HISTORICAL SOCIETY AND GIRL SCOUTS CELEBRATE 19TH AMENDMENT

All of the girls marched down proudly wearing white along with their sashes/vests and a yellow ribbon loosely fastened around their waists to symbolize the sun shining on the democracy of the women's movement.

In addition to her length of service and dedication the Chatham community, Grobert's exceptional blend of patient care skills and knowledge, leadership and teamwork and a calm demeanor in times of crisis made her a stand-out choice among the members of the Chatham Emergency Squad.
