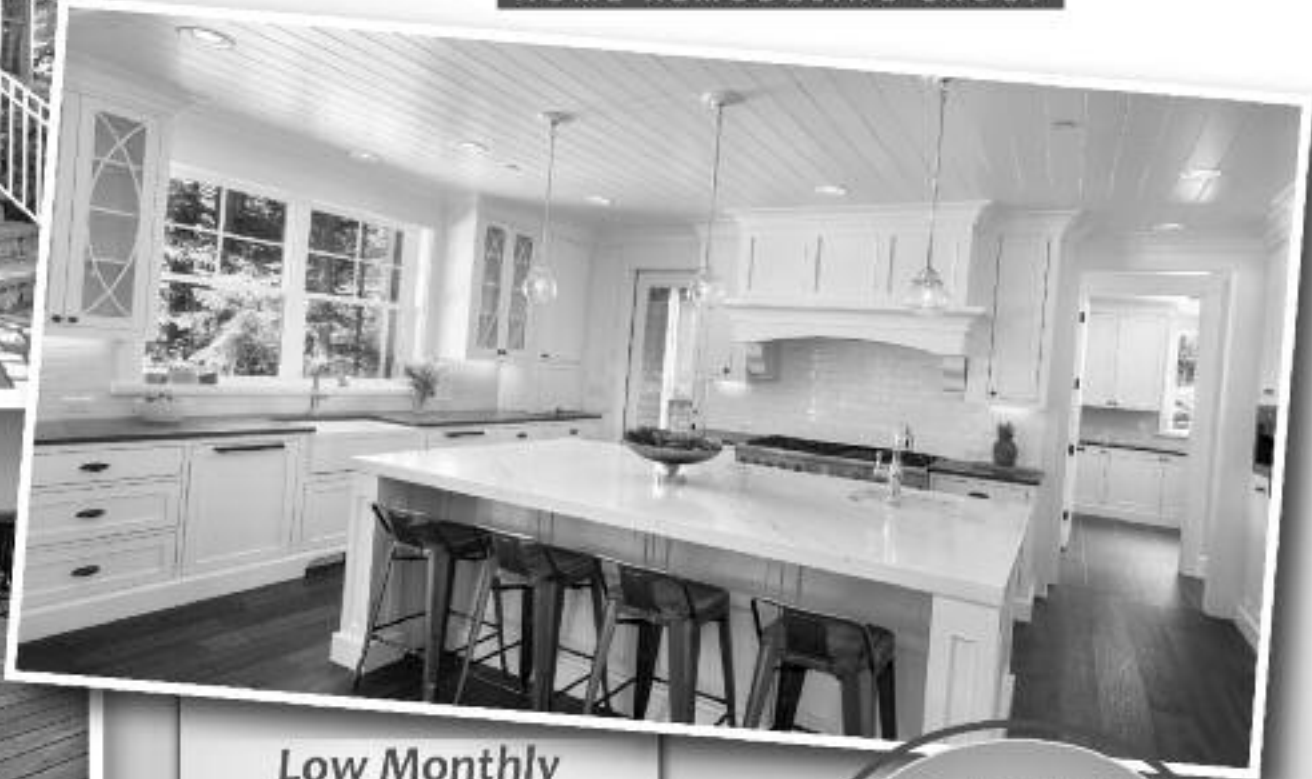

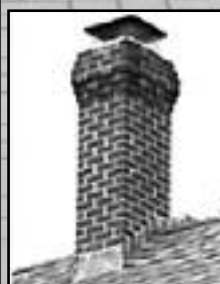

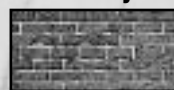

CHELSEA SENIOR LIVING DIRECTOR'S NYC MARATHON RUN WITH A PURPOSE

Chelsea Senior Living Regional Operations Director Paul Gedbaw has been an avid runner for twenty years. But his participation in this year's New York City Marathon has special significance.

"In April my good friend Bob passed away from ALS," he says. "That's how I got hooked up with Team ALS."

Gedbaw will run with Team ALS in the Marathon, one of the world's premier foot races, held November 4, 2018. The 26-mile race, the ultimate endurance test for a runner, is also a fundraising venue for many charities. The money raised by Team ALS goes to the New York Chapter of the ALS Association.

ALS, Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis, also known as Lou Gherig's Disease, attacks the nerves and makes them unable to control the muscles. It has no cure. Stilson's decline from the degenerative disease began in his early 70's and

happened quickly. He died at age 73.

"Bob Stilson was a high school teacher of mine," Gedbaw says. "He was a mentor and really the first adult who showed me there was a world outside the town I grew up in (Ogdensburg, NY). In later years, we just stayed friends. My goal is to raise five-thousand dollars. The money, which will go to the ALS Association, goes towards research, treatment, therapies and trying to improve the quality of life for people living with the disease."

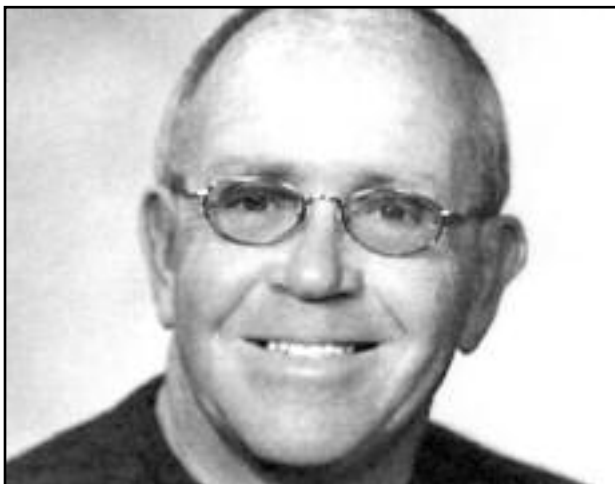

Members of the Rescue Squad were also in attendance.



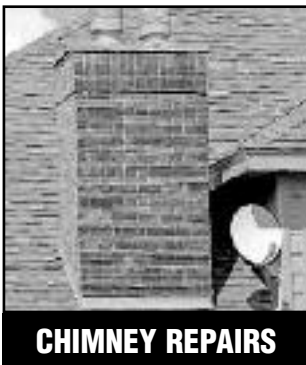

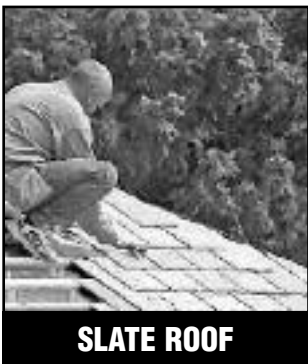

CAROLYN COLONNA TAKES OATH AS ADVOCATE FOR FOSTER YOUTH

Fanwood is among 11 Union County towns represented recently by volunteers sworn in as Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASAs), thanks to Carolyn Colonna, who says she became an advocate "because I felt something pulling at me to help children. ... The mission of Court Appointed Special Advocates of Union County really spoke to me. I am the proud mom of two young adults. I love being a mom, and I feel called to help children both know they can be heard and to be a reliable presence in a child's life."

Superior Court Judge James Hely administered oaths to Colonna and others from Cranford, Elizabeth, Hillside, Linden, Plainfield, Rahway, Roselle, Scotch Plains, Summit and Westfield, before they were matched to a foster youth or sibling set ranging from birth to age 21. After court observation of experienced CASA volunteers in action, the new advocates will meet their assigned youth.

Volunteers with Court Appointed Special Advocates of Union County are extra eyes and ears for family law judges hearing cases involving abused, neglected or abandoned children removed from home and placed in foster care. With court-ordered access to such parties as foster parents, doctors, caseworkers, therapists and teachers, the advocates incorporate findings into court reports for the judge and work to ensure the youth's needs are met and best interests are protected. CASA volunteers serve another important role for their youth: being a constant amid a flurry of unknowns and changes, including multiple caseworkers, foster homes and schools.

This class ranges from age 23 to 70 and includes parents, non-parents, business and medical professionals, county employees, retirees and homemakers. One was adopted from foster

care and another has guardianship of nieces from the system. Most had no prior knowledge of the foster system.

It's crucial that each of the more than 500 Union County foster youth have an advocate. As the only organization filling this role, community volunteers are still needed, and are encouraged to join one of the fall training sessions that begin September 17 (evenings) and October 12 (daytime). 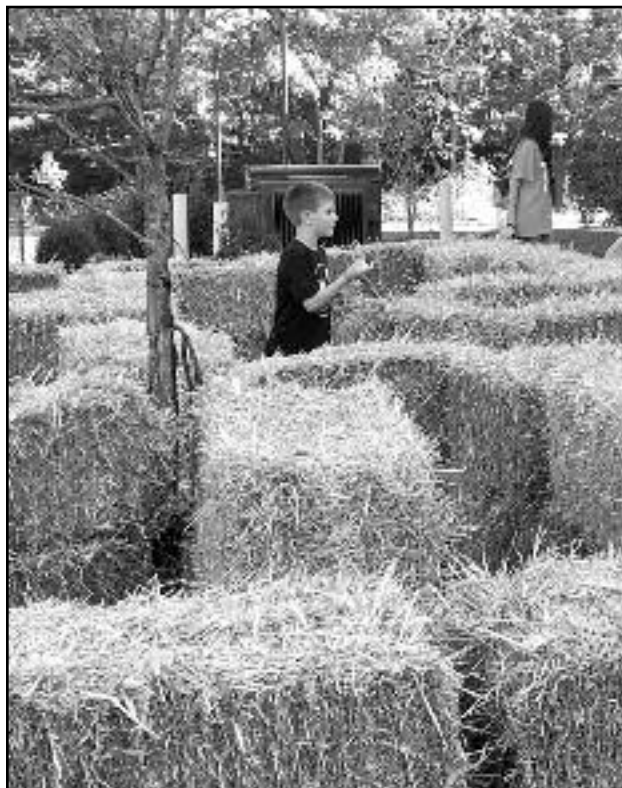
