#### RICH'S AUTOMOTIVE HELPS VETS THROUGH KINGDOM CARS

Rich Imbimbo, the owner of Rich's Automotive Repair at 541 Mountain Avenue in Gillette, and his daughter Kristie (Imbimbo) Gall started Kingdom Cars in 2017. Kingdom Cars is a 501c3 non-profit, faith based, auto repair center that works with families with car donations or low cost car repairs while helping them achieve financial stability within their budgets. Kingdom Cars was founded as a result of "seeing families forced to choose between paying for car repairs or putting food on the table," said Imbimbo. "We decided to provide help in a practical way. For the first time ever in New Jersey, we are proud to offer a unique, faith based, one-of-akind program for car repair help - not government organized!", he added.

Imbimbo, who started Rich's Automotive Repair in 1987, witnessed the many struggles first hand over the years as several of his clients had to spend their last dollars on car repairs. "They desperately needed the car repairs to be safe, but knew they would have nothing left over to buy groceries or pay rent." It was "humble moments" like these that moved him to action on behalf of people struggling to make ends meet. Since inception, Kingdom Cars has provided more than 35 cars to families in need, mostly single mothers.

Through Kingdom Cars, Rich's Automotive also offers 1st Saturday Car Clinics where families in need can bring in their cars for no- or low-cost auto repair. To determine eligibility, car owners must visit the website to be approved before bringing in their vehicle. "We are very grateful to the 20+ volunteers who give up a Saturday every month to make this program happen," Imbimbo said. It is not necessary to be a trade mechanic to volunteer, since Rich and his team of qualified mechanics are on-site to monitor all repairs. "We've provided more than \$20,000 in parts and labor for struggling families so they can keep their cars safely on the road," said Gall. Administrative help is also needed to support the effort, she said. Tasks like processing receipts and writing thank you letters to volunteers and vendors need to be done, and they are also looking for financial mentors who can help provide budgets and guidance to the families they work with.

Two Stirling Volunteer Fire Co. firefighters graduated in September from the very difficult and challenging state mandated Firefighter I course that was conducted at the Somerset County Fire Academy. An hour before the firefighter's monthly meeting on September 6, 2018, Chief Kevin Phillips congratulated them and presented John Stone and Tyler Nelson with personalized helmet shields, #134 and #135 respectively. These shields indicate they are now full-fledged and well trained firefighters. They had to complete 250 hours of vigorous classroom and field training. They were wholeheartedly welcomed into the ranks of the Stirling firefighters.

Additionally, another milestone was celebrated with three of Stirling's firefighters how having completed the NJ EMT Certification, which requires 220 hours of training and passing a stringent written test.

They are Darren Calleo, Tyler Harris, and Chris Hoffman. Long Hill First Aid Squad President Bob English presented them with their EMT patch and remarked how proud he was of the partnership with the Stirling Vol. Fire Co. for encouraging these young men to become EMTs and during the training they also became active members of the Long Hill First Aid Squad. The parents and relatives of each of the four were invited to witness the shield presentation ceremony and share in coffee and cake along with the taking of numerous photos. 

#### U-19 RAPTORS COMPLETE THE PERFECT SOCCER SEASON

Perfection is not easily attained, but it is something the Watchung Hills Soccer Association U-19 Raptors can lay claim to following an unblemished spring season.

Compiling a 10-0 record in the regular season, the Raptors' road to the U-19 Mid NJ Championship in June included a 4-1 semifinal victory over Woodbridge Barccelona and a 3-1 triumph over Cranford Rush in the final.

"Perfect seasons do not come around very often, and they are never products of luck," said Matthew Murphy, the team's trainer from the United Soccer Academy. "We went 12-0, we won our flight, and we won the MNJ title. We scored over 50 goals and conceded only 5. It really doesn't get much better than that."

The Raptors are comprised of soccer players from the Watchung Hills sending district towns of Warren, Watchung, Long Hill and Green Brook. Many of the players were active on the Watchung Hills Regional High School varsity soccer squad, though the team also includes players from Rutgers Prep and Morris Catholic. Many of the members graduated in the WHRHS 2018 class, and are attending colleges such as Cornell, Rensselaer Polytechnic, UCal-Berkeley

and Michigan in the fall.

"We started with a solid group of players who really love the game, but needed to quickly learn to work together to play at a very high level," said Michael Cantone, the head coach and a longtime WHSA volunteer. "I'm proud that the values of the team – respect, teamwork and focus – were apparent in every game and training session. ... They play soccer like the beautiful game it is meant to be."

"They are winners, and I have no doubt that success will follow them wherever they go in life," Murphy said.

The Watchung Hills Soccer Association provides recreational, travel and elite soccer programs primarily for children in Warren, Watchung, Green Brook and Long Hill. There are more than 1,200 children in the program.



#### WHRHS STUDENT KAI LORIMOR IS BLAZING HIS OWN N.J. RODEO TRAIL

Kai Lorimor of Warren is helping to put New Jersey on the rodeo map.

The 14-year-old boy started bull riding just over a year ago and joined the New Jersey High School Rodeo Association. Today, he is the state Bull Riding champion, All-Around Cowboy and Rookie of the Year for the junior high school division. He completed his first year with a trip to the National Junior High School Finals Rodeo in South Dakota, and recently competed in the Koloa Plantation Days Rodeo in Hawaii, where he took the winning buckle for steer riding in the three-day event.

Typically know as a Western sport, Kai fell in love with bull riding after viewing a YouTube

"I thought it was cool and I asked my parents if they could find me a place where I could learn," Kai said.

He soon found a home at Luck of the Draw Bull Riding in Monroeville, which is in South Jersey. He trains alongside professionals and "goes through about three or four bulls" during a session, testing himself at a higher level each

Kai remembers that the first time he got on a bull he fell off even before they could lift the

"Once I did it, though," he said, "it was such an adrenaline rush. I was hooked."

Under the tutelage of Scott Lynch, his coach at Luck of the Draw, Kai has come out of the chute

much success," Kai said of his coach. "He just doesn't tell you how to get on the bull, he shows you. And he explains everything."

Lynch also serves as an inspiration for his student. Lynch was 35 when he broke into the sport and pursued a professional career until he tore a muscle in his shoulder. That's one of the reasons why the very young rider has set his goals so high.

"I want to be the youngest Professional Bull Riding Champion ever, at the age of 18," said Kai, who just completed Warren Middle School and will begin Watchung Hills Regional High School in September.

Kai has a ton of respect for rodeo pros "who never quit and always get up." He is well aware that bull riding is a dangerous sport, and broken bones and worse are always possible.

"You really have to want it," Kai said. "I pray before I ride. My faith is one of the things that keeps me going."

Judging by Kai's success so far, there's no telling how far he can go in this sport or how long he will continue to ride.

"At least until my 50s or something like that," he said. "It doesn't have to be professional then, it's just something that I love to do."

Luck of the Draw Bull Riding has a practice pen for all levels. No experience is necessary and gear is provided at no additional cost. "Bull Riding School" sessions are conducted on Saturdays and Sundays each month.







