## AMERICAN LATINX EXHIBITION AT KEAN UNIVERSITY CHALLENGES ETHNIC IDENTITY THROUGH AMERICANA

An upcoming art exhibition at Kean University challenges ethnic identity through unique portrayals of American icons. In American Latinx, artist Linda Vallejo has depicted famous people and pop culture icons as Mexicans with tanned skin to encourage the often uncomfortable discourse about race, politics and American history.

American Latinx runs through Friday, December 14 at Kean's Karl and Helen Burger Gallery, located at 1000 Morris Ave. in Union. Gallery Hours are Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

"Vallejo's artwork challenges our thinking with a surprising cultural twist, provoking the viewer to consider how history and pop culture would look if, let's say, George Washington had been Mexican, or if Marilyn Monroe had been African American," said Neil Tetkowski, director of Kean Galleries. "Cultural identity is at the core of her art."

A reception with the artist will be held on Thursday, October 11, 2018 at 3:30 p.m., followed by a gallery walk-through and discussion, The Politics of Color and Class, at 5 p.m. Admission to the exhibition and all events is free and open to the public.

"My formative years were spent in far-flung locations throughout the United States and Europe. During my artistic grounding, I became increasingly immersed in the Chicano/Latino arts and indigenous communities – experiences that informed my cultural perspectives and my art practice," said Vallejo.

Vallejo, an arts educator and artist, conceived her recent work when she purchased a classic Dick and Jane children's book and altered the characters' skin color. She then did the same for American pop icons like Mickey Mouse, Cinderella, Fred Flintstone and Elvis Presley as well as historical figures such as Marie Antoinette and American presidents.

"This exhibition already has people talking," said Tetkowski. "American Latinx, like so many of the works that Kean Galleries presents, challenges audiences to investigate contemporary cultural, spiritual and political issues through an artistic lens."

Vallejo's works can be found in permanent collections at East Los Angeles College Vincent Price Museum, National Museum of Mexican Art, Carnegie Art Museum, California Multicultural and Ethnic Archives, UCLA Chicano Study Research Center and other museums.

## RAHWAY'S DANNI NEWBURY TAKES OATH AS ADVOCATE FOR FOSTER YOUTH JUDGE SWEARS IN 13 CASA VOLUNTEERS

Rahway is among 11 Union County towns represented recently by volunteers sworn in as court appointed special advocates (CASAs), thanks to resident Danni Newbury, who says she became a CASA because "the unsettling reality is that LGBTQ youth are overrepresented in the foster system. All young people — regardless of sexual orientation, gender identity and expression — deserve a safe, supportive, stable, loving, permanent home. It only takes one supportive adult to make a difference in a young person's life. I will be that person for LGBTQ youth who need an advocate and ally."

Superior Court Judge James Hely administered oaths to Newbury and others from Cranford, Elizabeth, Fanwood, Hillside, Linden, Plainfield, Roselle, Scotch Plains, Summit and Westfield, before they were matched to a foster youth or sibling set ranging from birth to age 21. After court observation of experienced CASA volunteers in action, the new advocates will meet their assigned youth.

Volunteers with Court Appointed Special Advocates of Union County are extra eyes and ears for family law judges hearing cases involving abused, neglected or abandoned children removed from home and placed in foster care. With court-ordered access to such parties as foster parents, doctors, caseworkers, therapists and teachers, the advocates incorporate findings into court reports for the judge and work to ensure the youth's needs are met and best interests are protected. CASA volunteers serve another important role for their youth: being a constant amid a flurry of unknowns and changes, including multiple caseworkers, foster homes and schools.

This class ranges from age 23 to 70 and includes parents, non-parents, business and

medical professionals, county employees, retirees and homemakers. One was adopted from foster care and another has guardianship of nieces from the system. Most had no prior knowledge of the foster system.

It's crucial that each of the more than 500 Union County foster youth have an advocate. As the only organization filling this role, community volunteers are still needed, and are encouraged to join one of the fall training sessions that begin September 17 (evenings) and October 12 (daytime). 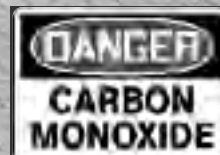

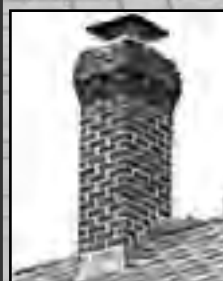

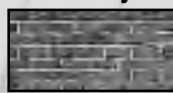

## SEDUM AUTUMN JOY

'Sedum Autumn Joy,' also called Autumn Stonecrop, is one of the most popular perennials on the market today. This hardy upright plant sports light green leaves and deep rose flowers which age to a beautiful bronze by frost.

Autumn Joy forms substantial clumps of foliage which are dramatic in the landscape. Their stout, sturdy stems support the massive flower heads which develop in summer and burst into bloom in fall. When in bloom they are an important late season food source for butterflies and bees. If left standing, they provide winter interest and food for birds.

A big reason for its popularity is due to Autumn Joy's easy care and dependability. Once planted in a suitable place you will enjoy your plants for years to come.

Plant your Autumn Joy in average, well drained soil in full sun. You can multiply your plant by division in early spring or by rooting stem cuttings. Plant 15 inches apart to allow space for the clumps to spread out.

Sedums are a member of the succulent family. The thick, fleshy leaves are a trademark of the 350 plants in this group which range from light green to dark purple. Most are best suited for rock gardens where they fill in spaces where few other plants grow well. Gardeners that collect sedums have displays that bloom from May until the first frost.

A pot of Autumn joy as part of a fall display with chrysanthemums, ornamental kale and a few pumpkins can be a spectacular display in the front yard.

For an extra splash of color, plant a pot of pansies by the front door. With a little luck they may come back and bloom again next spring.

# EARLY AMERICAN WRITER, WASHINGTON IRVING, CONNECTED TO RAHWAY

Washington Irving (1783-1859), was our country's first short story writer and is best known for his stories, "Rip Van Winkle" and "The Legend of Sleepy Hollow." Born in New York City on April 3, 1783 and named after General George Washington, it is a little known historical fact that his parents, William and Sarah Irving, lived in Rahway during the early years of the American Revolution. It is also possible that the home they lived in during those perilous years is still standing today.

The career of Washington Irving began in 1809 with the publication of 'The History of New York,' a work of satire that brought the author literary notice in this country. It was, however, after the publication of his collection of short stories and essays titled 'The Sketch Book' that he became an acclaimed literary figure, not only in the United States but in England as well. 'The Sketch Book,' which contained both "Rip Van Winkle" and "The Legend of Sleepy Hollow," received such outstanding reviews that even English critics acknowledged that good writing could come out of America and that the fledgling country had developed a culture of its own. Irving would go on to publish several other collections of stories and essays, histories, and biographies, including a five-volume set, 'The Life of George Washington,' placing him in the same literary category as other American masters including Hawthorne, Melville, Poe, and Emerson.

In a biography based on the life of the writer and penned by his nephew Pierre M. Irving, an incident is recorded concerning his parents' "escape" from a besieged New York City to the anticipated safety of New Jersey. The biographer states in part, "The father of the author, a merchant, was getting on successfully in a limited way in New York City when the Revolution broke out. He soon found his quiet dwelling under the guns of one of the English ships in the harbor and it was apprehended they would fire upon the town. A general panic prevailed and many of the inhabitants fled to the country, and among the number Mr. Irving and his little flock, with whom he took refuge at Rahway, in New Jersey. In Rahway, he was not much better off: business was at an end, his family suffered from fever and ague (chills), and finally when the British made an incursion into the Jerseys, he was pointed out to them as a rebel, and their troops were billeted in the best rooms of his house, while the family was banished to the garret. Under these circumstances he and his family returned to New York, after an absence of about two years."

It makes sense that the Irving family would have experienced difficulties in Rahway, especially in 1777 when the British were invading New Jersey. Located between Woodbridge and Staten Island, two towns loyal to the crown, and Elizabeth and Westfield, two towns with rebel sympathies, Rahway found itself in the middle of a hornet's nest. There are numerous historic accounts of Rahway residents

being harassed by the British during 1777 and throughout the war.

The house believed to have been the one lived in by William and Sarah Irving is located on Elm Avenue between Main Street and Irving Street and was owned by several prominent Rahway families dating back to the early 1800s. These families, including the Shotwells and the Vanderhovens knew of the legend and it was passed along to future home owners. The story resurfaced in the 1970s at a time when the country was gearing up for its Bicentennial Celebration bringing with it a renewed interest in researching local history.

The home is certainly old enough to be the one in question. In the summer of 1982, a team of architectural preservation officials visited the home during a city-wide survey conducted by Union County of structures built before 1911, at which time they concluded that the east portion was constructed around 1740. At that time, the 1 ½ story structure had a kitchen and living area on the first floor and sleeping quarters on the second level. The interior fireplace had an open side with exposed brick fireback. A narrow staircase along the east wall led to a sleeping level. The house

has a cobblestone foundation, another earmark of an eighteenth-century building. A 2 ½ story addition was built onto the west side of the home in the 1790s.

Besides the age and description of the home, something happened in 1860 that may lend further credence to the legend. Shortly after the author's death in 1859, the name of the street nearest this home was changed. To pay homage to Washington Irving, the city fathers officially changed the name of Second Street to Irving Street.

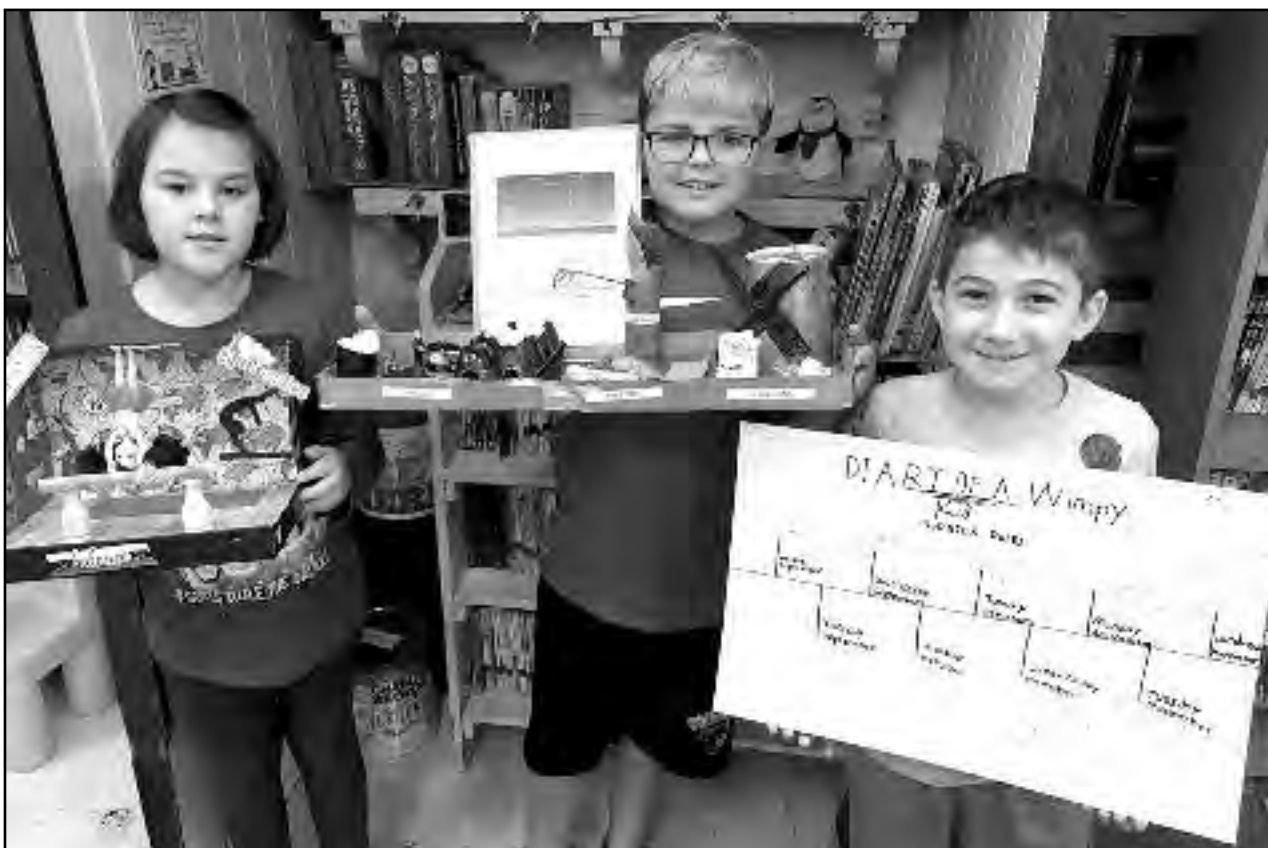
