shaving heads today, including shaving her dad.

Captain Rick Connolly has also been getting shaved since the beginning. He said, "It's a good event. It's been very successful."

Pastor Scott Harris from Trinity Reformed Church in North Plainfield was a first-time shavee. Prior to getting shaved, he shared, "I want to help research children's cancer. I'm a pastor. One of our missions is to love our

neighbor. The church donated a huge chunk of change. I can't wait to cut it off."

David Kriete, 13, was an honored child. He survived bone cancer but is now going through bone reconstruction. His father Brian Kriete shaved his head in support.






