

## **MOUNTAINSIDE'S RON SILVER TAKES HELM OF BOARD AT CHILD ADVOCACY NONPROFIT**

Mountainside's Ron Silver has taken the reins noted, "We are so pleased to have Ron take the of Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of Union County's board of trustees. Not only has the retired dentist served on the nonprofit's board several years, he also trained as a child advocate and spent six years as a CASA advocating for foster youth.

CASA of Union County recruits, trains, supervises and supports community volunteers to advocate for abused, neglected and abandoned Union County children, from birth to age 21, removed from home and placed in foster care or residential facilities. There are nearly 500 Union County youth in foster care.

"I've been part of CASA of Union County in several ways over the years: from training and advocating for teens aging out without a family or safety net — and for whom I was proud to be in their corner — to serving as a board trustee supporting staff, events and the general direction and welfare of the organization. As a father no, as a human — it's my obligation to give my time, something simple in effort but powerful in result, to fragile children in our own community. I'm fortunate to be part of the greater good CASA of Union County leaves in its wake," said

Executive Director Marla Higginbotham,

reins of our board during a time of major growth for the organization, thanks to a new paradigm that dramatically increases the number of youth we will be able to reach. Ron understands all the layers involved: what it takes to be a successful advocate, where the youth are coming from, the challenges for and commitment of staff, and the import of our work — from the granular level to the big picture."

Other changes to the board of trustees include elevation of Newark attorney Anne Collart of Rahway to vice president, and addition of real estate agent Terry Gould of Westfield and Edison attorney Adam Rothenberg of Scotch Plains. Collart and Gould also trained and have served as advocates, and Rothenberg's wife Christie has advocated for five Union County foster youth over the last four years.

Through court-ordered access to foster parents, doctors, caseworkers, therapists and teachers, CASA volunteers ensure a child's best interests remain a priority while working toward establishing a safe, stable and permanent home. CASA of Union County serves half the county's youth in care; its goal is to reach every child. For details on how to get involved, reach Courtney at (908) 293-8136.

## **JENSEN BUTLER BIKES ACROSS AMERICA TO RAISE MONEY FOR RARE CANCER RESEARCH**

Along the way, he is raising money for rare cancer research through Memorial Sloan Kettering's charity, Cycle for Survival.

On May 5, 2018 Jensen Butler graduated walk on to the Florida State University Football team but cycling is a relatively new endeavor for the 22 year old. An exceptional all-around athlete, he played football, basketball and tennis at his high school and is always looking for his next challenge.

> Last year over spring break, Jensen was inspired and rode his bike 300 miles from Florida State's campus in Tallahassee to Anna Maria, Florida. After that, he knew he wanted to do more and set out planning for the 70+ day journey that will take him through 13 states before finishing in Montauk, New York in mid July.

> Butler, who is riding solo, has a fundraising goal of \$10,000 for Cycle for Survival and hopes to raise awareness about the charity which is the movement to beat rare cancers. Cycle for Survival has raised over \$180 million dollars in the past decade with every single dollar allocated to rare cancer research.

> "With over 1.6 million new cancer cases diagnosed in 2017, approximately half of them were rare cancers so we all know someone who has been touched by rare cancer," said Butler. "Committing my ride to such a great cause while raising this money holds me accountable and motivates me to finish."




