

COMMUNITY HELPS STUFF-THE-TRUCK WITH DIAPERS FOR LOW-INCOME FAMILIES

On Saturday, September 15, 2018, Moms Helping Moms Foundation held a fun, kidfriendly Stuff-the-Truck diaper drive at the New Providence Community Pool in honor of Diaper Need Awareness Week. The event, sponsored by North Plainfield Nissan, was a huge success with community members donating 8,200 diapers for low-income families.

The Mayor of New Providence, Al Morgan, attended the event and honored Moms Helping Moms Foundation with a proclamation recognizing Diaper Need Awareness Week. He said, "Moms Helping Moms is a terrific organization working hard to ensure that our low-income families have access to essentials like diapers. Presenting this proclamation is an honor and signifies the importance of diaper need and the necessity to make diapers affordable."

Bridget Cutler, Executive Director of Moms Helping Moms, commented, "Chances are we all know someone, or have been the person, who has or will experience the struggle to afford diapers. Raising children is hard enough without

having to worry about whether you have enough clean diapers. Moms Helping Moms is here to help parents and raise awareness about the critical role that diapers play in the health and well-being of families."

Diaper Need Awareness Week (DNAW) is September 24-30. Started in 2012, DNAW is an initiative created by the National Diaper Bank Network to bring national attention and mobilize efforts to end diaper need. Diaper need is the challenge to provide babies with an adequate supply of clean, dry diapers. One-in-three families in the United States experience diaper need. A baby uses close to 2,800 diapers during its first-year, the cost of which is about \$1000 an insurmountable expense for many.

Moms Helping Moms Foundation is a baby supply and diaper bank founded in 2011 that provides essentials for low-income children like diapers, wipes, clothes, shoes, strollers and more. FIRE PREVENTION MONTH WITH THE NPFD

Throughout October and the upcoming weeks, the North Plainfield Fire Department will be participating in National Fire Prevention week. This safety campaign is the longest-running public health observance in our country. This year, the actual week is October 7th through the 13th, but we will continue many of the activities throughout the entire month. During this timeframe, children, adults, and teachers learn how to stay safe in case of a fire. Firefighters provide lifesaving public education in an effort to drastically decrease casualties caused by fires.

Activities throughout the month include conducting fire prevention and education visits to our local schools, as well as hosting visits to the fire department. Both the school and firehouse visits allow us to have a unique one-on-one interaction with the children where we can better cover the topic of fire safety and explain the importance of this year's theme and campaign - "Look. Listen. Learn. Be aware. Fire

can happen anywhere."

On Saturday, October 13, we will host an open house at Fire Headquarters, 8 Lincoln Place between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. The public is invited to come visit the station and meet the firefighters, so please come join us that day!

October also kicks off our annual smoke detector battery replacement program. Traditionally this program has been for our senior citizens, but it is open to all residents who live within our great community. During this month and through November, we schedule visits to these homes to assist in replacing the smoke detector batteries and, if necessary, we will also install or replace the smoke detector itself

This program has been offered for decades at no cost to the homeowner and any North Plainfield family or resident in need of this type of assistance can contact fire headquarters to arrange for a visit by calling us at 908-769-2935.





Organized by the county Commission on the Status of Women, the program is specifically designed to encourage seventh- and eighth-grade girls to prepare for future success in science, technology, engineering and math fields.

There will be three interactive areas for learning about science and engineering while developing valuable teambuilding skills. There also will be a panel of successful STEM women to provide insights, answer questions and discuss possible mentoring opportunities.




