EARTH DAY RAHWAY RIVER CLEAN-UP - SATURDAY, APRIL 27

All volunteers are invited to celebrate Earth Day with Boy Scout Troop 330, Cub Scout Pack 30 and members of the Rahway River Watershed Association in a clean-up of the Rahway River on Saturday, April 27th, 2019 (with a rain date of Sunday, April 28th). The clean-up will focus on areas upstream and downstream of the dam at Winfield Park, New Jersey. It is our hope to have enough folks participate that we can have teams work as far upstream as the Garden State Parkway and downstream through Rahway River Park in Clark, Linden and Rahway. Plans are to meet at the parking area adjacent to the waterfall of the Rahway River by the dam at Winfield Park at 8:45 a.m. This is a great way to celebrate Earth Day and if you haven't participated in an event like this before, you will find it invigorating, and you will feel good about what you have accomplished...it is also fun and educational...especially for scouts and young adults as they always find something interesting.

The clean-up will generally be between 9 a.m. – 12 p.m., but any amount of time or effort that folks can volunteer is appreciated. There is always a large volume of floatable debris to pick up. This includes tires and of course floatables (cans, bottles, plastics, etc.). The County of Union generously supplies gloves and garbage bags, and we solicit material donations (donuts, bagels, coffee, bottled water, paper towels, hand-wipes, etc.) for all volunteers.

Last year, over 100 folks participated, including girl scouts, cub scouts, boy scouts, fishermen, local activists and citizens, and we pulled some amazing things from the river. Sponsors came through with coffee, bagels, danish, donuts, cookies, bottled water, and juice boxes, and we had grilled hot dogs for lunch. We also had other giveaways for the participants.

All participants should wear jeans, long-sleeved shirts, gloves and boots, and waders are welcome for folks who like to get a little wet. Each participant should bring a standard 5-gallon carry bucket with a handle (put your name on the bottom)...this makes for easy carrying of "stuff"

for transfer to the large garbage bags. When we complete the event we do a basic inventory of the "big stuff" that we removed....and within approximately 24 hours Union County Parks removes and disposes of all the trash. There is no RSVP required but if you need more information or think you will attend please let us know by e-mail at rivercleanup@comcast.net.

RED TAIL FOX

Most people living in New Jersey would be surprised to know we share our territory with the 'Red Tail Fox'.

Sadly for many of us the only encounter we might have is to see a Red Tail Fox dead on the roadside. It's heartbreaking when we realize how the fox has adjusted to living beside humans for centuries. Now with new construction enclosing on their habitats and faster vehicles, the plight of the Red Tail Fox is more perilous than ever.

The life span of the red fox in the wild is two to four years.

Red foxes are about three feet long and two feet tall. One of the most noticeable characteristics of the red fox is the fluffy white-tipped tail. Red foxes have long snouts and red fur across the face, back, sides, and tail. Their throat, chin, and belly are grayish-white. Red foxes have black feet and black-tipped ears that are large and pointy.

Like a cat's tail, the fox's thick tail aids with balance, but it has other uses as well. A fox uses its tail, called a brush, as a warm cover in cold weather and as a signal flag to communicate with other foxes.

Foxes like all canines signal each other by making scent posts, urinating on trees or rocks to announce their presence.

If you are lucky enough to spot a Red Tail Fox it is easy to distinguish by sight from other members of the canine (dog) family. Please don't follow it or scare it away. They are justifiably scared of humans, their major predator, especially if they have young.

Red foxes live around the world in many diverse habitats including forests, grasslands, mountains, and deserts. They also adapt well to human environments such as farms, suburban areas, and even large urban communities. The

red fox's resourcefulness has earned it a legendary reputation for intelligence and cunning.

Red foxes are solitary hunters who feed on rodents, rabbits, birds, and other small game—but their diet can be as flexible as their home habitat. Foxes will eat fruit and vegetables, fish, frogs, and even worms. If living among humans, foxes will opportunistically dine on garbage and pet food. Red foxes have excellent hearing. They can hear low-frequency sounds and rodents digging underground.

In winter, foxes meet to mate. The vixen (female) typically gives birth to a litter of 2 to 12 pups. At birth, red foxes are actually brown or gray. A new red coat usually grows in by the end of the first month, but some red foxes are golden, reddish-brown, silver, or even black. Both parents care for their young through the summer before they are able to strike out on their own in the fall.

In mythology, lore and religions, the fox has been held in high esteem around the world from the time of ancient Egypt. The Red Tail Fox is usually depicted as clever and a cunning trickster, but seldom evil.

Please NEVER feed or approach a fox. They are wild animals and their fear of humans is essential for survival. Once tamed a fox cannot be successfully returned to the wild.

A LEGEND OF BURIED TREASURE ON THE BANKS OF THE RAHWAY RIVER

Tales of buried treasure always pique the imagination and conjure up romantic images of swashbuckling pirates, chivalrous highwaymen, and rakish outlaws. When such stories refer to places that are close to home, fascination levels increase and dreams of uncovering oaken chests filled with gold and jewels can easily slip from fantasy to reality. One such story that became legendary by the 1800s and set many a treasure seeker digging along the banks of the Rahway River, was the legend of Captain Kidd's buried treasure.

A story long lost in the archives of the Rahway Herald dated April 15, 1837, tells the intriguing tale of Captain Kidd who sometime between the years 1689 and 1695 sailed from New York across the Arthur Kill and down the Rahway River in search of a place to hide his ill-gotten wealth. The spot he eventually found was known as Price's or Post's Woods, a small piece of woodland located along the southern banks of the river midway between Rahway and the Sound. After bringing his ship as close to land as safety would allow, the anchor was dropped, and two small boats were lowered. Pirates were coming ashore.

Once on dry land, Kidd, along with several members of his crew, headed into the woods and stopped when they reached an oak tree of enormous height and girth. With a hand gesture given by the captain, three pirates, with spades in hand, began digging a pit. Once the excavation was complete, the crew went back to the boats to unload their cargo. When they returned to the tree, their arms were filled with bars of silver and gold and bags containing jewelry and precious stones. The men brought the valuables to the edge of the hole and getting another silent signal from the captain, dropped the riches to the bottom. The entire process was accomplished in complete silence without a word being spoken. The stillness, however, was shattered suddenly when a loud shot rang out. Kidd had drawn his pistol and fired on one of his men, who having been killed instantly, fell dead to the ground. Replacing the weapon in his belt, Kidd instructed the others to toss the lifeless body into the pit where it fell among the rich treasure. The hole was then filled with earth, leveled and patted down, and covered with leaves. The mission completed, the pirates left the scene as stealthily as they had come, returned to their ship, and sailed back into New York Harbor.

The incident just recorded might never have been told had it not been for the sharp eyes and

curious nature of one local Lenape chieftain known as Ra-wa-rah who secretly witnessed the entire devilish episode. The legend maintains that on the evening of the same day, Chief Ra-Wa-Rah was returning to his village in a canoe filled with an abundant supply of fish he had caught earlier. By now it was dark and as he paddled toward friendly campfires his keen eyes spotted a light far down the river that appeared to float on the water. It was not long before he realized the light was from a ship and he was soon able to make out a skull and cross bones on a flag that waved gently in the moon-lit sky. The Indian decided to ascertain what was afoot and maneuvered the canoe ashore, always being cautious by remaining in the dark shadows. In an effort not to be seen, but to gain a vantage point from where he could see all, the Indian adroitly climbed a tall tree and sat quietly on a sturdy branch. As fate would have it, the tree was the very one under which the pirates would bury their booty. The Indian saw and heard everything. When the nocturnal activity was over, Ra-Wa-Rah left his perch and returned to his village. Fearing he might anger the Great Spirit because of all the evil he saw, he kept the story a secret until the last days of his life. Finally, in his dying whispers he recalled many vivid details, but the chief never imparted the exact location in the woods nor did he make

mention of the giant oak.

A good legend is made believable when there are facts that can be associated with the tale. Captain William Kidd (1645-1701) was one of history's most notorious pirates. An infamous marauder, he made a career of attacking ships and commandeering their treasures. Between the years 1689 and 1695 Kidd spent time in New York and was by no means a stranger to this locality. In New York, he met and courted a wealthy socialite named Sarah Bradley, a young woman who before her eighteenth birthday had already been twice married. Kidd became Sarah's third husband on May 16, 1691 and for the next decade both would be hunted by the law. Kidd was eventually captured in Boston, transported to London, and tried for piracy and murder. Found guilty, he was hanged on May 23, 1701. He went to his grave never giving information regarding where his treasures were hidden. Sarah was arrested on the suspicion she knew where to find her husband's treasures. If she did know, she never let on. The amount of time she spent in jail is not certain, but she was released for lack of evidence. With her possessions restored, Sarah returned to New York where she managed to escape her past relationship with Kidd. In 1703 she married her fourth husband, a gentleman named Christopher Rousby, whose home was in Rahway. The pair had three children and Sarah, who lived until 1744, never left the area. Might she have stayed thinking that one day she would retrieve the captain's treasure trove?

There's another bit of factual information that must be mentioned before this account can be closed. It was from a derivation of the name of Chief Ra-Wa-Rah that the City of Rahway gets its name.

“SEW IT, SIGN IT” QUILT PROJECT TO BENEFIT SICKLE CELL AWARENESS

It's estimated that sickle cell disease affects 75,000 to 100,000 people in the United States, and about 6,000 individuals in New Jersey alone. While the blood disorder primarily affects

persons of African descent, it's also present throughout the Mediterranean, as well as Middle Eastern and Asian countries.

After a casual conversation with two students at the Cultured Expressions Sewing & Quilting Studio in Rahway, owner Lisa Shepard Stewart and associate Edie Browne brainstormed ideas for a sewing-related community project. Soon, the two settled on a fundraising quilt project to benefit sickle cell awareness, as Edie herself lives with the disease. Edie is also involved in the Sickle Cell Association of New Jersey, which will be the recipient of the funds raised. This was the beginning of the “Sew It, Sign It” project.

As the name implies, supporters visit the studio to SEW an easy 6” quilt block using colorful African prints (just 2 seams!), then SIGN the block, all for a registration fee of \$10, of which \$8 will be donated to the Association. Or they can just sign a plain ivory fabric square to be stitched into the borders of the quilt for a \$5 registration fee, of which \$3 will be donated. Of course, participants can donate above these levels by sewing multiple blocks or making an additional contribution to help cover the cost of finishing the quilt. The donor can include his or her own name, a personal message of encouragement, a tribute to a loved one afflicted with the illness or other positive sentiment. Participants will receive a custom logo button.

“We welcome everyone in the community to support this effort,” said Shepard Stewart. “We encourage folks to come out and experience the fun of working with African prints while contributing to a very worthy cause.” The public is invited to visit the CE studio to sew blocks from now through May 18 on a drop-in basis during regular studio hours, or by appointment. The blocks will be joined into a finished quilt to be displayed locally, then presented to the Association along with the collected funds by World Sickle Cell Day on June 19, 2019.

“Sew It, Sign It is a great group activity for families, quilt guilds, scouts, churches, civic groups and others. Beginners are especially welcome, and we'll guide you through the process of sewing and signing the quilt block, which takes no more than 5 minutes,” Shepard Stewart said.

Non-local customers can also participate by ordering block kits online at CulturedExpressions.com (The \$15 kit cost includes donation, fabrics, instructions, logo button and SASE to return the finished block.)

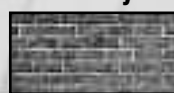

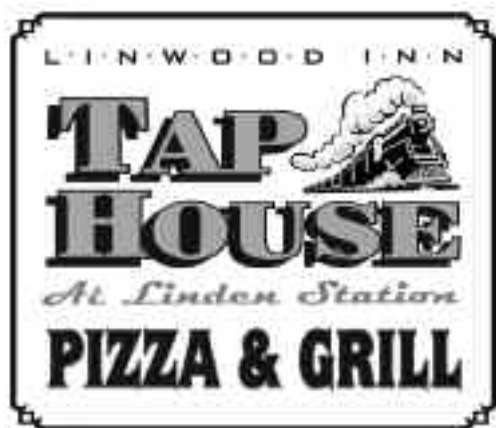

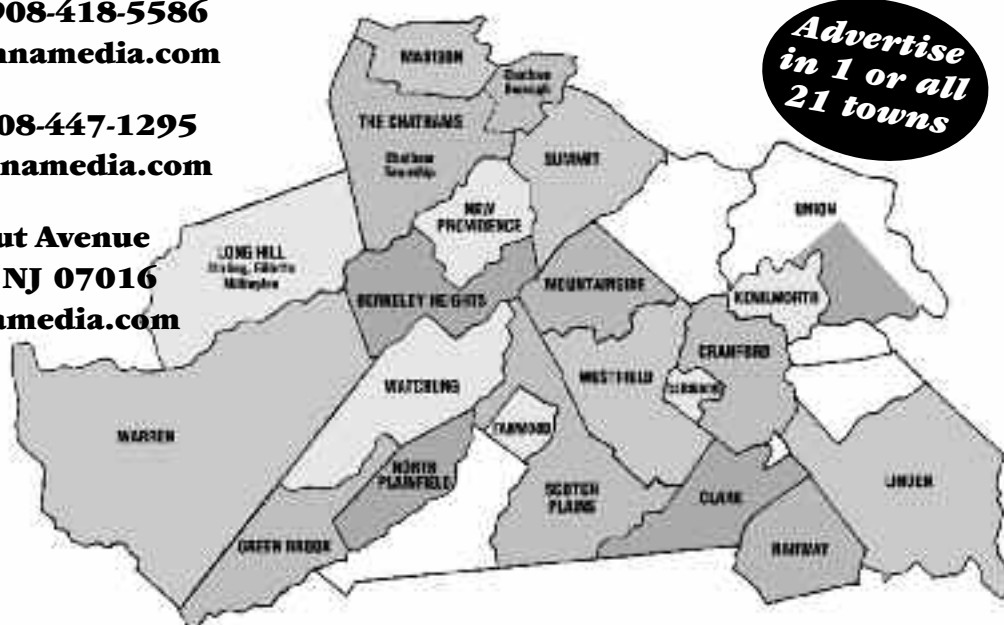
