DANAE CHURCHILL EARNS HER GIRL SCOUT GOLD AWARD

Danae Churchill, an ambassador scout of Watchung's Girl Scout Troop 65624, completed her Girls Scout Gold Award recently. Danae designed a unique project entitled "Straight from the Heart" in which she taught local community members how to make accessories to be donated to teen girls from low income families. Danae's research had shown that even receiving small items such as accessories would help the teen's self-esteem. Everybody likes to look fashionable! Plus, in each recipient's gift bag of accessories were instructions for the teens to learn how to make their own accessories from items such as sweaters and t-shirts. Danae created a Facebook page with tutorials to teach people around the world how they can make these items and donate them to local agencies.

When Danae first conceived of the project, she immediately contacted Cindy Homer, founder of Hearts of Watchung and asked her to be her mentor. Ms. Homer has long matched low-income families with donors for holiday and

year-round giving. Danae knew that Ms. Homer would be a good source of information regarding what gifts would work and how to get them to the girls. Ms. Homer used her Hearts of Watchung network to channel Danae's gift bags to teens that would appreciate the accessories.

With the help of Danae's fellow troop members, Danae staffed a table at a Watchung fall festival, and held a library program to reach out to community members. People generously donated materials such as t shirts, sweaters, and yarn, as well as their time to hot glue bags, braid head bands, and finger-knit hats.

Danae put together about 22 gift bags each with about three accessories in them. Danae officially finished the project in September 2017 and passed her Girl Scout gold award interview at that time. She held onto the gift bags to deliver them to the Hearts of Watchung annual adopt a family drive in early December 2017.

Danae would like to thank Ms. Homer for her patience and guidance; her fellow Girl Scouts and leaders for their help; the community members that made accessories; and Sharon Orlando, youth services librarian at the Watchung Library for helping her reach out to the community and her family members for their support.



Minimal light, as explored by visual artists, reveals the many ways in which detail and character can be perceived even in low light environments. Whether it's the light emanating from a source, such as a sun or a room light, or the light emanating from a soul that is slowly extinguishing, the idea of minimal does not refer to a lack of richness at all.

The New Art Group today consists of New Jersey-based artists Susan Ahlstrom (Stirling), Francesca Azzara (Westfield), Orna Greenberg (Millburn), Nancy Ori (Berkeley Heights), Paul XO Pinkman (Plainfield), Heidi Sussman (West Orange) and Katie Truk (Hamilton). Founded in 1990, with an over 28-year exhibition history, the New Art Group is one of New Jersey's longest standing visual art collectives. The Group has had over 70 exhibitions of members' works in venues throughout New Jersey and environs.



A GRATEFUL WHRHS ALUMNA RECEIVES 'UPSTANDER' AWARD

As Engy Gadmawla, Watchng Hills Regional High School (WHRHS) Class of 2014, embarks on her last semester of undergraduate studies at Drew University, Madison, she does so remembering her very first class on her very first day as a WHRHS Warrior in September 2010.

She was born, and spent her first 10 years living in Cairo, Egypt, before she moved in 2003, just two years after 9/11, to Watchung with her mom, dad, and sister.

"I grew up being called a terrorist," she told the audience at the "Facing History and Ourselves" annual New York Benefit Dinner, Thursday, Oct. 19, 2017 at Pier 60 at Chelsea Piers, New York City.

Between 750 and 800 people attended the dinner. Engy Gadelmawla was one of three key speakers at the event, and one of four people presented with Upstander Awards. Others receiving Upstander Awards were: Jennifer and Peter Buffett and the NoVo Foundation; and actress, playwright and activist Anna Deavere Smith.

It is the same annual benefit dinner that in 2014 recognized the work of WHRHS Social Studies Teachers Jamie Lott-Jones and Mary Sok, and WHRHS students Engy Gadelmawla, Catherine Higgins and Monica Mahal, for creating and implementing the WHRHS "White-Out to Erase Bullying" campaign. That campaign brought together some 13 New Jersey school districts and raised awareness of bullying and upstander behavior. Lott-Jones and Sok accompanied Gadelmawla to the banquet along with members of her family.

Rising out of that effort, WHRHS students helped to literally coin a new word in the Oxford English Dictionary (OED) to describe a new concept. It is "Upstander," someone who is different from being merely a "bystander," someone who, in effect, "faces history and ourselves," and tries to do something about it.

In 2014, the WHRHS teachers and students received recognition at the Facing History and Ourselves Benefit Dinner: They were recognized as "Upstanders." Last Fall, Engy Gadelmawla received her second Upstander recognition, for everything she has done since then. She was asked to be one of the keynote speakers at the 2017 Facing History and Ourselves Benefit Dinner.

Engy shared the poem with the Facing History and Ourselves Annual Dinner audience, reading:

"First they came for the Socialists, but I was not a Socialist and I did not speak out/ Then they came for the trade unionists, but I was not a trade unionist, so I did not speak out/ Then they came for the Jews, but I was not a Jew, so I did not speak out/ Then they came for me, and there was no one left to speak for me."

Continuing, she shared: "For me, this poem is a daily reminder that we all have the power to be 'perpetrators, bystanders or upstanders.'

Facing History has taught me that it is our decision what role we take."
