The SPFHS Repertory Theatre is proud to present this year's production of Broadway's hit musical "Once Upon a Mattress." 

ROTARY CLUB BREAKFAST TO BENEFIT FRAZEE HOUSE

The Scotch Plains-Fanwood Rotary Club will host their first Pancake Breakfast at the newly renovated Scotch Hills Country Club in Scotch Plains. The event will take place on Sunday, March 25, 2018 from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m., and the price will be \$10 per person. Pancakes, eggs, ham, turkey sausage, coffee, tea, and juice will be served and there will be prize drawings every 30 minutes.

For many years, the Scotch Plains Lions Club hosted the annual Pancake Breakfast. In March 2017, they held their final breakfast because the longtime organizers, Ron and Jane Kelly, relocated and there wasn't anyone in the club who could run the event. The Fanwood-Scotch Plains Rotary Club agreed to take over as of this

Proceeds from the breakfast will benefit the Frazee House Save the project (crowdrise.com/savethefrazeehouse), a local restoration effort managed by the Rotary Club. The Frazee House is a farmstead that has been

standing for more than 270 years, and has been celebrated as an example of vernacular architecture from the 1700's. According to local legend, British General Cornwallis marched through the property after the Battle of Short Hills in 1777, and asked Aunt Betty Frazee to hand over bread for his tired and hungry troops.

To this she replied, "Sir, I give you this bread through fear, not in love." Cornwallis and his troops did not touch the bread, but they did take just about everything else. Betty's husband, Gershom Frazee, was a carpenter and very likely built the home himself between 1720 and 1740, influenced by the area's early Dutch homes.

The Fanwood-Scotch Plains Rotary Club has been serving the community since 1938. Meetings are held on Wednesdays at noon at the Stage House Restaurant, 366 Park Avenue, Scotch Plains, New Jersey. 

Sivak also provided a statement from DiNizio's band mates Jim Babjak and Dennis Diken: "The Smithereens support and applaud the grassroots effort by our fans to have a street in Scotch Plains, New Jersey, renamed in honor of the late Pat DiNizio, our friend and lead singer of The Smithereens. He was always a proud resident of his hometown and lived there until his passing. Such a tribute will be well deserved."

Scotch Plains Municipal Manager, Alexander Mirabella said, "We are working on the

Township of Scotch Plains, including a ceremonial street sign near his family home. Pat was a favorite son of the Township and a dear friend of mine personally and I miss him. He never missed an opportunity to speak highly of Scotch Plains whenever he was in the world. One of his final performances was in Scotch Plains last summer on the Augustine Green outside of Town Hall. The Township is planning a few surprises to honor Pat, which will be announced in the coming months."



NEW E-CYCLING PROGRAM FOR SCOTCH PLAINS RESIDENTS

The Township Council and Mayor of Scotch Plains are pleased to announce that the Township is now offering free electronics recycling. Since February, 2018, Scotch Plains residents could safely get rid of old or unwanted electronic equipment that is not allowed to be disposed of in the regular garbage. The drop off program is available at the Municipal Public Works yard located at 2445 Plainfield Avenue, Scotch Plains, New Jersey.

Items that will be accepted include televisions, computers, monitors, laptops, tablets, E-readers, printers, copy machines and fax machines. All material collected will be recycled. Please do not bring items not on this list as they will not be accepted.

Drop off will be available at the DPW every Thursday between the hours of 7 a.m. -2 p.m. All residents of Scotch Plains are eligible to

participate at no cost. Residents must show ID to use this service.

"Old televisions and computer monitors are the source of a considerable amount of dangerous material, including lead, mercury, and cadmium – and it is unlawful to dispose of them with the regular garbage," stated Scotch Plains Mayor Alexander "Al" Smith. "We are happy to be able to provide this service to our residents and increase our recycling tonnage going forward."

Refrigerators, washers and dryers, microwaves, and air conditioners will not be accepted. Please save them for Union County's Scrap Metal Recycling Program. Visit the County website for more details.








Area residents who enjoy sewing and quilting, and those who would like to start, are invited to join the newly formed Rahway Sewing & Quilting Meetup group.



SCOTCH PLAINS RESCUE SQUAD TIP OF THE MONTH: THE DANGERS OF DROWSY DRIVING


Most people wouldn't think of driving after drinking alcoholic beverages. However, some of those same people would think nothing of getting behind the wheel when they're overly tired, even though research has shown that drowsy driving can be as dangerous as drunk driving.

A new report by AAA (American Automobile Association) states that "drowsiness is a factor in approximately one in ten accidents," much higher than previously thought. In New Jersey, a law was passed in 2003 that makes it illegal to knowingly drive while fatigued. Maggie's Law was named after Maggie McDonnell, a 20-year-old college student who was killed when another driver who hadn't slept for 30 hours and was using drugs hit her car head on in 1997. Maggie's Law defines fatigue "as being without sleep for more than twenty-four consecutive hours and makes driving while fatigued a criminal offense."

William Van Tassel, a driver training manager for AAA, makes it clear that the only solution for drowsy driving is sleep. "Short term tactics like drinking coffee, singing, rolling down the window will not work. Your body's need for sleep will eventually override your brain's attempts to stay awake," said Van Tassel.


Some of the symptoms to watch out for are drifting out of your lane into another, having trouble keeping your eyes open, head bobbing, yawning, and frequently rubbing your eyes. If you experience any of these signs, find a safe place to rest, or ask someone else to drive. Even if you don't fall asleep, fatigue impacts judgment and reaction time.

TOM KRANZ PUBLISHES FIRST NOVEL

It took ten years of on-again, off-again effort but Fanwood Councilman Tom Kranz has published his first novel, inspired by his experiences in television news and a fantasy of exacting swift justice for an objectionable, even criminal boss.

"Budland" is the story of how Bud Remmick, a successful TV assignment editor, went from newsroom manager to prison inmate. Bud's plan sounded good on paper--do the lenient prison time for killing his blackmailing, criminally abusive boss, get out in a few years, and move on with his life. But the realities of prison, including a near-fatal attack and the strain on his loyal wife, force him to face his lifelong denial of a deep-rooted anger that not even he can fully fathom.

"I know it's a leap of faith to read a first-time novel, but I think you may be pleasantly surprised," Kranz says.

While the self-published novel is based loosely on some of Kranz's own experiences, the characters are composites and not based on any particular individuals.

"There's humor and compassion and a despicable bad guy whose behavior pushes some of today's hot buttons on sexual abuse in the workplace," adds Kranz who previously wrote a non-fiction book, "Liveshot: Journalistic Heroism in Philadelphia". Both are available on Amazon in paperback and Ebook.

A graduate of Temple University, Kranz worked for eleven years at WCAU-TV, the NBC affiliate in his native Philadelphia. He then worked for 15 years at CBS News, where he managed reporters, producers and photographers, wrote and edited scripts and did some field producing that took him to many American cities, Chile, Israel and Japan.

Kranz currently serves as Director of Communications for Chelsea Senior Living, a Fanwood based company. He is in his fifth year as a Fanwood Councilman and approaching twenty years as a volunteer EMT on the Fanwood Rescue Squad.


