HAPPY 100TH BIRTHDAY ANN MACCHIA COONS

North Plainfield is home to the "Lunch Bunch," established in September 2014. This small group of senior women who enjoy social events/ meets monthly for lunch at various local restaurants.

One of our members has reached a milestone and we are proud to share the good news with the North Plainfield community.

Anna (Ann) Macchia Coons is celebrating her 100th Birthday this month. The second youngest of 10 children, Ann was born on October 4, 1919 in Jersey City. New Jersey.

After graduating from All Saints Grammar School, Ann continued her education at Lincoln High School, graduating in 1937. Her interest in sewing and her dream of designing elegant dresses was quickly realized when Ann found herself enrolled in The Traphagen School of Design in New York City. One of Ann's designs was chosen for the cover of the school's magazine - "Fashion Digest."

To feature the latest clothing designs, Traphagen held fashion shows in New York City hotels. Guy Lombardo and his Royal Canadians was the orchestra that accompanied the models for the shows. After 2 years Ann received her certificate of completion from Traphagen.

Ann got a job as a sample maker at Abe Shrader Dress Company on 7th Avenue, NYC. She would receive a sketch and make the pattern and sample. Her pay was \$65 a week.

She worked for Shrader during the day, but since this was during World War II, she got a job at RCA as an assemblyline worker from 11 P.M. to 7 A.M. to help the war effort.

Harold Coons was a regular visitor to his Great Aunt. who lived next door to the Matthias. He and Ann were married in All Saints Church in Jersey City in 1948. Sadly, Harold died 17 years

Ann speaks lovingly and with much pride of her two daughters-Joanne and Lorraine. Joanne is a writer who has written for the TV show "Another World." Her latest writing endeavors are fantasy novels under her pen name -Brandylen James. She currently teaches English



at Keiser University in Florida.

Lorraine is Chairperson of the History Department at Chestnut Hill College in Philadelphia.

The Coons moved to North Plainfield in the early 1960's. She decided her girls would have a good education and so she went to work to assure there would be funds for their college education. She got a part-time job at Banker's Trust in New York, as a proof reader. Ann found this job to be too boring, so she asked to be trained a secretary. The bank sent her to secretarial school where she quickly learned the skills needed to function as a secretary. After 23 years, in 1983, she retired.

A typical day for Ann was much like mothers of today. She dropped her daughters off at school, drove to the Plainfield train station to get the train to Newark, hopped another train to New York and walked blocks to Wall Street.

Ann enjoys sewing, reading, and traveling. She is a parishioner of St. Joseph Church.

Ann lives at home, takes no medications, has a wonderful sense of humor and is sharp as a tack. Ann did confess that her knees are starting to bother her, especially going up the steps.

When asked her advise on reaching her 100th birthday she replied "I didn't plan to live this long, I didn't want to be a burden to my family. I take one day at a time and don't let things bother me. "

We congratulate everyone on their new ranks and hope for a great year for the NJROTC Staff of 2020, and for the new cadets!













ANNUAL 9/11 SILENT PROCESSION CEREMONY


