LOCAL BASEBALL PLAYERS AND COACHES WILL BE HONORED AT ANNUAL “HOT STOVE” AWARDS DINNER, SUNDAY, FEB. 10 SPECIAL GUEST SPEAKER: DWIGHT “DOC” GOODEN

The Union County Baseball Association will induct four new members into the Union County Baseball Hall of Fame at the organization’s 83rd annual Hot Stove League Dinner on Sunday, February 10, 2019 beginning at 1:00 p.m., at The Gran Centurions in Clark, New Jersey.

The four new inductees into the Union County Baseball Hall of Fame include:

Rich Biddulph of Roselle, an All-State catcher for Roselle Catholic High School and longtime coach of American Legion Baseball teams in Cranford and Roselle;

Walter Podgurski of Union, an All-State second baseman for the Farmers, who went on to play for the University of Pennsylvania and was drafted by the Minnesota Twins;

Chris Roof of Berkeley Heights and Scotch Plains, a standout player at Governor Livingston High School and Montclair State University and longtime coach at Governor Livingston;

Tom Urban of Elizabeth, a varsity infielder at Thomas Jefferson High School, baseball coach in Elizabeth and at Arthur L. Johnson High School in Clark, and director of the Union County Baseball Association Summer and Fall leagues.

The special guest speaker at the annual event will be Dwight “Doc” Gooden, the former award-winning pitcher for the New York Mets and the New York Yankees. Gooden’s headline-grabbing 16-year Major League career – including Rookie of the Year and Cy Young awards with the Mets and his no-hitter while pitching for the Yankees – remains a hot topic of discussion nearly two decades after he threw his final pitch.

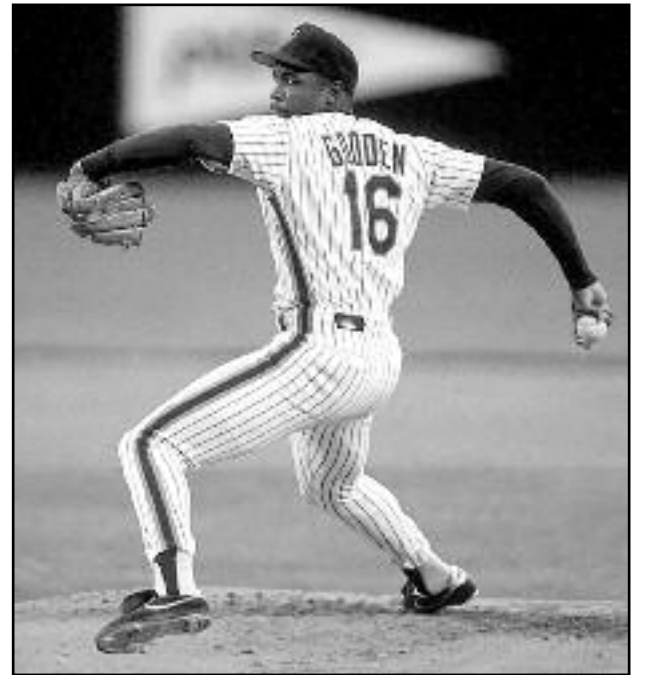

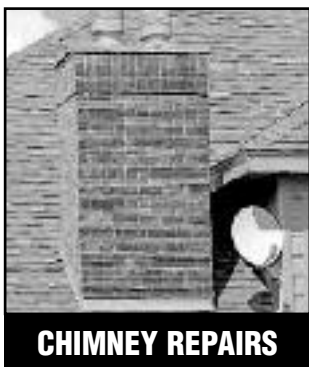

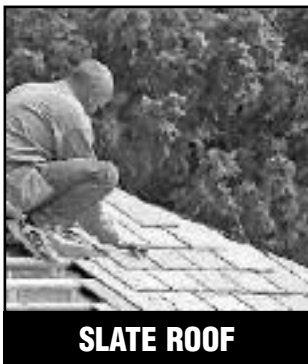

RACHEL SHANAGHER SELECTED AS BERKELEY HEIGHTS NOMINEE FOR COUNTY EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR RECOGNITION

Rachel Shanagher, Grade 1 Teacher at Mary Kay McMillin Early Childhood Center, has been chosen by the Berkeley Heights Public Schools to be the district's nominee for Union County Educator of the Year recognition.

Mrs. Shanagher was named Educator of the Year at McMillin Early Childhood Center last spring, along with honorees from each of the other five Berkeley Heights Public Schools, in accordance with the Governor's Educator of the Year program. She has since been selected from that group of outstanding educators to represent the Berkeley Heights school district in the competition for county-level honors.

Mrs. Shanagher has been serving as a Grade 1 Teacher at The Early Childhood Center since September 2013. She began her employment in Berkeley Heights just a few months after earning her Bachelor of Science Degree in Mathematics/Elementary Education from Ramapo College of New Jersey and completing her student teaching experience at John F. Kennedy Primary School in Raritan.

"I remember the first time I met Rachel when I interviewed her for the position she currently holds," said Anne Corley-Hand, Principal of McMillin Early Childhood Center. "Poised and confident, I felt like I was speaking with a seasoned staff member rather than a recent college graduate and beginning teacher."

Along with a few of her colleagues, Rachel has implemented an afterschool enrichment program at Mary Kay McMillin. She also serves as a representative on the Elementary Math Curriculum Committee and Council on Instruction, and is a frequent participant in and volunteer at PTO family events and in the annual Berkeley Heights Education Foundation Basketball Game.

"Mrs. Shanagher's classroom is an atmosphere of caring, encouragement, and collaboration," Mrs. Corley-Hand continued. "She puts her whole heart into teaching. When asked to describe Rachel, her colleagues used words such as 'creative, enthusiastic, dedicated, passionate, caring, innovative, resourceful, and determined.'"

DON'T FALL FOR SCAM CALLS AND EMAILS IMPERSONATING IRS

The IRS is urging the public to be aware of suspicious individuals claiming to be from the IRS.

Scammers and cyberthieves continue to use the IRS as bait. The most common tax scams are phone calls and emails from thieves who pretend to be from the IRS. Scammers use the IRS name, logo, fake employee names and badge numbers to try to steal money and identities from taxpayers.

Taxpayers need to be wary of phone calls or automated messages from someone who claims to be from the IRS. Often, these criminals will say taxpayers owe money and demand payment right away. Other times, scammers will lie to taxpayers and say they're due a refund. The thieves ask for bank account information over the phone. The IRS warns taxpayers not to fall for these scams.

Below are several tips that will help filers avoid becoming a scam victim.

IRS employees will not:

- Call demanding an immediate payment. The IRS won't call taxpayers if they owe taxes without first sending a bill in the mail.
- Demand payment without allowing taxpayers to question or appeal the amount owed.
- Demand that taxpayers pay their taxes in a specific way, such as with a prepaid debit card.
- Ask for credit or debit card numbers over the phone.
- Threaten to contact local police or similar

agencies to arrest taxpayers for non-payment of taxes.

- Threaten legal action, such as a lawsuit.

If taxpayers don't owe or don't think they owe any tax, and they receive an inquiry like this, they should:

- Contact the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration. Use TIGTA's "IRS Impersonation Scam Reporting" web page to report the incident.
- Report the incident to the Federal Trade Commission. Use the "FTC Complaint Assistant" on FTC.gov. Add "IRS Telephone Scam" to the comments of your report.

In most cases, an IRS phishing scam is an unsolicited, fake email that claims to come from the IRS. Some emails link to sham websites that

look real. The scammers' goal is to lure victims to give up their personal and financial information. If the thieves get what they're after, they use it to steal a victim's money and identity.

For those taxpayers who get a phishing email, the IRS offers this advice:

- Don't reply to the message.
- Don't give out your personal or financial information.
- Forward the email to phishing@irs.gov. Then delete it.
- Don't open any attachments or click on any links. They may have malicious code that will infect your computer.

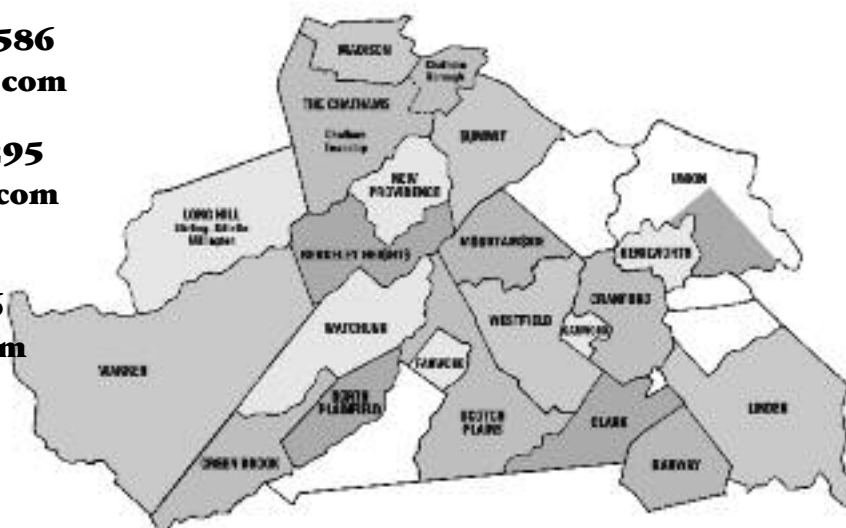
