EDUCATION COMMISSIONER CONGRATULATES CLASS OF 18

Linden High School celebrated its Class of 2018 on Friday, June 22, with its 108th Commencement Ceremony at Tiger Stadium at Cooper Field.

The keynote speaker was New Jersey Commissioner of Education Lamont Repollet.

"I am so happy to be here today to celebrate your special accomplishment with you," he said in his remarks to the students. "Please accept congratulations from Gov. Philip Murphy and the entire Department of Education."

He recognized standout programs at Linden High School, including the rigorous International Baccalaureate course of study, the accomplished Navy Junior ROTC program that comprises more than a quarter of the school's students, the model English as a Second Language program, and science and technology initiatives.

He also singled our three outstanding students for praise: valedictorian and National Honor Society President Karolina Budkiewicz, salutatorian and class president Ayanna Brant, and NJROTC cadet commanding officer Je T'aime Thompson.

"With the dynamic, comprehensive education you have received here in Linden, you are ready to hit the ground running in whatever is next for you," he told the graduates.

In return, the students awarded Dr. Repollet an honorary diploma, making him a member of the Class of 2018.

Vice Principal Lizzie Ortiz, who acted as graduation coordinator and emcee, recognized several members of the graduating class who have committed to serve in the military – asking them to stand – to great applause from the crowd of friends and family.

Eighty-three percent of graduates plan to continue their education at two- or four-year colleges, and another 9 percent plan to enter another form of post-secondary training.

The Class of 2018 also heard from Superintendent Danny A. Robertozzi, Principal Yelena Horre, Board of Education President Raymond J. Topoleski, and Linden Mayor Derek Armstead. The Linden High School Concert Choir sang the class song, "Bridge Over Troubled Water."

LINDEN HIGH SCHOOL COSMETOLOGY CLASS GOES 5-FOR-5 ON STATE LICENSING TEST

Seniors in the Linden High School cosmetology class scored a perfect five for five in passing the state exam to be licensed. This is the second straight year that everyone in the class passed the exam, following the class of 2017's seven graduates.

"It was a small group this year, but all five of them passed both theory and practical, so it is a great accomplishment for the girls," said Maria Fabre, the class's teacher, who is in her 13th year at LHS.

The students in the three-year program traveled to Passaic County Technical Institute on Saturday, May 19, to take the hands-on test after having previously passed a written exam.

Superintendent Danny A. Robertozzi said the five seniors deserve praise for reaching their goal.

"These students have kept their eye on the prize for three years, and now it has paid off," he said. "As with all our vocational programs, we want to prepare our students to thrive in the workplace. These young women are a perfect example of how that can happen with the right tools and great determination."

Fabre said class results can vary year to year, depending on the students' commitment.

"If they're willing to work together, they're all on the same page, working for the same goal," she said, "we usually do very well."

Students are just waiting to get their diplomas, which they submit along with their test results to become licensed in the state of New Jersey to perform hairstyling and cosmetology.

"Now they can go to college if they want, but they can always find a part-time job in the field," Fabre said. "They can always work and make their own hours. It's an extra feather in their cap. It's a great accomplishment."

Possibly the biggest hurdle the students must clear is attaining the 1,000 hours of instructional time they need to be eligible to take the exam.

"So if they have a lot of absences or suspensions, that's a factor," Fabre said. "Some students don't make it because of that. But I always say to them when they graduate, 'You just made \$17,000,' because that's what it would cost for them to go out today and do the program at a private school. It's really a great program."



LINDEN FIRE DEPARTMENT RECOGNIZED FOR COMPASSION

Fifteen individuals and seven organizations recently received the Union County Human Relations Commission's prestigious Unity Award for Achievement, an honor given to role models who dedicate their time and efforts to activities and programs that raise and honor the human spirit.

The awards were handed out during a special presentation held at the Kean University's STEM Building in Union Township on Monday, May 7, 2018. The 2018 awards marked the 17th year in which the Commission has named honorees.

Linden Fire Department Platoon "D" was presented with a Unity Award for Special Achievement in recognition for compassion that went above and beyond the call of duty.

Linden Firefighters Platoon "D" include Fire Chief Joseph G. Dooley, Captain Salvatore Principato, Firefighters Daniel Diaz, Jose A. Espinal, Brain Paster, Daryl Roberts, and Peter Wronski.

One morning two years ago, an elementary school student from Elizabeth was viciously assaulted by his classmates while riding a school bus to Lincoln School, a special education school in Cranford. The attacks continued a second time during the afternoon hours.

The student, Jonathan Moran, a highly functioning autistic child, suffered minor injuries to his face, lips, and mouth during the bullying. Witnesses said a group of students began calling Jonathan names and making fun of his sneakers before the group began to punch him in the face.

The Linden Fire Department's "D" Platoon responded to the incident and treated Jonathan at the scene.

Afterwards, rather than allowing Jonathan to return to the school bus, the EMTs transported him safely home. During the ride, Jonathon spoke to them of some of his hopes and dreams for the future.

This story did not end there, however.

The firefighters took up a cash collection among themselves and returned to Jonathon's home later that evening, bearing gifts that included a brand new pair of sneakers, a American flag, and a "your mother's favorite fireman" shirt to remind him to stay strong and not allow bullies to ruin his day.

The Linden firefighters were recognized for their ongoing service, and honored for their above-and-beyond compassion that greatly impacted the lives of Jonathan and his family, but also had a significant impact on the greater community.







On July 16, 2018, under a scorching sun, the Linden Fire Department gathered to pay homage to eight of its fallen brothers that have died in the line of duty.

The LFD held the ceremony dedicating their Last Alarm Memorial on the 102nd anniversary of the department. With over 100 people in attendance, many of them being family members of the eight late firefighters, Maters of Ceremony Deputy Chief Kevin Brady explained that this dedication is the final act of the Department's Centennial Celebration. The time period of the passing of the firefighters being honored in this memorial started in 1931 and ended in 1983 and as Linden Fire Chief Joseph Dooley stated, "This Memorial has been a long time coming. During the lead up to the 100th Anniversary, we realized that we needed to find a way to honor these men."

The eight firefighters honored are Firefighter John Mahoney 1931, Captain Albert Wilke 1960, Superintendent of Alarms George Ball 1963, Captain James Dunn 1967, Captain Theodore Peceski 1968, Firefighter James Dunn 1969, Firefighter John Beruck 1974 and Firefighter Lewis Haskell 1983.

NUMBER OF GRADUATES PROFICIENT IN TWO LANGUAGES DOUBLES

As the Linden High School Class of 2018 graduated in June, 35 students will be leaving with a diploma that shows colleges and potential employers that they are proficient in two languages.

The Seal of Biliteracy is a New Jersey Department of Education distinction awarded to students who have demonstrated a high level of proficiency in English and an additional world language.

The designation goes on the student's diploma and on their transcript.

"It signals to universities and to potential employers that the student is leaving our district prepared with 21st Century skills," said Superintendent Danny A. Robertozzi. "Our district's participation and commitment to this program affirms that we value, honor and celebrate the diversity among the cultures and languages that make up our Linden community."

Kevin LaMastra, the district's supervisor of world languages/bilingual/ESL, said that the state has increased the difficulty of its test to attain the Seal of Biliteracy, and that Linden has worked hard to keep pace.

"When it first started it a couple of years ago, it was a lot easier for the kids to do it," he said. "Then the state really stepped it up before the 2016-17 school year. Now students have to be able to read a magazine article about climate change or economics, for example. It's really getting into being able to use the language at an

academic level. As opposed to a step below that, which would involve reading a train schedule or a menu – not quite as high of a level."

LaMastra said it's an achievement for the students to be proud of, and it sets them apart from their peers in college and in life.

"There are kids who speak Spanish at home who are not able to read and write at that level," he said. "These students are able to begin college not just learning a language, but being able to do academic work in a language. That means they're ready to go right into a literature class or study science in that language.

"If some of them wanted to go abroad to a university, they're in a pretty good position where it's more likely they'll be successful. We're really proud of that."

LaMastra explained that when the state testing requirements became more rigorous, Linden had just 17 students attain the Seal of Biliteracy in 2017. But the district regrouped and worked closely with its world language teachers, and were able to more than double that number this year.

"We looked at what the test looked like, and we started to see what we could do differently in the classroom," he said. "And we're still looking to see what we can do better. "We're measuring the success of our program by how many kids we can get to that level. We want to produce more and more students who can leave us at that level of proficiency." The students who attained the Seal of Biliteracy were honored by the Board of Education on March 27.




