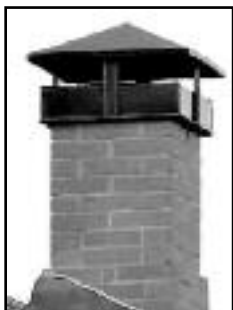

Gran Centurions in Clark. The afternoon included lunch, dancing and a visit from Santa Claus. A wonderful time was had by all.

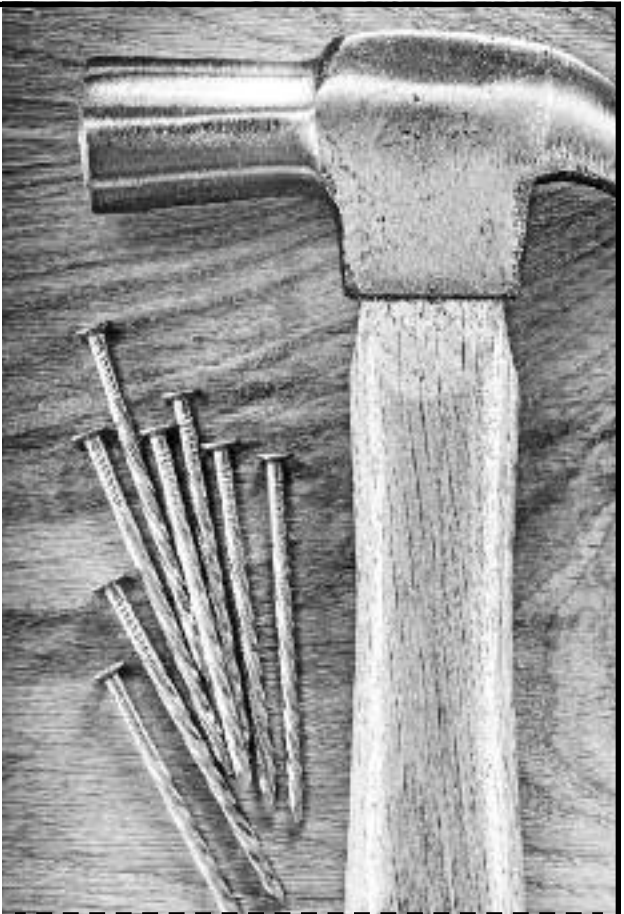

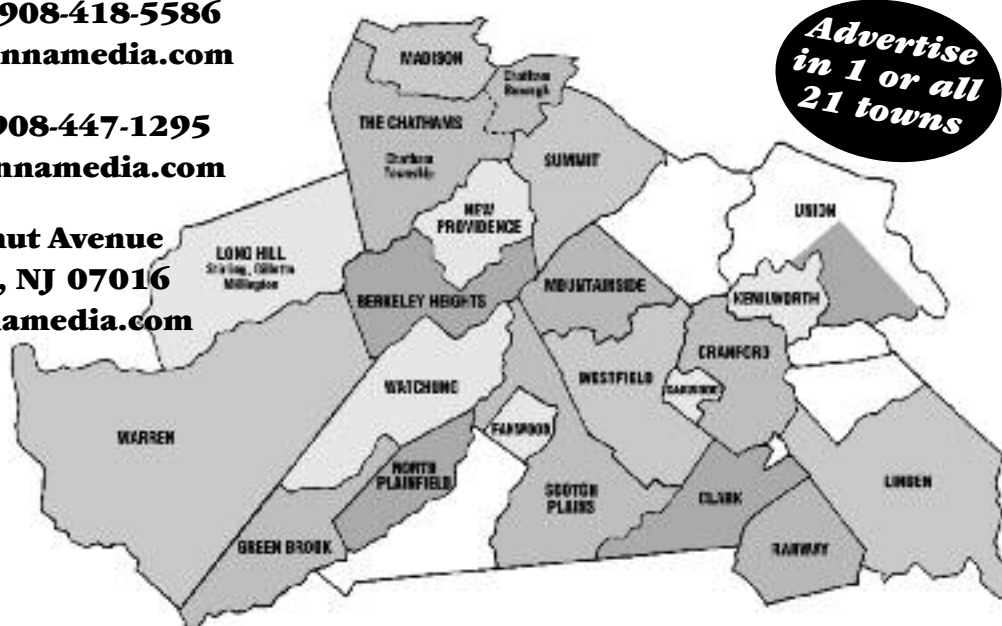
