

Keira worked hard to learn the process of community pet adoptions and the challenges that homeless pets face. Her 50 hoursplus project was to assist Rawhide Rescue in bringing dogs up for adoption to pet adoption days held at PetSmart. She fostered a dog that was homeless and eventually adopted a homeless

The largest problem is the increasing number

of homeless pets, contributed to by puppy mills, families that do not neuter or spay, and pet abandonment. Many area rescues bring dogs from high kill shelters in the south that are filled with unwanted pets. Once the shelters fill up the older animals are placed on the Red List of animals scheduled for euthanasia. At that point rescues get emails asking for those animals to be taken into foster care.



The Silver Award is the second highest award a Girl Scout can achieve. One of the most challenging aspects of running a small non-profit is having a place to meet. A good meeting room provides an atmosphere that facilitates effective and decisive meetings.


There's nothing wrong with a friend's living room or a library conference room. Starbucks and Panera Bread seem not to mind meetings. However these options aren't always reliable because of their "first-come, first-serve" nature and certainly can become challenging when the number of members grows.

The Watchung Hills Elks have 6.5 acres of property that include a lodge meeting hall, bandstand, picnic ground and pavilion. These are all available for rent by the public — birthday parties, retirement celebrations, weddings, concerts, movie-nights, etc.

But for non-profits in and near Warren Township, NJ, they can be rented at no charge. (Additionally if you're an Elk, you gain access to our bar/lounge and large, private swimming pool.) Areas are available at no-charge, Mondays through Thursdays for non-profits and available Fridays through Sundays for a suitable donation. There is seating for about 80 at the round tables in the "banquet style" and seating for about 100 in the "theater style." 8 foot pull-down projection screen (bring your own projector) is available. Other attributes include high-speed internet, good overhead lighting, and ample parking.

We're happy to count these non-profit organizations as satisfied customers of our facilities: American Legion of North Plainfield, Warren Township Cub Scouts, Warren Township Girl Scouts, Warren Township Honorary PBA, and Warren Township PBA Local #235.




RAINFOREST SPECIAL EVENT HELD AT WARRENBROOK SENIOR CENTER




