









WHAT, WHERE, AND WHEN IN OLD KENILWORTH - HIGHEST RANKING VETERANS RECALLED

Of the many hundreds of Kenilworth veterans, two rose to the highest ranks ever attained by a local resident. They were Lieutenant (j. g.) Mary Elinore Conklin (1922-1954) and Colonel Garrett C. Maney, Jr. (1919-2003). They attended local elementary schools and both the Roselle Park High School and Springfield's Jonathan Dayton Regional High School. Her family arrived in the 1920s and his before 1910.

Mary Conklin was one of two children of the late Police Chief George Conklin and his wife Anna. She grew up on the small family ranch that once existed behind 530 Monroe Ave. There she became an accomplished equestrian. During WWII Mary enlisted in the United States Navy and was stationed in New England. While in the Waves she became a lieutenant (j. g.), the highest military rank ever attained by a Kenilworth woman during wartime. After the war Lt. (j. g.) Conklin married Manness Martin. They had two sons, Jeffrey and Thomas.

Garrett Maney, Jr. was one of eight children of Garrett and Mary Maney. His grandfather, Peter Manning, who resided with the family, was a former slave who served in the Union Army during the Civil War. The family resided Downtown. Garrett saw action in three wars: WWII, Korea, and Vietnam. He credited his abilities in the Army Air Corps as stemming from his youth in Kenilworth which at that time had a number of small airfields. He was a member of the highly decorated African-American Tuskegee Squadron; received the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart, and the Distinguished Flying Cross. He and his wife, the former Gladys Walker, had four children: Alice, Lona, Chester, and Garrett III.


