NEW JERSEY NATIVE ENTERS CLASS OF 2023 PLEBE SUMMER AT THE U.S. NAVAL ACADEMY

ANNAPOLIS, Md. – John Robert Trombetta a graduate of Morristown - Beard School in Morristown, NJ was inducted into the Naval Academy Class of 2023 Thursday, June 27, and will begin six challenging weeks of basic midshipman training as part of Plebe Summer.

Approximately 1,200 candidates are selected each year for the Academy's "plebe" or freshman class, and each student is required to participate in Plebe Summer. Last year the Naval Academy received over 16,000 applications for the Class of 2022.

During this time, plebes have no access to television, movies, the internet or music, and restricted access to cell phones. They are only permitted to make three calls during the six weeks of Plebe Summer.

The pressure and rigor of Plebe Summer is carefully designed to help plebes prepare for their first academic year at the Naval Academy and the four years of challenge, which awaits them.

As the summer progresses, the new midshipmen rapidly assimilate basic skills in seamanship, navigation, damage control, sailing, and handling yard patrol craft. Plebes also learn infantry drill and how to shoot 9 mm pistols and M-16 rifles.

Other daily training sessions involve moral, mental, physical or professional development and team-building skills. Activities include swimming, martial arts, basic rock climbing, obstacle, endurance and confidence courses designed to develop physical, mental and teambuilding skills. Forty hours are devoted to the instruction of infantry drill and five formal parades.

Founded in 1845, the U.S. Naval Academy today is a prestigious four-year service academy that prepares midshipmen morally, mentally and physically to be professional officers in the naval service. More than 4,400 men and women representing every state in the U.S. and several foreign countries make up the student body, known as the Brigade of Midshipmen. U.S.

News and World Reports has recognized the Naval Academy as a top five undergraduate engineering school and a top 20 best liberal arts college. Midshipmen learn from military and civilian instructors and participate intercollegiate varsity sports and extracurricular activities. They also study subjects such as leadership, ethics, small arms, drill, seamanship and navigation, tactics, naval engineering and weapons, and military law. Upon graduation, midshipmen earn a Bachelor of Science degree in a choice of 25 different subject majors and go on to serve at least five years of exciting and rewarding service as commissioned officers in the U.S. Navy or U.S. Marine Corps.

The Brigade of Midshipmen is comprised of approximately 4,400 students from every state in the union and a handful of international students. Each year, approximately 1,200 young men and women are admitted to the Naval Academy's incoming class.

ACTOR NEILL HARTLEY PORTRAYS FDR IN "AN ARSENAL FOR DEMOCRACY"

Actor Neill Hartley wowed Long Hill Township as Ichabod Crane with the Legend of Sleepy Hollow. Now Neill is back at the Long Hill Township Library on Saturday, December 7, 2019 at noon, this time as Franklin Delano Roosevelt, in the captivating one-man show set against the background World War II.

See, hear, and experience FDR as he prepares to address the nation: The date is December 29, 1940. Franklin Delano Roosevelt has just been re-elected to an unprecedented third term in office. But the world is in a crisis. Nazi Germany has blazed a path of destruction across Europe, and America may soon be drawn into war. Neill is also a busy director for theaters which include Philadelphia Young Playwrights, University of the Arts, University of Pennsylvania, Arcadia University, Productions, the Brick Theater and the Luna Theater.

The Stirling Volunteer Fire Co. has a new fully accredited firefighter, Brian DiDonna of Millington, who graduated from the County Fire Academy in early October. At the fire company's monthly meeting he was congratulated by his fellow firefighters for his achievement and Fire Chief Al Gallo presented him with his new personal helmet shield that displays his official firefighter number, #138. His parents were there to witness the shield presentation ceremony and share in coffee and cake along with the taking of numerous photos. They are very proud of their son.

The Firefighter I course is almost 200 hours and provides certified and extensive training to volunteer and paid firefighters together. The training helps participants become experts on firefighting equipment and techniques, handling hazardous materials situations, effective firefighting teamwork, firefighter and civilian safety, and communications.

A strict dress code was maintained for Firefighter I training, additionally if the student missed just one class, he would fail the course automatically. He also had to pass grueling

physical and written tests.

The Stirling Volunteer Fire Co. is 100% comprised of Long Hill Township residents who have given freely of their time 24/7 every day of the year since 1913.

Among Dr. Keiserman's awards are top prizes in two international piano competitions in Russia: one based in Volgograd, the other in Saratov. Recently Anna was awarded 3rd place in the "American Prize in Piano Performance" competition. With a focus on actively engaging audiences, Anna created several custom programs for the Salmagundi Art Club. With her "American Music 1917-18," "Sounding Palettes," and "New York Lights," Anna invited audiences to explore surprising repertoire in a variety of cultural contexts. Other performance credits include Le Poisson Rouge, Weill Recital Hall at Carnegie Hall, and performing for the Fête de La Musique at the invitation of the French-American Piano Society, Big Hall of the Volgograd Conservatory, Volgograd, Russia.

In 2017 Anna received the "Culture and Art" award from the New Russia Cultural Center (Rensselaer, NY) for her dedication to promoting arts and culture in the community. In the summer 2019 Anna embarked on a concert tour in Spain premiering the Sonata "Cerdanyenca" for cello and piano by Marc Migó Cortes. Future engagements of 2020 include recording the solo piano works of the living Catalan composer Jordi Cervelló in Barcelona, Spain and Midwest concert tour with renowned saxophonist Paul Cohen. Anna Keiserman has served as faculty at the NYU Steinhardt School of the Arts, at the Rutgers University Extension Division, and at William Paterson University. Having earned

Every October, as the leaves on the trees begin to change colors, residents and volunteers from all over Somerset County begin to get excited about the Watchung Hills Regional Municipal Alliance (WHRMA) Great Pumpkin Certified 5K Run/Family Fun Walk.

This year, WHRMA, which serves Warren, Green Brook, Watchung and Long Hill Townships, decided to collaborate with the Watchung Twp Recreation Department's Harvest Festival. The event was held on October 19, 2019 at Watchung Twp's Mobus Field and it was a great success. More than 700 residents attended. It was a great opportunity to raise awareness to WHRMA mission and programs.

The WHRMA is a non profit grassroots community organization that receives funding from the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse through the Freeholders of Somerset and Morris Counties. WHRMA identifies community needs through surveys and key informant interviews local data received from local government and funds intervention programs that serve Warren, Green Brook, Watchung and Long Hill Townships. Outcomes from the Centers For Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance Report June 2018 states that "agencies and organizations including schools and youth friendly health care providers can help facilitate access to critically important education, health care and high impact evidence based intervention programs".

The WHRMA committee meetings are held at Watchung Hills Regional High School on the 2nd Wednesday of each month at 7:30 p.m. except in July and August and all meetings are open to the public. The committee sponsors film screenings, author led book discussions, community events and panel dicussions on the topics of drug, alcohol, tobacco and vaping prevention in all the schools in the towns they serve as well as mental health first aid training and suicide prevention throughtout the year. According to The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's Youth Risk Behavior Survey Data Summary and Trends Report 2007-2017 "Improving the health of adolescents and, subsequently, their health in adulthood will require our collective action at the family, school, and community levels". Parents of all school age children are strongly encouraged to get out and support WHRMA events on a regular basis.
