#### **CRANFORD STANDS OUT IN EMS COMPETITION**

Ten Cranford First Aid Squad cadets entered the New Jersey State Cadet competition. Cranford teams came home with 2nd and 3rd places. The event was hosted by Keyport First Aid Squad, with teams coming from New York and Pennsylvania in addition to New Jersey.

The Cranford team of Michelle Carneiro, Parth Shah, and Mikaylee Grohol won second place. The team of Caitlin Cook, Ally Licks, Emma DeBole, and Alex Machos won third place. Others competing were Kat Riggins, Gianni Matadial and Amanda Hogan. Advisors for the teams were Abraham Pritzker, Winona Whelan, Sue Lucas and Kent Lucas.

Cranford teams all competed in the Advanced division, where the three to four-person teams were required to have at least one certified EMT. They were judged in three scenarios, including a trauma victim, a cardiac victim and a motor vehicle collision with entrapped victims. Advanced teams were judged on patient assessment and proper equipment use

- backboard, traction splint, cervical collar, oxygen and nitroglycerin administration, obtaining vital signs, CPR and airway management. The teams worked with fire department crews during the car crash scenarios with actual vehicles.

The Cranford First Aid Squad cadet program consists of high school members, ages 16-18, with the intent of becoming New Jersey certified EMTs. Cranford has the largest cadet program in Union County with over 20 members.

"We strongly encourage all our high school members to take the Union County College EMT course and become EMTs" said advisor Kent Lucas. "They will get the most out of their time at Cranford First Aid Squad by becoming EMTs. Not all of our members plan to go into a medical field but they still benefit from the experience and will know how to handle any medical emergency when they finish."

#### **JANE RANDALL CELEBRATES 100TH BIRTHDAY AT THE CHELSEA**


Jane Randall, an immigrant from Scotland who met her husband overseas then moved to the U.S after World War II to raise a family, celebrated her 100th birthday at her home at The Chelsea at Fanwood on Thursday, July 18th, 2019.

Mrs. Randall spent her childhood and young adult life in and around Edinburgh, raised by an aunt and uncle. After graduating high school she learned to use adding machines called comptometers, the first mechanical calculators that were actually invented in the U.S. in the late 19th century. She became experienced enough to teach young women how to use them. She later worked as an accountant at a brewery. She has vivid memories of being on the roof of the building where they worked to wave at the royal family when they came to town, especially Queen Elizabeth II wearing her signature bonnet.

She met her husband Ronald, a U.S. soldier stationed in the UK, and they moved to the states, settling first in Chicago and eventually ending up in Cranford, NJ. She enjoyed living there and was active in the Episcopal church. She volunteered for 30 years at a local resale shop.

Mrs. Randall had four children. She has six grandchildren and two great grandchildren. Her family celebrated her birthday separately. Her Chelsea friends celebrated with a cake and music.

## LIBRARY HAS A VISIT FROM THE BRIGHT & BEAUTIFUL THERAPY DOGS

On July 9, 2019 The Bright & Beautiful Therapy Dogs visited the Cranford Public Library to facilitate their "Paws" for Reading program where furry friends lend a floppy ear to emerging readers to hone their reading skills by reading to certified therapy dogs. These programs help the childern gain confidence by reading aloud. Practicing reading to the dogs makes it easier for the children to speak in front of groups later on.

The Bright and Beautiful Therapy Dogs, Inc. is a nonprofit 501(c) 3 organization which evaluates, tests, trains and qualifies owners and their well behaved dogs as therapy dog teams. These teams give unconditional love, boost selfesteem, and relieve loneliness and boredom. Did you know petting a dog will lower your blood pressure? The benefits are endless. They work in nursing homes, hospitals, psychiatric wards, shelters, schools and many other facilities.

Pet therapists are in great demand, and there is a serious shortage of therapy dogs.

Our dogs visit children in pediatrics. Most of the children have never been away from home before. They are frightened, fearful at the prospect of having to spend the night in a big scary hospital. Sometimes the children are severely handicapped. When they visit, the dogs seem to spark a reaction no one has ever seen before. Children in hospitals hold therapy dogs while being infused with chemotherapy. Libraries and schools are discovering how reading out loud to a dog can relieve shyness and reduce inhibitions,

We visit lonely seniors in nursing and assisted living homes. The dogs and handlers provide a welcome change in their routine and often form lasting friendships with the patients. They bring back pleasant memories of family pets in days gone by.

When we visit rehabilitation facilities and hospitals, the patients are able to ease the boredom of institutional life or the pain of recent surgery by visits from a friendly face with a wagging tail. Sometimes a depressed patient who

hasn't spoken in months will have a conversation with a dog. Difficult patients can become more compliant with a furry face to convince them to take that pill.

We never charge for visitation. We pride ourselves upon being an all volunteer organization, so contributions and donations are important to us. Of course, all are tax deductible.





#### CRANFORD POLICE DEPARTMENT YOUTH POLICE ACADEMY GRADUATION

Department Youth Police Academy graduated on Friday, July 12, 2019 after completing a oneweek course designed to expose them to the functions of the police department.

The academy program, designed to bridge the gap between the members of the police department and the youth of Cranford, included 51 cadets from Cranford between the ages of 11 and 14. "The primary goal of the Youth Police Academy is to encourage open communication between Cranford youth and the members of the Cranford Police Department" said Cranford Police Chief Ryan Greco.

Each academy day started with one hour of physical fitness and military drill practice led by Patrolman Daniel Donnerstag followed by classroom lectures and demonstrations. Detective Steven D'Ambola and Captain Joseph Van Bergen coordinated training sessions designed to familiarize the cadets with the roles of Cranford police officers, as well as the functions of various county and state law enforcement agencies. During the week, cadets received classroom lectures and practical exercises on police

The thirteenth class of the Cranford Police department structure, patrol operations, motor vehicle stops, investigative techniques, DWI, first aid/CPR, firearms safety, gang awareness, and traffic investigations. Patrolmen Ryan Gerrity and Lynne Galvez also assist in the daily activities.

> Demonstrations were presented by the Cranford Police Department's Water Rescue Unit, Firearms Unit, Investigative Division, and Traffic Bureau. Additional presentations were made by the Cranford Fire Department Emergency Medical Services, United States Marine Corps, New Jersey State Police, New Jersey Transit Police Department, New Jersey Office of Homeland Security & Preparedness, Union County Sheriff's K-9 and Crime Scene Units, Union County Bomb Squad, Union County SWAT, Union County Prosecutor's Office, Union County Office of Emergency Management, United States Secret Service, and United States Homeland Security Investigations.

> More than 150 family and friends of the cadets attended the graduation ceremony held at the Cranford Community Center. Chief Ryan Greco, Captain Joseph Van Bergen, and Detective

Steven D'Ambola led the graduation ceremonies. During the ceremony, family and friends were given an overview of the Youth Academy Program. The highlight of the graduation was a video depicting the weeklong training experience. All graduating cadets received certificates for their participation in the program.

This year's session of the academy was dedicated to Honorary Police Officer Raymond Schwartz who passed away earlier this year after a courageous fight against cancer. Ray was a previous Youth Academy cadet and junior instructor. In his honor the Ray Schwartz Memorial Award was created and awarded to a cadet for displaying exceptional integrity and dedication to the Cranford Police Department and Police Youth Academy. This year's award was presented to cadet Ryan Kilbashian.

Retired Secret Service Agent Tom Sloan donated a signed copy of his book "Guardians of Democracy" to each cadet. The book chronicles the 150-year history of the US Secret Service. In addition, he had every cadet sign a copy of the book in Ray's memory and the book was presented to the Schwartz family at graduation.


