### **LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS PUBLISHES SONGS OF THE SUFFRAGISTS: LYRICS OF AMERICAN FEMINISM FROM 1850 TO 2020**

The League of Women Voters Berkeley Heights, New Providence and Summit (LWVBHNPS), including members and our high school/college interns, has spent the last 2 years putting together a terrific read, Songs of the Suffragists: Lyrics of American Feminism from 1850 to 2020, as part of our fundraising for local student scholarship awards and celebration of the Centennial.

Citing more than 80 sources and including more than 40 images, Songs of the Suffragists:



narrates the history of American feminism from the 19th Century through the modern era. Each chapter includes an excerpt of song lyrics from the relevant period, along with a well-researched commentary regarding the song and the woman's movement at that time.

The book is 66 pages long and provides an ideal foundation for book club programming around the centennial.

This book was started by LWVBHNPS interns in the spring of 2018 with the help of LWV members Pat Dolan and LWV President Susan Ferris Rights.

Songs of the Suffragists: Lyrics of American Feminism from 1850 to 2020 was then researched and drafted by the LWV-BHNPS's stellar group of high school and college interns

Lyrics of American Feminism from 1850 to 2020 in both 2018 and 2019. Interns included: Bridget Bowen, Julia Haas, Stephanie Lioudis, and Elizabeth Moshkevich. Each brought their unique insight and perspective to the creation of this book.



### **BIKE DONATIONS SOUGHT** ON BEHALF OF PEDALS FOR PROGRESS

cleaning. Maybe you have a bike taking up space in your garage, shed or basement. Maybe it is an old model, a bit worn, in need of repair, or just something you or your kids have outgrown. We have a great option for you that is socially and environmentally responsible.

Faith Lutheran Church, New Providence is currently collecting bicycles in usable and/or repairable condition on behalf of Pedals for Progress (P4P), an organization which annually recycles thousands of bicycles, sending them to countries around the world. Faith Lutheran has been partnering with P4P since 2002 and has collected thousands of bikes in that time.

Anyone wishing to donate an adult or kid-sized bike can drop it off at the far end of the church parking lot near the little brown shed at 524 South Street in New Providence. There is no need to call ahead, just drive up and drop off your donation in the lot and Faith will make sure it gets to P4P. To arrange for pick up, contact the Church Office at 908-464-5177 or leave a message and someone will get back to you.

In the last 29 years, P4P has collected more than 159,000 bicycles and shipped them to people in need in places including Latin America, South America, Africa, Thailand, and the Balkans. In each of these locations, the bikes are reconditioned by partner agencies and distributed

Now is a great time to do some spring at low cost to poor working adults or wherever there is need. Donated bikes previously used for relaxation and recreation get a second life providing life-sustaining and transportation for people to commute to work or school, to transport produce to market, and to access healthcare and other services.

### THERESA GAZAWAY NAMED POLICE CHIEF AND OEM COORDINATOR

Theresa Gazaway as the 7th Police Chief of the Borough of New Providence. She succeeds Anthony Buccelli, who retired on May 1, 2020. Notably, she is the first female Police Chief in Union County history.

Chief Gazaway began her career in law enforcement after being accepted into the Alternate Route Program at the John H. Stamler Police Academy in July 1995 and was subsequently hired by the New Providence Police Department. Her assignments have included Patrolman, Traffic Safety Officer, Bicycle Officer, DARE Officer, Senior Citizen Liaison, Detective, Patrol Commander and Detective Bureau Commander. Chief Gazaway was promoted to Sergeant in 2006, Lieutenant in 2010 and Captain in 2017. She currently serves as the Accreditation Manager for the department and oversees the day to day operations.

Chief Gazaway graduated from Raritan Valley Community College with an Associate's Degree in Criminal Justice. She is a Certified Public Manager; NJ State Chiefs Certified

On May 1, 2020, Mayor Al Morgan swore in Command Executive, and has a certificate in Public Safety Liability Mitigation from Stockton College. She has served as the President of The Union County DARE Officer's Association and Vice President of the New Providence P.B.A., Local #132. Chief Gazaway also serves as a staff instructor at the John H. Stamler Police Academy and an assessor for the NJSACOP Accreditation Program.

> Chief Gazaway is a long time New Providence resident with deep roots in the community. She and her husband Ron were married and raised their two children in the Borough. She is also a member of the New Providence Lions Club and the Summit Elks.

### **OUT OF MANY- ONE! NEW PROVIDENCE RESIDENTS FIND A WAY TO CELEBRATE THEIR TRICENTENNIAL DURING SOCIAL DISTANCING**

Residents of New Providence are planning an art installation to begin on Flag Day, June 14, to celebrate the 300th anniversary of the town (1720-2020). Most Tricentennial events have been cancelled or postponed due to virus isolation protocols. This project is a way to keep spirits up and show how powerful people can be if they work together.

E Pluribus Unum (Latin for Out of Many, One) was a favorite motto of the founding fathers. This art installation, named for that motto, symbolizes the town, founded in colonial days, coming together as one to make something larger than anyone alone could create.

"Anyone in New Providence - a group, a family, a sports team or an organization - is welcome to design and decorate a square of cotton fabric with weather-safe markers or paints," said Patricia Jacobs, Executive Director of the New Providence- Our Community For All. "Then squares will be collected and strung like pennant flags on ropes from the roof lines and railings of the large pavilion in Centennial Park. The park is visible from Springfield Avenue, making it easy for pedestrians and drivers to see. The flags will be on full display for several weeks. Make a flag! Join in the fun!"

Suggested themes for the flags include, what you love about New Providence, things you have learned or enjoyed during your time spent at home, what are you looking forward to when life returns to a more normal pace?

The flags will create a sea of colorful green, gold and white—New Providence's colors.
