INTERACT CLUB WORKS RUTGERS CONCESSIONS

Rutgers University basketball and wrestling fans enjoyed special service at the Rutgers Athletic Center concession stands again this season from the Interact Club at North Plainfield High School.

The Interact Club sent twenty to twenty-five members to four basketball games and four wrestling events to staff two concession stands and raise money for scholarships.

Along with members of the Rotary Club of the Plainfields, the Interact Club members prepare hot dogs, hamburgers, cheeseburgers, hot pretzels, and hot popcorn. They make fountain sodas to order, serve up candy and chips, hot sandwiches and empanadas, hot chocolate and coffee for the hungry fans. Their reward is the opportunity to work together, develop skills in dealing with customers, and sharing the fun of a social evening with others.

"We have been working concessions at Rutgers for over 18 years," said Michael Townley, a member of the Rotary club who chairs the event. "For over half that time, the Interact Club has supported our project with their hard work and dedicated service."

Interact clubs are the high school equivalent of Rotary clubs, serving others through various projects and programs. At North Plainfield High School, they are led by Alexandra Pereira, a Spanish language teacher and the club's adviser.

"Alex is a great club adviser," said Townley. "She guides the club through their own activities and service projects, such as sponsoring blood drives, and really allows them to develop their leadership skills. Alex also identifies the 'best of the best' for recognition as 'Students of the Month' throughout the school year."

From the slowest nights at the concession stand to the busiest, the Interactors take their jobs seriously. "I love working with the kids at the Rutgers games," said Roberta Smith, Rotary club president. "They are so enthusiastic and conscientious about their work, it's fun to be there with them. The scholarships that we award at North Plainfield High School only go to members of Interact. This is our way of thanking them for their hard work and dedication to our club and the community."

The Interact Club also helps the Rotary Club with their annual Track and Field Meet, held every year on the first Wednesday of June. Club members serve as assistants on many of the events, filling positions side-by-side with Rotarians as they help officiate events for approximately 300 student athletes in area middle schools.



DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COURT EXPAND HOURS

Safe+Sound Somerset's Legal Advocates have been meeting with survivors of domestic abuse/violence on-site at the Somerset County courthouse on Thursdays to provide support and information about the Temporary and Final Restraining Order process and what can be expected the day of Domestic Violence Court. Legal Advocates also provide individualized safety planning and education about the dynamics of domestic abuse to empower survivors to make informed decisions to keep themselves and their families safe.

Based on how well this arrangement has worked for survivors of domestic abuse, Safe+Sound Somerset was granted permission from the Superior Court of New Jersey, Family Division Somerset County to further expand onsite hours beginning January 2019. Legal Advocates are now available at the courthouse Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., to allow us to accept immediate referrals and to assist survivors who have questions about the TRO process. On weekends, holidays and weekdays after 3:30 p.m. and all other times when the Superior Court is closed, survivors may file a domestic violence complaint at the local police department.

In the first 18 months, Safe+Sound Somerset served 583 people in the courthouse, 106 of those Spanish speaking. Legal Advocates provided over 1,000 individual services, including extensive dismissal counseling to 255 plaintiffs electing to dismiss a TRO or FRO. Expanded onsite availability will increase our capacity and ensure that more individuals impacted by domestic abuse have access to support, education and resources at the location and time they are needed.




