## ALJ SCRUB CLUB HOSTS ORGAN DONATION AWARENESS DAY

The Arthur L. Johnson Scrub Club, a “PreMed” class for students interested in the medical field, in collaboration with the NJ Sharing Network held an assembly for all high school students on May 23, 2018 in recognition of their 2nd annual Organ Donation Awareness Day. Several speakers explained the importance of organ donation.

The club’s advisor, Bernadette Jacobi, began the assembly by thanking the speakers and commending the club for organizing the event. The Scrub Club dedicated this event in memory of Caitlin Nelson, a 2014 ALJ graduate whose life was cut short last April in an accident. Other speakers included ALJ student Kayla Dias and Brooke Hartrum from the NJ Sharing Network.

Anne Nelson, a Clark resident, spoke about the importance of organ donation through sharing her sister Caitlin’s story. Described as the “ultimate act of kindness,” Caitlin donated her organs to help others. One of those people was Sonia Carlin, Cait’s lung recipient, who spoke about the gratitude she felt towards Caitlin referring to her as “her angel.” Caitlin’s mom, Rosanne Nelson, and Cait’s best friend, Jackie Stankwich, were also in attendance to show their support.

Jacobi stated, “I am still so moved by the events of our day, the words that were spoken, the deep-down strength in our guest speakers today, the attentiveness of the kids, the help of my colleagues, and the amazing job my PreMedders did in preparing for such a powerful and moving presentation.”

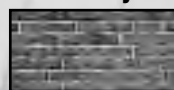

## JOE TUREK AND AMY WYSOCKI AWARDED SCHOLAR ATHLETE AWARDS

On Wednesday, May 23, 2018, two student athletes from Arthur L. Johnson High School were designated as the recipients of the Union County Interscholastic Athletic Conference (UCIAC) Scholar Athlete Award.

The UCIAC is an organization run by Executive Director Tom Lewis, who has continued the great tradition of the Scholar Athlete Dinner from the late Frank J. Cicarell. Frank J. Cicarell was a teacher, coach,

administrator, BOE member, and President of the Union County Athletic Conference. In spite of all of these positions, what he was most remembered for was his impact on the student athletes, as he was the driving force that made athletics in Union County what they are today. Our Union County Tournaments are still named after him to this day. Over the years the dinner, organized and run by Executive Director Tom Lewis, has grown in size and has given out

hundreds of thousands of dollars in scholarship money.

These awards, which are presented to a male and female athlete from each school in the county, celebrate not only the athletic successes of our high school athletes on the fields, courts, and mats, but honors the countless hours that they spend in the classroom as well.

ALJ Senior student athletes Joe Turek and Amy Wysocki were honored as the recipients from Clark. Joe Turek had a stellar career at ALJ participating in football and baseball. As a senior, Joe was named captain of both teams he played for and broke both the seasonal and career rushing records during his time on the gridiron. He recently captured his 100th hit on the baseball diamond as well. He will continue his education at the University of Delaware. Amy Wysocki participated in field hockey and basketball throughout her career at ALJ. She helped both Lady Crusaders' programs compete for County and Sectional State titles throughout her years of participation with the programs.

Gus Kalikas, Athletic Director at ALJ, said of the recipients, "Joe and Amy have been an integral part of the success of our athletic programs at Arthur L. Johnson High School, allowing us to have success on the fields in multiple sports. More importantly, they have been model student athletes that did things the right way both on the fields and in the classroom. They are truly deserving of being named our recipients of the UCIAC's Scholar Athlete Awards, and we wish them well as they embark on their college careers."

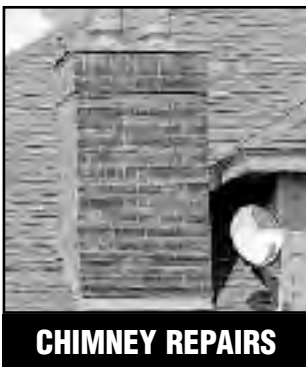

## VISCONTI AWARDED PRESTIGIOUS SCHOLARSHIP AT SWARTHMORE

George Visconti Jr., valedictorian of Arthur L. Johnson's Class of 2018, has chosen Swarthmore College to continue his academic and athletic career in basketball.

After selecting Swarthmore, Visconti received a call that he was awarded the prestigious McCabe Scholarship. It's different than most scholarships in that the recipient does not apply for the award. Finalists are chosen from the general applicant pool by the McCabe Selection Committee and are notified of their candidacy.

Established in 1952, the Thomas B. McCabe, Class of 1915, Achievement Award recognizes applicants to Swarthmore who have exhibited exceptional academic achievement, character, and leadership qualities, especially in service to their school and community. At minimum, it is a four-year, full-tuition scholarship awarded based exclusively on merit.

Visconti broke Kevin Boyle's school scoring record of 1,415 points in his junior year at ALJ. In his senior year he became the fourth player in

Union County history to surpass 2,000 points, finishing with 2,116.

A First Team All State Group 2 player in his senior year, Visconti was Third Team All State his sophomore and junior seasons. He led the Crusaders to their second 20-win season in school history as a junior, which concluded with ALJ's first appearance in a state sectional final.

Visconti, who is a winner of Wendy's High School Heisman for New Jersey, has put together an impressive list of academic achievements and activities as well. They include: Dwight D Eisenhower Leadership Award, United States Military Academy, West Point; Crusader Athletic Leadership Council; Peer Leadership Program; Hero's and Cool Kids Mentoring Program; Vice President – National Honor Society; Vice President – Student Council Class of 2018; President – Science National Honor Society; Key Club member; and St Agnes Catholic Youth Organization Youth Group.

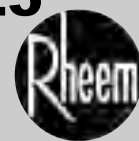

## ED DUBROSKI RECIPIENT OF JEFFERSON AWARD



On June 2, 2018, the State of New Jersey held the Jefferson Awards Ceremony for Public Service at the Trenton War Memorial.
