## THE MANY REWARDS FOR LEARNING TO SEW

Generations ago, it was not only common but required that children learned the art of sewing and knitting. Clothes were made from hand; hats and mittens were crafted in living rooms not factories. If you're keen to enhance your motor skills, sewing does just that; especially hand-eye-coordination; Brain Growth. Sewing requires creativity, which improves the brain's ability to grow new brain

cells.

Sewing encourages mindfulness and reduces stress and anxiety. The meditative action of sewing encourages positivity and feelings of relaxation. Being forced to concentrate on one particular task enables you to become immersed in a situation and truly unwind.

Kids who may be struggling in other areas of the school curriculum find expressive outlets through art. It's a way to uncover their abilities and talents that may not otherwise be seen. Art paves way creativity and is a special means of communicating ideas, solutions and feelings in a way other than written or verbal.

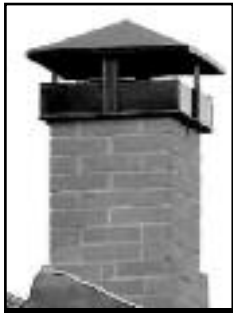

## NATIVE AMERICAN PLANTS 'NATIVES'

There is a renewed interest in growing 'native' plants throughout the nation. Although gardens go through trends of what is popular at the time, there are many good reasons for planting some natives everywhere we can.

Over the centuries native plants have adapted to their environment; our soil and weather making them more disease resistant and easier to take care of. Native plants and insects have evolved in a symbiotic relationship with flowers perfect for their pollinators. Now it is impossible for Monarch butterflies to survive without the native milkweed plants on which it lays its eggs.

The basic definition of 'native' is any plant growing in a habitat without human interference, or New World plants that were growing here before the arrival of Europeans.

There are gardens and meadows devoted to natives as well as pristine habitats such as 'The Great Swamp' in Basking Ridge, NJ. Rain Gardens, now popular to help reduce flooding, utilize natives because of their hardiness and ability to filter toxins from the water and soil.

The native plant movement has many followers who are devoted to 'native only' gardens. For mainstream gardeners, however, a blend of natives and modern plants with a few annuals is much more practical, especially since we have invested time and money over the years.

Introducing natives to your garden can be as easy as planting a few native bulbs, such as the 'Turks Cap Lily'. An old fashion lily that blooms in June with elegant speckled orange or white flowers that drip downward. These lilies are so beautiful they are now planted in gardens all over the world.

If you have space and a dramatic setting, native 'Witch Hazel' comes into bloom with

yellow blossoms in March when nothing else is in bloom.

'American Beauty Bush' has a remarkable show of lavender berries streaming down its stems in early autumn.

During late autumn our native 'Winterberry' holly drops its leaves and displays bright red berries along its branches deep into winter.

These are just a few of hundreds of different native plants that you can add to your garden.

When planting native shrubs, flowering plants, and bulbs think of its space for the long term. Many gardeners like to put in a plant and if they change their mind, just dig it up and move it, sometimes just a few feet. Many natives have deep taproots which makes them drought resistant but impossible to move successfully. Research your plant's requirements for sunlight, water and soil before planting to give it a proper start. Proper sunlight increases the energy plants require to produce more flowers.

I encourage everyone to plant a few natives in their garden. If you are at a garden fair or garden center, visit the Native Plants table, or you can find them in catalogs and on the Internet. If every garden has a few native plants, the benefits will ripple through our communities and environment.

We all enjoy showing our gardens to family and friends. When we do it's always fun to point out "this is a native."

## RAILROAD PLAYED LARGE PART IN RAHWAY GROWTH

The writer of an article outlining the history and development of the railroad through Rahway that appeared in the 125th anniversary issue of the Rahway News Record (May 27, 1948), stated, "It is safe to say at this late date that as the railroad went, so did Rahway." Tracing the city's history, there can be little doubt that since the tracks were laid in 1831 the railroad has influenced and continues to influence the growth of the city.

From Rahway's early days until the third decade of the 1800s, the main arteries for transportation and commerce were the river and St. Georges Avenue. The river was a direct route to the Arthur Kill and provided power for a variety of mills located on the waterway. St. Georges Avenue was a main road connecting New York City and Philadelphia. After the Revolutionary War, shops, homes, hotels, a church, and offices dotted St. Georges Avenue making that stretch the "business district" for the area. By the mid-1830s, however, with the coming of the railroad, reliance on the river and the road lessened, shifting the commercial center to the Main Street/Irving Street side of town and to the properties all along the railways.

The New Jersey Railroad and Transportation Company began laying tracks for a main line between New York and Philadelphia in 1831 and by January 1832 stops were being made in Rahway. A wooden passenger depot would be built in close proximity to where the present station stands. The new transportation system immediately stimulated growth and prosperity in a number of ways. Rahway's carriage trade grew into a major industry becoming one of the largest carriage manufacturing centers in the world. No longer was the river the only option for the exportation of vehicles and parts. All sorts of businesses and institutions including markets, barber shops, banks, drug stores, tailor shops, churches, laundries, jewelry stores, and saloons sprung up on Main, Irving, and Cherry Streets. The railroad also brought the city to the attention of those travelling the rails. Rahway

Station was the first suburban stop after leaving New York City and many would come to find Rahway to be a convenient and pleasant place to live. Records also reveal that a large percentage of Rahway's population was employed by the railroad. Engineers, firemen, freight and passenger crews, and maintenance workers were all needed to support the system.

The railroad also grew and made improvements over the years. In 1846 the Pennsylvania Railroad acquired the New Jersey Railroad and Transportation Company and would run the lines until 1968. It was because the mighty Penn Railroad, an organization that by 1882 had become the largest railroad, largest

transportation enterprise, and largest corporation in the world, ran through the city that large industrial concerns would choose to make Rahway their home. Over the course of 100 years, from 1880-1980, major industries including Regina, Three-in-One Oil, Quinn and Boden, Wheatena, Royal Manufacturing, Merck, National Pneumatic, Monti Christi, Purolater, and Allen Industries built their complexes on the line. A second passenger station was even built off Scott Avenue to accommodate the employees from several plants.

Trains running on ground level had always been a hazard for vehicles and pedestrians and by the early 1900s the safety concern was finally addressed. To eliminate the dangerous situation of high speed trains crossing roadways, a major project of elevating the tracks commenced in December 1911. The first stage was to construct a new elevation on the eastern side of the existing tracks allowing work to be done while trains continued to run on the old tracks. A new, impressive, two-story, brick, and terra cotta passenger station was built level to the elevated tracks and was ready to serve the public on June 26, 1913. A crowd of over 2,500 joined in celebrating the grand opening. Once the east bound lines had been raised, the old lines were elevated. The entire project, which was done with no interruption to rail traffic, was completed by May 1914. In all, twelve grade crossings had been eliminated within the city limits.

More improvements and changes in the railroad development as it affected Rahway have occurred in the ensuing years. In 1933, the entire line from Jersey City to Philadelphia was electrified. In 1968, the Pennsylvania Railroad merged with the New York Central Railroad to become Penn Central which in 1976 became Conrail. In the early 1980s, New Jersey Transit took over the operation. Many readers might remember that Rahway Station was an Amtrak stop from 1971 to 1975. In 1974, the massive white station that had served commuters for over 60 years, was razed and replaced by a simple brick station which unfortunately lacked many amenities. The present station, with its park-like entrance plaza and visually appealing design, opened in 1999.

Today, Rahway Station remains one of the busiest stations for trains travelling the Northeast Corridor and North Jersey Coast Lines and "it is safe to say at this late date" that the railroad continues to be an important factor in the present and for the future growth of the city.

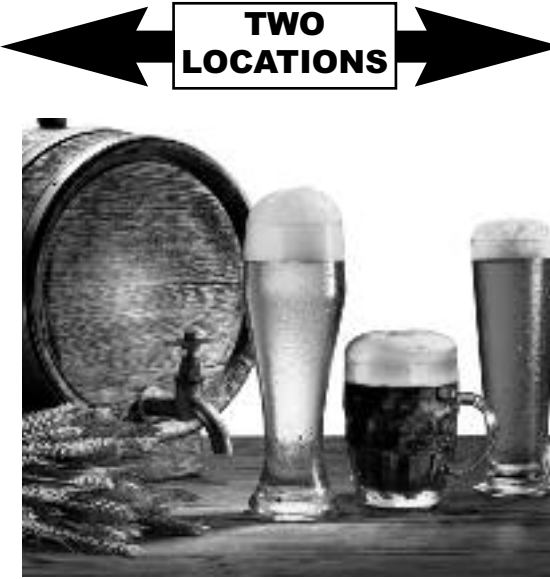
