FANWOOD'S FAMOUS CHRISTMAS HOUSE BENEFITS CHARITY

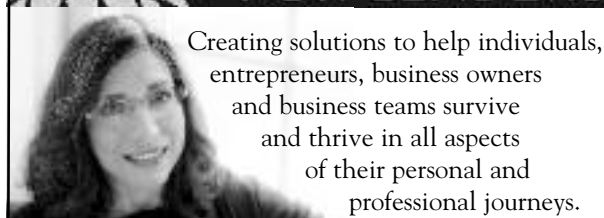

There is a secure lock box next to the front door, or the family welcomes visitors to the ring the doorbell. In 2018, over \$7000 was collected and donated to the charity.

All display and lighting expenses are paid by the Roser family. The 20,000 light extravaganza

is the work of one person, Greg Roser, who starts preparing the display in September. The display is a blend of wooden home-made displays and purchased displays, and is a collection started 37 years ago. This is a traditional display with no flashing lights, and soft Christmas music playing.

The special event for the season is Santa's arrival on Saturday December 7th (rain or shine) from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m., or until the last child is seen by Santa. Last year 150 children visited

Santa. There is NO CHARGE to attend, and everyone is welcome. There will be gifts for all children. This event is a gift from the Roser family, who has made Fanwood home for over 30 years. 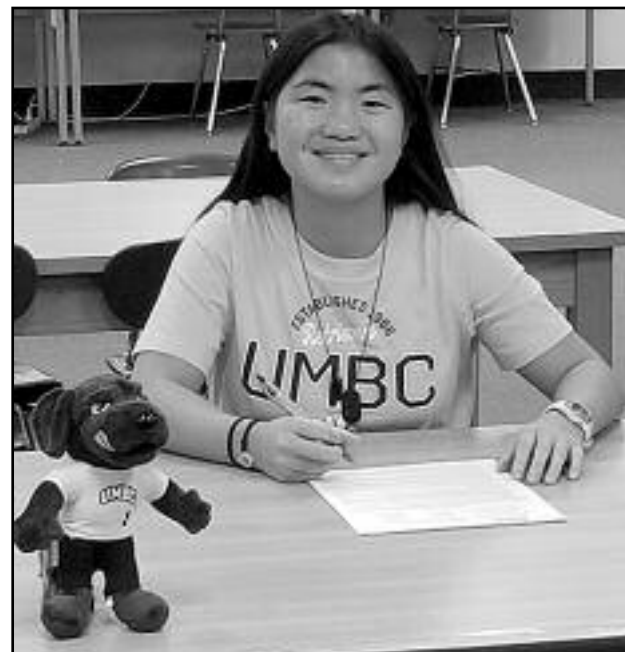

During the month of December, the Fanwood-Scotch Plains Rotary club will sell Luminaries at the Fanwood Department of Public Works on Manfra Way off of North Avenue (across from the Fanwood Public Library). The sale dates are December 7, December 14-15, December 21-22 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and December 24 – 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. The luminary kits cost 75 cents apiece in all quantities and include paper bags, candles and sand. Customers are encouraged to bring buckets, boxes or plastic bags to transport the sand. The kits can be purchased in any quantity and payments can be made by cash or check. Quantities over 100 can also be purchased online by credit card. See the Rotary Facebook page for additional information regarding online purchases: facebook.com/fsprotary.

Luminaries are traditionally used to illuminate the streets on Christmas Eve. A candle is nestled

in sand at the bottom of a paper bag and placed along sidewalks to create a beautiful walkway. The candles are then lit at dusk on Christmas Eve. Some neighborhoods in the area get together and buy hundreds of kits to create an amazing display.

All proceeds from the sale will be used to fund the various charitable and humanitarian projects that Rotary supports, both locally and internationally.

The Fanwood-Scotch Plains Rotary Club has been serving the community since 1938. The club meets on Wednesdays at noon at the Stage House Restaurant. On the last Wednesday of the month, the club meets in the evening at 6:30 p.m. Guests are invited to attend and learn about the good that Rotary is doing worldwide.
