PLAINFIELD MUSICIAN TO RECEIVE ROTARY CLUB AWARD

The Rotary Club of the Plainfields has announced that Plainfield resident Victoria Griswold, former owner of the Plainfield Music Store, will receive the 2019 Service Above Self Award at the club's 20th Annual Wine Tasting Dinner. The event will be held on May 1, 2019 at Giovanna's Restaurant in Plainfield, and is a fundraiser for the club's scholarship program.

Ms. Griswold is a renowned pianist who rescued the Plainfield Music Store when it's former owner retired. She moved the store to 120 North Avenue in Plainfield and built it into the area's premier location for sheet music. She is a member of the Plainfield Music Club, the Watchung Book Club, the Plainfield Arts Council, and numerous other organizations in support of the arts. Ms. Griswold has played with the Plainfield Symphony and many other musical groups over her career. She was recently a highlighted performer at the Plainfield Music Club's Black History Month presentation at the Plainfield Public Library.

Club President Roberta Smith cited Ms. Griswold's dedication to the arts and to her membership and service as a Rotarian as the determining factors in her selection for the award:

"Your spirit of volunteerism is manifested in the many ways that you have served the people in our area in both club and community activities. None of us on the Board can recall any club project that you did not raise your hand and volunteer to serve or chair. Third graders enjoy your presentation of dictionaries every year. Our scholarship program has benefited from your insightful review and selection of candidates every single year. Even after long hours at the Plainfield Music Store, you found time to volunteer for multiple games at Rutgers, staffing concessions for our scholarship fundraiser. In the hot sun or cloudy shade, you are always there at our Track and Field Meet and for work at the Giving Garden. These are but a few of the projects that have benefitted from your participation.

"We also will present this award in recognition of your service and accomplishments as a musician par excellence. Your dedication to music drove your decision to take ownership of the Plainfield Music Store and save it for music lovers everywhere. Under your ownership, the business expanded its reach with on-line sales and served as a resource for even more musicians throughout the world. You supported this business as a labor of love for music lovers everywhere.





This adult-only, tricky tray-style event is the West End PTA's annual fundraiser. The profits help sponsor many events and activities for the students, as well as the purchase of additional educational supplies and opportunities.

Upon completion of a persuasive writing unit in class, Lauren DeNoma, of Best Friend Dog and Animal Adoption based out of Cranford, visited the students with some special friends. She discussed this organization's mission and the importance of their work.

Students took notes during the presentation, and have now begun using their newly acquired skills to solicit donations for the rescue. NORTH PLAINFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT ACHIEVES RE-ACCREDITATION

Police Chief William G. Parenti announced Accreditation program for New Jersey. that a team of assessors from the New Jersey Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission "NJLEAC" arrived on Sunday, January 20th, 2019. The assessors re-examined all components of the Police Department's policies, procedures, management, operations, and support services. The accreditation program requires police agencies to comply with modern police standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations and support services. "North Plainfield Police was the first agency in Somerset County to receive the coveted accredited status and it is our pledge to be continue to be held to a higher standard and obtain our 4th Re-Accreditation." Chief Parenti said.

Every three years law enforcement executives from the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police come to the North Plainfield Police Department to confirm that we continue to meet the standards. A copy of the standards is available at the Borough Clerk's office and posted on the Police Department's website. For more information, contact Sergeant William Speck at 908-769-2970.

Chief Parenti stated "Accreditation is a progressive and time-proven way of helping law enforcement agencies calculate and improve their overall performances. The assessors for our Re-Accreditation were from the Rutgers University Police and the Edison Police Department. I thank the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police for pursuing the concept and developing a statewide voluntary Law Enforcement


