

KEAN THEATRE STUDENT, CHRIS GRANT, SHINES ON PROFESSIONAL STAGE

Submitted by Margaret McCorry Kean University theatre student Chris Grant has already launched his professional acting career, and he hasn't even graduated yet.

The Linden resident was cast in a lead role in Premiere Stages' production of Brick City at the Bauer Boucher Theatre Center, working alongside professional actors with Broadway, film and television credits, for the play's threeweek run in September.

Premiere Stages is Kean's professional theatre in residence that offers theatre students an opportunity to earn credits toward membership in Actors' Equity — the union for theatre actors in America. Premiere Stages works closely with the Kean Theatre Conservatory to provide professional development for students.

"I don't think I would be anywhere near where I'm at in the acting world without the Kean Theatre Conservatory," Grant said.

Grant's journey to leading man began when he joined Premiere Stages' Equity Membership

program in 2017 and served as an understudy in the production of Skeleton Crew.

He still remembers the call he got in the middle of class saying he had been cast as Darnell in Brick City, the story of two high school students — the star basketball player and a senior with a disability — who meet in extended study hall.

"I went into the hallway and began shouting and making a bit of a scene. It was something I literally never thought would happen to me," he said.

"This gave Chris something students don't usually receive as part of their college program — rave reviews from multiple theatre critics," said John J. Wooten, Premiere Stages' artistic director.

Ruth Ross at NJ Arts Maven praised Grant's

"winning performance," while Karen Nowasad at Let's Go to the Theater noted that he "makes Darnell a very believable character, one that you like and cheer on."

Holly Logue, director of the Kean Theatre Conservatory, has seen Grant grow as an actor.

"He is a consummate professional. Chris displays acting talents that are exceptional," she said.

Grant admits he was full of doubt about studying theatre but has gained confidence at Kean. He is taking a valuable lesson away from his Brick City experience.

"Don't think anything is impossible," he said. "The way I look at it is, if one person did it, there's an opportunity for you to do it too, if you're willing to put in the time and the work."

LINDEN HIGH SCHOOL NJROTC HONORS LOCAL HEROES FOR VETERANS DAY

honored dozens of local veterans as well as military tradition on Nov. 12, 2018 with its annual Veterans Day ceremony and Navy/Marine Corps birthday celebration.

More than 400 cadets – about a quarter of the total school population - stood in formation in the LHS gym before veterans, local officials, and bleachers filled with parents.

The ceremony was highlighted by an "Old Glory Presentation" in which cadets gave a flag to guest of honor Dennis Costello, commander of the Linden John Russell Wheeler VFW Post 1397. The post is named in honor of the first Linden resident killed in World War I.

Before it was given to Costello, the folded flag was slowly passed through the hands of five cadets in line ending with Cadet Master Chief Petty Officer Maurice Faulk, who kneeled and handed the flag to Costello, who saluted the cadet. Meanwhile, an emotional reading about the history and meaning of the flag was performed by Cadet Lt. Commander Ariana men and women of the NJROTC. Eastwood, the master of ceremonies.

Speaking to the assembled crowd, Cadet Capt.

commanding officer, thanked all veterans for their service.

"We reflect and express our gratitude to those who have served our country in uniform, as well as those who are deployed overseas," he told the crowd. "No words can express how grateful we are for your service. Veterans are the reason our nation remains strong and a fighting force for freedom around the world."

Nolasco also said veterans epitomize the sentiment in President John F. Kennedy's inaugural address, "Ask not what your country can do for you, ask what you can do for your country."

Commander Boyd Decker, the high school's senior Naval Science instructor, who retired from the military in 2015 after 20 years as a Navy pilot, also thanked all the local veterans for their service and for joining the cadets for the ceremony.

He also highlighted the service of the young

The Linden High School Navy Junior ROTC Gibert Nolasco, the NJROTC's student every day," Decker said. "Anything that is asked of these kids, whether it is supporting school functions or supporting local organizations, they iust always come through."

> More than 100 of the cadets also pitched in the previous night when the City of Linden honored 43 Hometown Heroes with a ceremony in the same gym to unveil banners that will fly on Wood Avenue throughout the month. The cadets handed out plaques to the veterans or to family members of veterans who are deceased.

> Superintendent Danny A. Robertozzi also praised the dedication of the cadets.

> "They are truly exemplary young men and women," he said. "Though some may go into the service, most will not. But the lessons that they are learning in this program, of leadership and service and character, are lessons that will serve them for the rest of their lives."

> Linden Mayor Derek Armstead praised the cadets as "some of the most disciplined, most respected children."

> "It's no secret that you can find me here to watch basketball games, because I love Linden athletics," he said. "But there's not a finer team assembled in this school than this ROTC program."

> The occasion was capped off with cake in celebration of the Navy's 243rd birthday. The first piece was presented to Costello as guest of honor. As is tradition, the cake is then given to the oldest sailor and Marine present, who pass it on to the youngest. The NJROTC honors that tradition by also recognizing the oldest and youngest cadet.

> The oldest Marine present was Robert Kratzer, custodian and groundskeeper at Tiger Stadium at Cooper Field, the district's football and soccer stadium. The oldest sailor was Linden High School teacher Peter McTiernan.

> The youngest sailor was Lt. Clara Rosales, a 2003 graduate of LHS, whose sister Isabelle Vazquez is a sophomore in the NJROTC. The youngest Marine was Sgt. Bradley Wozniak. The oldest and youngest cadets were senior Yesenia Fernandez and freshman Emily Silva.





STUDENTS SPEND SATURDAY IN SERVICE OF NEEDY

About 40 Linden High School students traveled to Newark on Saturday, October 27, 2018 to take part in Rutgers Community Engagement Day.

The students, members of the Navy Junior ROTC and National Honor Society, were broken up into different teams to clean up parks, volunteer with non-profit groups, and beautify the city. They also visited the New Jersev Institute of Social Justice, and packed lunches and wrote cards for less fortunate families.

The program was spearheaded by Ahmed Shehata, a Linden Board of Education member, Rutgers-Newark alumnus, and keynote speaker for the event. He worked with Superintendent Danny A. Robertozzi, Linden High School Principal Yelena Horré, and NJROTC Commander Boyd Decker to arrange the enriching trip for the students, which underscored the district's motto of "Commitment to Service."

"As soon as I was asked to speak, I wanted to make sure our kids were involved in some

capacity," Shehata said. "I wanted the kids to get that real college campus feel. I'm grateful that Mrs. Horre and Dr. Robertozzi gave me the green light and helped orchestrate the whole thing, along with Commander Decker and school security staff member Lakhia Carter, who gave up their Saturday to chaperone."

The program was part of Shehata's push to bring Linden Public Schools and Rutgers University closer together, "to help bridge the gap between our kids and admission at our state's university," he said.

"My goal is to strengthen the ties between Linden and Rutgers so we can continue to do great things together," Shehata said. "This is just one of the many initiatives we have in motion and I'm grateful that Linden and Rutgers are both onboard."

Shehata, who was awarded the Rutgers Community Service Award, plans to work with students during the holiday season at food pantries and other places of need around the state, also in conjunction with Rutgers-Newark.


