GIRLS' TRACK AND BOYS' TENNIS TIE IN GPA CHALLENGE

The Arthur L. Johnson Athletic Department recently held a breakfast in honor of the 2019 Spring Athletics GPA Challenge winners the Girls' Track and Field Team and the Boys' Tennis Team. For the first time in the awards history, two teams finished with identical GPAs, so both were given the award and enjoyed the ceremonial breakfast. The event, sponsored by the Athletic Department, was held in the Arthur L. Johnson High School Cafeteria.

The Crusader GPA Challenge is awarded each season to the team that finishes with the highest overall GPA among athletic teams seasonally. They will be presented with certificates, have their team memorialized on a plaque, and be invited for a "Breakfast with the A.D." to celebrate their actions both in the classroom and on the field. MEMORIAL PARK REDEDICATED

On Sunday, May 19th, 2019, the Historical Committee rededicated Memorial Park, first installed in 1959, as the rock bearing a plaque was recently relocated to a more prominent spot at the Garwood Recreation Complex.
