WITH \$15,000 IN AWARDS, SCHOLARSHIP CONTINUES TO GROW

A \$1,000 scholarship awarded in 1993 to a Linden High School senior named Danny Robertozzi is still paying dividends to LHS students today.

Robertozzi, now the superintendent of Linden Public Schools, had been selected to receive the Kenneth Hetem Memorial Scholarship, given to a lineman on the LHS football team with top grades.

"I was a student sitting in the audience on scholarship night, and I remember one of the speakers saying, 'If you ever have the opportunity to come back to your community and give back, please make sure you do,'" Robertozzi said.

Those words stuck with him until the day he became superintendent in 2013, when he decided it was time to pay his scholarship forward.

He enlisted the help of his former high school guidance counselor, Theodore Simonelli, in creating the Danny A. Robertozzi Superintendent Scholarship Fund. In the first year, the fund paid out one \$500 scholarship.

At this year's LHS Scholarship Awards Program on Monday, May 13, 2019, Robertozzi announced that the fund will hand out \$1,500 scholarships to 10 students, and was met with a roar of applause.

The seniors chosen to receive the awards this year are Jaclyn Beviano, Austin Urban, Brooke Beyer, Love Desrosiers, Ariana Eastwood, Darius Lewis, Daniel Lopez, Siarrah Myers, Asia Todd and Piotr Zelazny.

"Some of the finest kids in Linden High School," Simonelli said.

The Superintendent's Scholarships are supported solely through private donations. A fundraising dinner has been held for the past two years at Amici's Restaurant in Linden, bringing together people from throughout the district and community to support the fund through ticket sales and raffles.

The recipients are chosen by a committee headed by Simonelli, based on an application and essay.

Robertozzi dedicates the scholarship to his parents, Nan and Tony Robertozzi, whom he lost to illness a year apart while he was in college. In fact, the criteria for selection were inspired by his parents. Students are chosen for outstanding character or a pursuit of a career in education.

"I do it in the memory of my mom for character because my mom was the nicest person ever in the history of the world," he said. "And she always told me to do the right thing.

"And my dad worked hard. He worked in a chemical factory for 30 years and never missed a day of work.

"So they taught me that through good character and hard work, you'll always be successful."

The Superintendent's Scholarships were awarded at Linden High School's annual awards night, where \$100,000 of scholarship were distributed.

"We celebrate the achievement of our students," Principal Yelena Horré said in opening remarks to the crowded auditorium. "We give them accolades and a little bit more, and then send them off into the world knowing that we believe in them, the community believes in them. Congratulations to all the students and thank you to all the community members who support us."

LINDEN'S 2019 SUMMER CONCERT SERIES DEDICATED TO GARY LUCIANO

The 2019 City of Linden Summer Concert Series opening night was held on Tuesday, June 4, 2019. Jim Barone – Elvis Tribute band, had the large crowd dancing and singing along to Elvis tunes at the jam packed Raymond Wood Bauer Promenade.

The evening opened with Linden's Recreation Supervisor, Nancy Braxton, announcing that the 2019 concert series is dedicated to the Memory of Gary Luciano, a former Linden councilman and supervisor of the Recreation Department who passed away on Sunday, April 21, 2019. Gary Luciano was instrumental in having the Promenade built and bringing about the concert series as well as many other popular events in the city. He lived with his family in Linden for 42 years prior to moving to Rahway.

Braxton, emotional at times, stated "Tonight is a bitter sweet night, our friend Gary Luciano passed away on Easter Sunday. We decided that we were going to dedicate this season to Gary because he was one of the main reasons that we have this promenade. And we have to be grateful to him. Gary was a magnificent person as most of you know. I want to thank his family for sharing him with us for all those years. We love him and we will remember him always."

Raymond Wood Bauer Promenade is the home of the Performing Arts in Linden, New Jersey. There are free concerts, special events such as National Night Out Against Crime and Fire

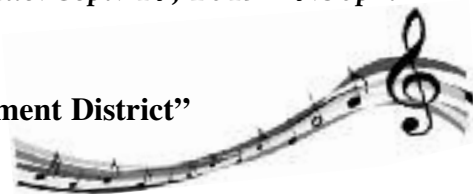

The Linden High School NJROTC held a dignified change of command ceremony on May 13, 2019, revealing the commanding officer for the 2019-20 school year, as well as the regimental staff, which will lead the unit through the next school year.

Commanding Officer Cadet Capt. Gilbert Nolasco, a graduating senior, was relieved by junior Mario Rodriguez.

The auditorium was packed with cadets, families, staff, and honored guests including Assistant Superintendent Denise Cleary and other administrators, members of the Board of Education, Mayor Derek Armstead, Linden Chief of Police David Hart, and leaders of local military groups.

Commander Boyd Decker, senior Naval Science instructor at Linden High School, spoke about the unit and what the ceremony represents to the cadets.

Principal Yelena Horré said the NJROTC is one of the school's most successful programs, making up about a quarter of the school population.

The Change of Command followed the unit's annual awards ceremony. The top honors of the night went to cadets Gladylise Mendez and Maurice Faulk, who were named female and male Cadets of the Year, respectively.

Faulk was also honored along with cadets Erik Hernandez, Onelvi Martinez and Andrew Lopez for their enlistment in the U.S. Marine Corps. The four will depart for basic training shortly after graduation.

The Linden High School Navy Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps, founded in 1986, is a voluntary citizen development program focusing on character education, leadership and service. Most cadets do not go on to serve in the military, but are better prepared to take on the challenges of higher education or the workforce because of the discipline and sense of commitment they learn in the program.



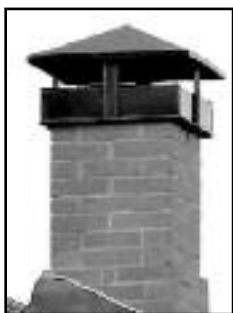

Anna was honored by the Board of Education at its meeting on May 30, where she was surprised by Kefalas with a bag of donated gifts to make sure that she got some birthday presents after all.

Kefalas, who teaches at School No. 8 and School No. 10, is a cancer survivor herself. She feels obligated to help raise money and awareness because of all the help and kindness she was shown from the Linden Public Schools community when she was fighting breast cancer.

"I had one of those days really bad days," she recalled. "It was a bad chemo day and it was awful weather. I remember sitting in my house and saying, 'God, if you just get me through this, I swear I will do everything I can to pay it forward.'"

For the past two years, she has sold T-shirts that read "Fight Like a Tiger" in honor of the Linden mascot, with proceeds going to the American Cancer Society.

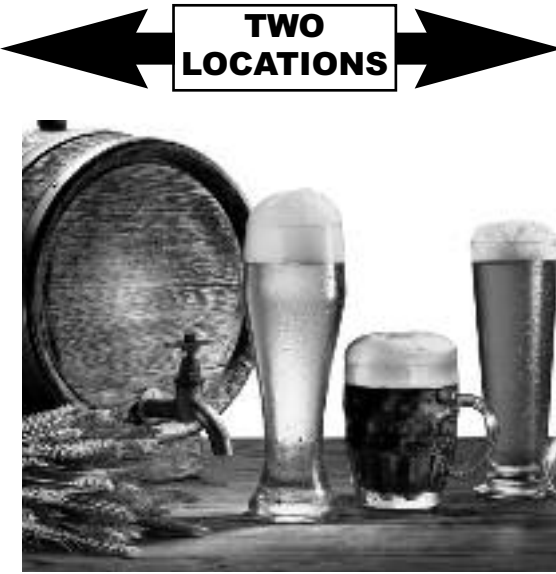
