





The supply of this special personalized dictionary and gazetteer will be delivered curbside contactless style to the schools and distributed to the students by the school staff.

In the past, Rotarian volunteers would hand

deliver the dictionaries to the 3rd grade classrooms, followed by a highlighting the information contained in the books, an introduction to Rotary, and how Rotary's efforts and projects are seen around Madison. Instead, this year the program will be done virtually with a video on Youtube presented by Judy.

In addition to the 218 Third graders receiving the dictionaries, additional copies will be sent to the Kirby Center, as well as the Adult School as part of their ESL Program. To date 4,752 dictionaries have been distributed to Madison 3rd graders since the onset of the program.
