POLICE PATROLMAN ROBERT F. HAND REMEMBERED

On February 11th the Cranford Police Department remembers Patrolman Robert F. Hand and the sacrifice that he made 46 years ago. On February 11, 1975 Patrolman Robert F. Hand was killed in the line of duty during a motor vehicle pursuit.

The car that Patrolman Hand was chasing was driven by an eighteen year old Rahway resident. The chase began in Cranford and continued onto Westfield Avenue in Clark, where the officer lost control of his car and crashed into the storefront of a glass and mirror shop. The eighteen year old driver of the car that Patrolman Hand was chasing was arrested in Rahway several minutes after the crash. Patrolman Hand was taken to Rahway Hospital where he was pronounced dead. Patrolman Hand left behind a wife and four voung children.

Patrolman Hand will always be remembered as a servant leader who had deep ties to our community. His was nicknamed 'The Senator' because he was known to stop and talk to all of the store owners, shoppers, and everyone else who he saw on his beat. His peers would joke that it would take him half of his shift to walk just one block because of his desire to help people and start conversations with everyone he saw.

Patrolman Hand was an Air Force veteran who served in the Korean Conflict and he received an honorable discharge in 1950. He was sworn in as a Cranford Patrolman in 1956 and received numerous commendations during his 19-year career. In 1968 he was issued a commendation for breaking up a large scale narcotics ring that resulted in the arrest of 10 drug dealers, and in 1969 he was commended for arresting a child sex offender.

Patrolman Hand was active in the Cranford Elks Lodge and VFW Post 335 and had been elected by his fellow officers to serve as president of the Cranford P.B.A.

For the week starting February 11, 2021 uniformed Cranford officers wear black mourning bands across their badges in remembrance of their fallen brother. In addition, all police cars display a memorial badge in his honor all year.

COURSE ON DEALING WITH MENTAL ILLNESS

The NAMI Family-to-Family Education Course will be offered by the Union County Chapter of NAMI (National Alliance on Mental Illness). The course will be online via Zoom starting on Thursday evening, March 4 at 7 p.m., and meet each Thursday over a consecutive 8-week period. FAMILY CAREGIVERS WEATHERING COVID-19

Thomas Corea decided to become a stay-home dad when his son, TJ, was 18 months old. Not long after that, he and his wife, Carol, discovered TJ was on the autistic spectrum. Thomas Corea has been the family caregiver for his son, now 26, ever since.

While Thomas Corea is a very positive person - he is a musician by trade - he often found it daunting to deal with the system that is in place to provide people with disabilities and their families the supports they need.

"Unless you stand on a mountain and scream, you get nothing," he said. "You try to keep your head above water and their head above water to keep them safe."

According to estimates from the National Alliance for Caregiving, 65.7 million Americans serve as family caregivers for an ill relative or a relative with a disability. Per the Administration for Community Living, research indicates family caregiving takes a significant emotional, physical and financial toll. With nearly half of all caregivers over the age 50, many are vulnerable to a decline in their own health, they say. Studies show that coordinated support services can reduce caregiver depression, anxiety and stress.

To ease that stress, Thomas Corea turned to Community Access Unlimited, first for direct support services while TJ was in school, then for respite services when he turned 21. Monique St. Claire is the family's support counselor, providing the family with 6.5 hours of respite support one day each week. St. Claire takes TJ on short trips, such as to outside events.

Having reached a dead end in his career, he takes a lot to handle," St. Claire said. "I'm getting him out of the house and giving his parents respite...He gets frustrated when he doesn't get what he wants. But I can reason with him and then he says with a sweet voice, 'Okay.' It's very endearing."

> St. Claire's support became even more important when Covid-19 hit the United States and all TJ's other supports stopped. St. Claire is back to visiting weekly.

> "He lost all his routine," Thomas Corea said. "He lost his sense of day and night. He needs constant attention...Now that he has it back, he's back to normal."

> CAU plays a major support role for thousands of family caregivers and has not abated its services during Covid. Yet the agency is facing drastic increases in expenses related to the pandemic and is asking for help.

> "CAU is working hard to keep our members and staff safe during the pandemic and we continue to incur significant expenses, such as personal protection equipment," said Bernadette



In August 2020, Renna Media reported that Faith Lutheran Church collected and repaired 170 used bikes from residents of New Providence, Berkeley Heights and neighboring towns. The collection was conducted on behalf of Pedals for Progress, an organization which recycles bikes for persons in developing countries. Faith contributed \$1,700 toward the shipment of the bikes.

In the United States daily transportation occurs conveniently with little or no forethought. This is not the case in developing countries, where a village may not have one car. The mode of transportation for commuting to work, going to market and receiving medical care is frequently a pedal bike.

Later this year, Faith will again be asking persons to donate bikes for Faith to process through Pedals for Progress. A person may ask Faith to pick up the bike from his/her house or deliver the bike to Faith. If one wishes to donate a bike before the request, one may place the bike by the shed at the back of Faith's parking lot located at 524 South Street, New Providence, NJ. Since 2002 Faith has been participating in the Pedals for Progress program. For the past five years, Casey Walsh has chaired the ministry for Faith.


