SENIOR JAGDEEP BHATIA SELECTED AS FINALIST FOR **2020 REGENERON SCIENCE TALENT SEARCH**

Watchung Hills Regional High School (WHRHS) Senior Jagdeep Bhatia, 17, of Green Brook Township has been selected as one of 40 finalists nationwide in the Regeneron Science Talent Search 2020.

The announcement of the 40 finalists was made on Monday, January 20, in Tarrytown, N.Y., and Washington, D.C., by Science Talent Search sponsors, Regeneron Pharmaceuticals, Inc. and Society for Science & the Public (the Society).

Bhatia's project title is: "Simple and Fast Algorithms for Interactive Machine Learning with Random Counter-Examples."

Bhatia explained that while the current processes of training machines – what is generally thought of as 'Artificial Intelligence' – those processes now tend to be slow, requiring a lot of data.

"My project tries to solve that," he said, "tries to make the whole process more data efficient. My proposal asserts that there is a more data efficient way to train machines. I attempt to prove that assertion using mathematical proofs. The whole point is to find a way to make the learning process for machines more like human learning."

He said he plans to study Computer Science and machine learning in college, but is undecided yet about whether he plans to pursue a Ph.D. or other advanced scholarship in computer Science, or build his knowledge and expertise in Computer Science to then apply that preparation in an applied or business use.


For the short term, he is very excited to have been selected by the Science Talent Search, and is looking forward to meeting his fellow search finalists in Washington, D.C.

"I am really excited and grateful to have this wonderful opportunity," said Bhatia. "I am really excited to present my work in Washington, D.C., and meet the other finalists."

While at WHRHS, he has been President of the Computer Science Club, which has included, among other things, helping to organize and stage the WHRHS "HillsHacks" Hackathons the last couple of years. In addition, he is president of the WHRHS Math Team, and a four-year athlete on the WHRHS Cross Country Team.

The Regeneron Science Talent Search 2020 is the nation's oldest and most prestigious science and math competition for high school seniors. Alumni have gone on to have world-changing careers in STEM (Science Technology Engineering Mathematics) fields and earn some of the most esteemed academic honors, including the Nobel Prize, the Fields Medal, the National Medal of Science, the MacArthur Fellowship and even an Academy Award.

The 2020 finalists were selected from 1,993 highly qualified entrants, all of whom completed an original research project and extensive application process. The finalists were selected based on their projects' scientific rigor and their potential to become world-changing scientists and leaders.



Finalists' projects span a diversity of STEMrelated topics including targeting cancer via signaling pathways, developing a mobile application for stroke diagnosis using deep learning and computer vision, and identifying an improved method for trace level arsenic quantification in water.

The finalists will travel to Washington, D.C. from Thursday, March 5 to Wednesday, March 11, where they will undergo a rigorous judging process and compete for more than \$1.8 million in awards. They will also have an opportunity to interact with leading scientists, meet with Members of Congress and display their projects to the public on Sunday, March 8.

The finalists are each awarded at least \$25,000, and the top 10 awards range from \$40,000 to \$250,000. The top 10 Regeneron Science Talent Search 2020 winners will be announced at a black-tie gala awards ceremony at the National Building Museum on Tuesday, March 10. In total, more than \$3 million in awards will be distributed throughout the Regeneron Science Talent Search, which includes the awards to finalists as well as the \$2,000 provided to each of the top 300 scholars and their schools.

LIBRARY SYSTEM INTRODUCES TRANSLATOR DEVICES TO CONNECT WITH CUSTOMERS

According to statistics from the U.S. Census Bureau, approximately 30.5 percent of Somerset County residents speak a language other than English at home. As a result, the Somerset County Library System of New Jersey (SCLSNJ) offers translation devices at all 10 Library branches to ensure that all customers are able to communicate with Library staff.

"We are excited by how well these inexpensive devices enable us to bridge the language divide," said Brian Auger, county Library administrator.

The Google minis can translate to and from 44 different languages including Spanish, Chinese, and Arabic. The U.S. Census survey shows that approximately 11 percent of residents in the County speak Spanish at home, while 9.5 percent speak a European based language, and 8.3 percent speak an Asian or

Pacific Island based language.

"We deployed these devices to serve as onlanguage translators in our communities," said Lauren Ryan, manager of branch services, strategic initiatives and special projects. "While we aim to have bilingual staff present in our branches, these devices can supplement communication when a bilingual staff member is not present. This initiative is in alignment with our Strategic Priority of addressing the needs of shifting demographics and our Core Service of providing technology access and expertise that meet the needs of the community."

In addition to these devices, the Library System offers hundreds of titles in Spanish; foreign language learning resources including Mango Languages and Rosetta Stone; and English Conversation classes in partnership with Literacy Volunteers of Somerset County.









CARING CONTACT CRISIS LINE GRADUATES 96TH CLASS NEXT TRAINING TO BEING MARCH 17

Six area residents completed training in December 2019 to become volunteers on the Caring Contact crisis hotline. During the 52 hours of training the graduates developed the ability to listen actively, assess the needs of someone in crisis and provide empathy and support. The training included dynamic and interactive presentations by guest experts in active listening, grief recovery, mental health issues and suicide intervention. Volunteer Listener Training is taught by trainers who are long-time listeners and nationally certified instructors in Mental Health First Aid and Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training.

"I trained to become a caring contact listener in an effort to connect with those that need to feel human connection in order to cope with whatever struggles they are going through whether it be mental health, family crisis, chronic physical pain or economic hardship," stated Bisrat Mekbeb of Scotch Plains. "I am fortunate to be in a position to give back to my community through Caring Contact in this way."

When asked why he was drawn to this work, Ryan Hinderliter of Westfield said, "I wanted to channel my love for psychology and my passion for making a difference in the community into something meaningful."

Caring Contact is an award-winning, volunteer-staffed crisis hotline and listening community that supports the Nation Suicide Prevention Lifeline. Located in Westfield, NJ, they provide active listening support and best-inclass education to central and northern New Jersey.







RIO CLEMENTE & REGAN RYZUK ~ FOUR HAND PIANO DUO

Critically acclaimed audience favorite Bishop of Jazz, Rio Clemente, will appear at the Watchung Arts Center with his special guest Master Pianist-Composer, Regan Ryzuk, in a Four Hand Piano Duo on March 14 at 8 p.m. The show will be followed by a dessert reception with the opportunity to meet the performers.

Rio Clemente's career began with a BMI scholarship for musical theatre and subsequent studies at Juilliard School of Music. A grant from Broadway Tomorrow for new composers followed. Along with his classical training, Rio developed a style embracing a diversity of music that makes him one of the most expressive and versatile pianists anywhere. After several television appearances, Rio advanced professionally to playing at several distinguished concert halls and festivals, including Carnegie Hall, Avery Fisher Hall at Lincoln Center, Manhattan's famous Birdland and the Oak Room at the Algonquin Hotel, as well as the Newport and JVC Jazz Festivals. Rio also performed at the White House representing the United States Coast Guard and all Auxiliaries. He regularly appears with groups such as The Morris Choral Society and Orchestra and at jazz venues from Manhattan to Cape Code and from Florida to California.

Rio has recorded for well-known labels and has published twenty CDs under his own label, Etnemelc Music Productions. collaboration with Carmine Lombardo has written a number of selections ranging from gospel to Latin, including orchestral arrangements. A children's song was nominated for a Grammy and this past October his original musical "VIZHON" had its world premiere performance in Florida. As a music educator, and teacher, he has served as music director for the Generations of Jazz program of the New Jersey Jazz Society, and has presented customized programs in schools, including Viva La Musica Latina with the late percussionist Russ Moy.

studied with Robert Helps at Manhattan School of Music as well as attended The Juilliard School. Ryzuk's classical music studies then led into jazz studies with Jaki Byard and Sir Roland Hanna. At Juilliard, he studied music theory and composition.

Ryzuk began touring with various ballet companies - traveling through Europe and Latin America. The playing of ballet classes improved his improvisational techniques and laid the groundwork for one of his greatest compositional works - "48 Preludes and Fugues" - in the style of Johann Sebastian Bach. This work was composed over the course of a year when he was living in Switzerland. After moving back to the United States, Ryzuk lived in New York and continued his composition work. He also developed a base of students, including Fountains of Wayne co-founder, Adam Schlesinger. Ryzuk was a founding partner in a TV/film music

production company, respectively known as SOUNDGUILD. Regan's work can be heard on numerous television and movie projects through his work with Zomba Music. Additionally, he has provided music for Extreme Music Library, LTD.

Tickets are \$20 in advance, \$25 (\$22 WAC members) at the door. Buying tickets in advance is strongly recommended and can be purchased securely through Eventbrite (watchungartscenter @eventbrite.com). Tickets may also be purchased by mail (please include email address) or in person during office hours.
