
## **GARWOOD BASKETBALL'S ANNUAL SPIRIT NIGHT**

## **NJ TRANSIT TO ASSESS GARWOOD STATION** FOR INCREASED STOPS

I am excited to announce that NJ Transit has agreed to conduct an assessment of Garwood Station to determine if our ridership warrants additional train stops. Upon being sworn into the Office of Mayor, I hit the ground running on a number of issues and contacting NJ Transit was top among them. I received a response from Lawrence Hamm, NJ Transit's Regional Manager for Government and Community Relations, informing me that my request for additional train stops was received and an assessment is underway. While it is likely to take more than a single request to make this a reality, I will continue to lobby for better service, in quantity and quality, for those taking public transportation into and out of Garwood.

It has been a number of years since a request like this has been made, but I remain optimistic

that Garwood's service from NJ Transit will improve, particularly once large sites on South Avenue along with North Avenue are complete in the next two years or so. In fact, back in 2009, a memorandum of understanding was sent by NJ Transit to then Mayor Dennis McCarthy, which memorialized a joint commitment to making mutually-beneficial advancements. Garwood has followed through by advancing transit-oriented development projects, which will soon become more than a plan, but a reality. Now, we ask NJ Transit to stay committed to its promise of schedule enhancements.

NJ Transit is certainly facing its share of challenges at the present time. However, I am committed to building a strong line of communication between our two entities and will continue to advocate for the best interests of Garwood.
