June 3-7: Restaurant Week!

June 6: 75th Anniversary of "Operation Overlord", also known as "D-Day" 156,000 American, British and Canadian forces landed on five beaches off the coast of France.

June 7: Battle of Connecticut Farms Remembrance day. Kenilworth's Proclamation giving our Borough recognition for being a part of the Battle of Connecticut Farms in 1780. While it was not "Kenilworth" at that time, in and around our Borough the Militia was responsible for halting an advance of 5000 Hessians en route to Morristown to attack Washington's Continental Army.

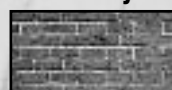

REGISTER FOR SUMMER YOUTH BASEBALL LEAGUE

The Union County Baseball Association invites baseball players between the ages of 8 and 15 to register for its Summer Youth Baseball League.

All games are played in Warinanco Park, on the border of Elizabeth and Roselle, Monday through Thursday between 9 a.m. and 12 p.m. The games are coached and supervised by Union County Baseball Association staff. The season will begin in late June and end the first week of August.

Players are divided into three age groups: Minor League 8-10 year olds, Major League 11-12 year olds, and Teen League 13-15 year olds.

The Union County Baseball Association has added indoor clinics to the Summer League program. UCBA staff will utilize the new state-of-the-art Warinanco Park Skating Center, which is equipped with artificial turf and indoor batting cages, to provide players weekly clinics focused on hitting, fielding, pitching, and catching. This added benefit is included with the player registration fee.

The registration fee for the Summer Baseball League is \$50 and players can register online at ucba-nj.org. In-person registration will also be held on June 15th and June 22nd from 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. at the Warinanco Park Boathouse.

YWCA UNION COUNTY HONORS EIGHT ALLIES

The YWCA Union County honored eight individuals and organizations for their committed effort on behalf of domestic violence survivors during their Annual Meeting held at the Clark Public Library on April 25, 2019.

Each honoree received a certificate and resolution in their name for their partnership in empowering survivors of domestic violence throughout the county. The honorees were Theresa Cosmas; Sgt. Mahasin El-Amin; Ryan & Dana Felmet; First Presbyterian Church of Cranford; Garden State Bank: A division of New York Community Bank; Annette Ferrigno, Kids For Kids: A Mindfulness Movement; Gail Veltre, Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital, Rahway – Barnabas Health; and Lauren Thorne.

The YWCA's mission is eliminating racism, empowering women, and promoting peace, justice, freedom and dignity for all. Locally, the YWCA Union County is on a mission to empower survivors of domestic violence to become safe and free from abuse through comprehensive, client-centered services, and through education, collaboration and advocacy that builds safe, informed and supportive communities.

Domestic violence crosses all barriers of race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, gender and socioeconomic status and it is a crime that impacts our entire community. It is estimated that 1 in every 4 women will be affected by domestic violence in her life- more than breast cancer, lung

cancer, and ovarian cancer combined. The monetary cost of domestic violence in the United States in dollars has been estimated to exceed 9.3 billion a year in medical and mental health services, loss of productivity, and loss of paid earnings. An average of 3 women per day in the United States are killed as a result of domestic violence.

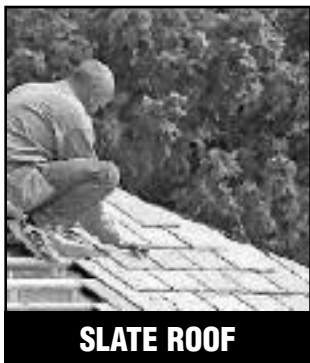

WHAT, WHERE, AND WHEN IN OLD KENILWORTH – GREATEST GENERATION

Part I of a tribute saluting ten living Kenilworth veterans who fought in World War II appeared in the May edition of this newspaper. Since that publication one has passed away.

Technical Sergeant Alex “Kelsy” Kuriawa, of the US Army, 99, passed away suddenly on May 5, 2019. TSgt. Kuriawa served from 1943-1945. He was part of the Normandy Invasion (D-Day)

and fought in the Battle of the Bulge under immense enemy shelling and gun fire. Born in Elizabeth, he and his late wife of 66 years, Helen, moved to Kenilworth in 1953. Their four sons are: Kevin, Christopher, John, and Michael. Known by his nickname, Kelsy, he served in the Kenilworth public works department for 34 years, most of the time as superintendent.

Motor Machinists Mate 2nd Class James F. Lucadema, 93, served in the US Navy, 1944-1946. Headquartered at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, he was on anti-submarine patrols off the South American coast. Among the ships he sailed was the USS Marlboro (APB 38). His future wife, Lucille Sodano, enlisted in the WAVES in 1945. She passed away this April at age 95. Married in 1949, they moved to Kenilworth in 1956. Their children are Kenneth and Donna (Masucci).

Seaman First Class Robert Moldenhauer, 92, served in the US Navy, 1944-1946. Stationed aboard the destroyer, USS Hyman, his ship was hit by a kamikaze plane at the Battle of Okinawa, causing fire and death. At the Battle of Iwo Jima, he witnessed the flag raised on Mt. Suribachi. Married in 1949 to Marie DeStefano, they moved that year to Kenilworth. They are the parents of three: Robert, Lynn, and Brian. VFW Post 2230 honored him, and fellow navy veteran John Beninati, in 2015. Moldenhauer served 23 years as a special police officer.

Private 1st Class John A. Rembish, 95, served in the US Army, 1943-1946. In the artillery battery, he saw action in southern France during

the invasion of Anzio and later in Germany. At war's end he was in Austria. He and his late wife, Ann Sickie, both born in Pennsylvania, married in 1955 and moved to Kenilworth in 1963. They have four sons: John, Jr., Michael, Peter, and James.

Private 1st Class Robert D. Sammons, 97, served in the Army Air Corps, 1943-1946. Pfc Sammons was primarily stationed at Guam while serving in the Asiatic-Pacific Theater. His duties included special vehicle operator, and training with the Thompson submarine gun. He was a second-class gunner. Born in Bayonne and married in 1949, he and his late wife of 63 years, Dorine Faircloth, moved to Kenilworth in 1955. They have a son, Richard.

Another surviving veteran, a corporal, age 95, served in the US Army, 1943-1946. He wishes to remain anonymous at this time. Mainly stationed in India he also was stationed in Africa. When on board ship in the Mediterranean, it and another ship sailing behind his, were attacked for two days by German aircraft. The second ship was sunk with great loss of life. Married in 1949, he and his late wife moved to Kenilworth in 1951. They have three sons.

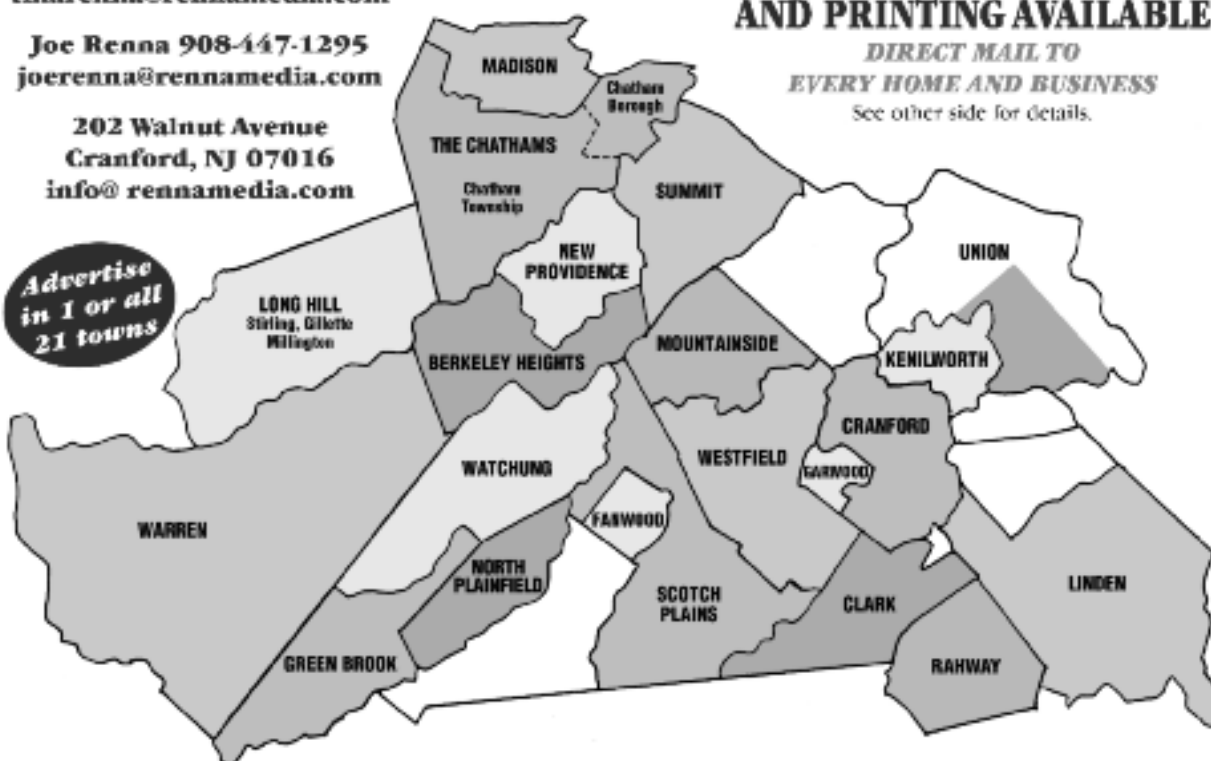
